Mr. Brostek is a Director for Tax Issues at GAO. He is responsible for reviews related to (1) the management of IRS and its various programs and (2) how well federal tax policy objectives are achieved. Recent reviews led by Mr. Brostek have reported on options for reducing the tax gap, the effect of states' regulation of paid tax return preparers on federal tax compliance, and the growth of tax expenditures and their estimated revenue losses. Previously, Mr. Brostek was an Associate Director in GAO's Federal Management and Workforce Issue Area, where he was responsible for GAO's assignments relating to management of the government's civilian workforce. He also directed GAO's work related to federal management issues, such as its implementation of the Government Performance and Results Act, and reviews focusing on federal statistical collection programs. Earlier in his GAO career, Mr. Brostek led work on or participated in reviewing a wide range of federal government programs and agencies from intergovernmental assistance programs, to law enforcement efforts, to federal budget processes.
