It's easy to get the latest IRS tax information — just connect to [IRS social media](#). Connecting with IRS's social media helps you navigate tax tips and deadlines. You can even find out the status of your tax refund.

You can find these IRS social media tools on [IRS.gov](#):

IRS2Go — IRS's free mobile application is available for the Apple iPhone, iTouch or Android mobile devices. Get the most current status of your refund, tax news updates, IRS YouTube videos and more helpful tax information right from your mobile device.

YouTube — IRS's channel on YouTube houses video tax tips on a variety of topics in English, Spanish and American Sign Language.

Twitter - The IRS tweets daily tax information through a few different Twitter accounts:

- [@IRSnews](#) provides tax-related announcements and tax tips in English.
- [@IRSenEspañol](#) provides tax-related announcements and tax tips in Spanish.
- [@IRStaxpros](#) offers news and guidance for tax professionals.
- [@RecruitmentIRS](#) provides up-to-date leads on IRS employment opportunities.

Tumblr - IRS Tumblr is a blogging platform where you can access IRS tax tips, videos, and podcasts. The IRS Tumblr website includes information about important programs and is accessible from your Smartphone, tablet or desktop Internet browser.

Podcast - IRS provides short audio recordings that offer one tax-related topic per podcast. They are available for download on iTunes or through the [IRS Multimedia Center](#) along with text transcripts.
