Subject: The Form W2-G schema is being updated

The TY2012v4.0 Form W-2G Schema requires an update. We will be reverting back to the W-2G schema found in the TY2012v3.0 Schema package to match the 2012 tax form. Returns using the TY2012v4.0 Form W-2G schema will be rejected, as IRS will only validate the Form W-2G schema against the active validating schema version in TY2012v4.1 in production. This change impacts IMF returns only.

This change will be implemented in TY2012v4.1 and is scheduled to be posted on IRS.gov on December 11, 2012. The schema package will be implemented in ATS on December 31, 2012 and implemented in Production on January 22, 2013.

Our Customer Service Representatives will not have access to the CAF and will have limited research capability during the outage. New authorizations submitted for this purpose will be forwarded to the CAF for processing. You will not need to re-submit it through the Disclosure Authorization function of e-Services.

Subject: Important Update Concerning Form 1040 Schema Versions

The IRS will deploy the Form 1040-series schema package 2012v4.1 (minor version) into the Modernized e-File (MeF) ATS environment on 12/31/12, and into Production at Startup on 1/22/13. We will also deploy schema package 2012v4.0 (major version) into Production on 1/22/13

Important note: The 2012v4.1 package contains significant changes that should have been released as a major (required) schema change affecting all software vendors. However, in light of this late date and the impending filing season startup, the IRS decided to support the versions noted above and asks all software developers to immediately review the "Diff" files embedded in the 2012v4.1 schema package, and use that version if your clients will potentially be impacted. For example, the 2012v4.1 package includes a critical Form W2 change making the Employee Social Security Number a required rather than an optional field (removed minOccurs="0"). We also added a new Form 8949 Paper Indicator in the Return Header in 2012v4.1. If your client continues to uses the 2012v4.0 package, they will not have that option. The IRS uses the 2012v4.1 schema to validate both packages, so any element name change will also reject as a schema error if they mismatch.

We highly recommend that all software developers use the 2012v4.1 schemas (if you have not done so already) to prevent unnecessary rejects.

Subject: Critical Update Concerning Form 1040 Schema Versions

As communicated on December 21, 2012, the IRS will deploy the Form 1040-series schema package 2012v4.1 into the Modernized e-File (MeF) Assurance Testing System (ATS) environment on December 30, 2012, and into Production at Startup on January 22, 2013. **Important update**: The 2012v4.1 package contains significant changes that should have been released as a major (required) schema update affecting all software vendors. However, to minimize external impact, we previously stated that MeF would support both the 2012v4.0 and the 2012v4.1 packages.

After additional analysis and testing, the IRS has decided to support only the 2012v4.1 schema package. This action will prevent a number of schema validation errors and potential processing delays that may be encountered when using the 2012v4.0 package.

Effective Sunday, December 30, 2012, the 2012v4.1 schema package should be used for ATS. Schema package 2012v4.0 will not be deployed into Production and will reject as a mismatch.

Although we strongly encourage software companies with approved software to retest using the 2012v4.1 schemas, you will not be required to do so.

Subject: E-Services portals out until January 6

In addition to the previously announced CAF outage from December 26 to 6:00 AM January 2, the e-Services' Transcript Delivery System, Disclosure Authorization and Electronic Account Resolution systems will be out three additional business days. They should return to operation Sunday, January 6, 2013.

During this time, you will be unable to request transcripts, submit a new Form 2848, Power of Attorney and Declaration of Representative, Form 8821, Tax Information Authorization or use the Electronic Account Resolution. We encourage users to hold their transactions until the system is operational.

As a reminder, if you choose to fax Forms 2848 and 8821 during the outage period, please do not re-submit it through e-Services. Your forms will be processed manually.
