2. **Only** route or fax Form 4442 to the SPC ITIN Operation to complete revoke actions on RTS **after** AM merge actions have posted on IDRS or a determination has been made that the merge action is not required.

**EXCEPTION:** If the spouse/secondary taxpayer has filed returns with his/her ITIN as primary, a merge to his/her SSN is required.

Form 4442 should be sent to the SPC ITIN Operation to complete the revoke action (e.g., multiple ITIN assignment, Taxpayer has been assigned a SSN etc.) as necessary.

**REMINDER:** Annotate both TINs on the Form 4442 referral and specify which TIN should be revoked and the reasons for the revocation. If a merge action is not required, this must also be annotated on Form 4442 prior to forwarding to the ITIN Unit for revoke action.
