If you are a transmitter or software developer and plan to transmit Forms 1041 and/or 94x through MeF, you will need to update your [IRS e-file Application](#). Please access your e-file application and select "Form(s)" from the menu page. Next select the applicable provider option of transmitter or software developer, then select Form 1041 or 94x and MeF Internet XML. Be sure to save the change. This action must be completed for each form type you intend to transmit.

States: No action is necessary. IRS will update the e-file application of States who plan to participate in the 1041 MeF Fed/State program.

Subject: Preparers Suspected of Filing Inaccurate EITC Claims Receive Warning Letters

During November and December 2013, the IRS will send letters to preparers suspected of filing inaccurate EITC claims. The letters detail the critical issues identified on the returns, explain the consequences of filing inaccurate claims for EITC and advise preparers that IRS will continue monitoring the types of EITC claims they file. Filing inaccurate EITC claims may result in penalty assessment, revocation of IRS e-file privileges and other consequences including barring preparers from tax return preparation.

IRS also plans to conduct visits to some tax preparers in efforts of providing education and outreach on meeting EITC Due Diligence requirements.
