Módulo 5: Estado civil para efectos de la declaración

El estado civil para efectos de la declaración determina la tasa de impuesto sobre el ingreso. Hay cinco estados civiles:

- soltero
- casado declarando en conjunto
- casado declarando por separado
- cabeza de familia
- viudo que reúne los requisitos con hijo dependiente

Algunos contribuyentes son elegibles para usar más de un estado civil. Por lo general, el contribuyente elegirá el estado civil que resulte en la tasa de impuesto más baja.

Income

Table for income reporting with lines 7 through 22, including categories like Wages, interest, dividends, and other income.

Adjusted Gross Income

Table for adjusted gross income reporting with lines 23 through 37, including deductions for educator expenses, moving costs, and student loan interest.
