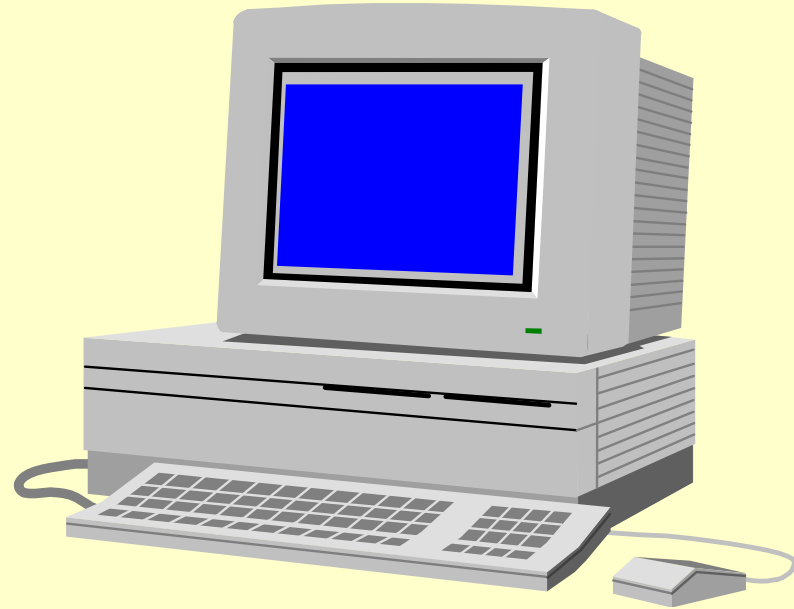

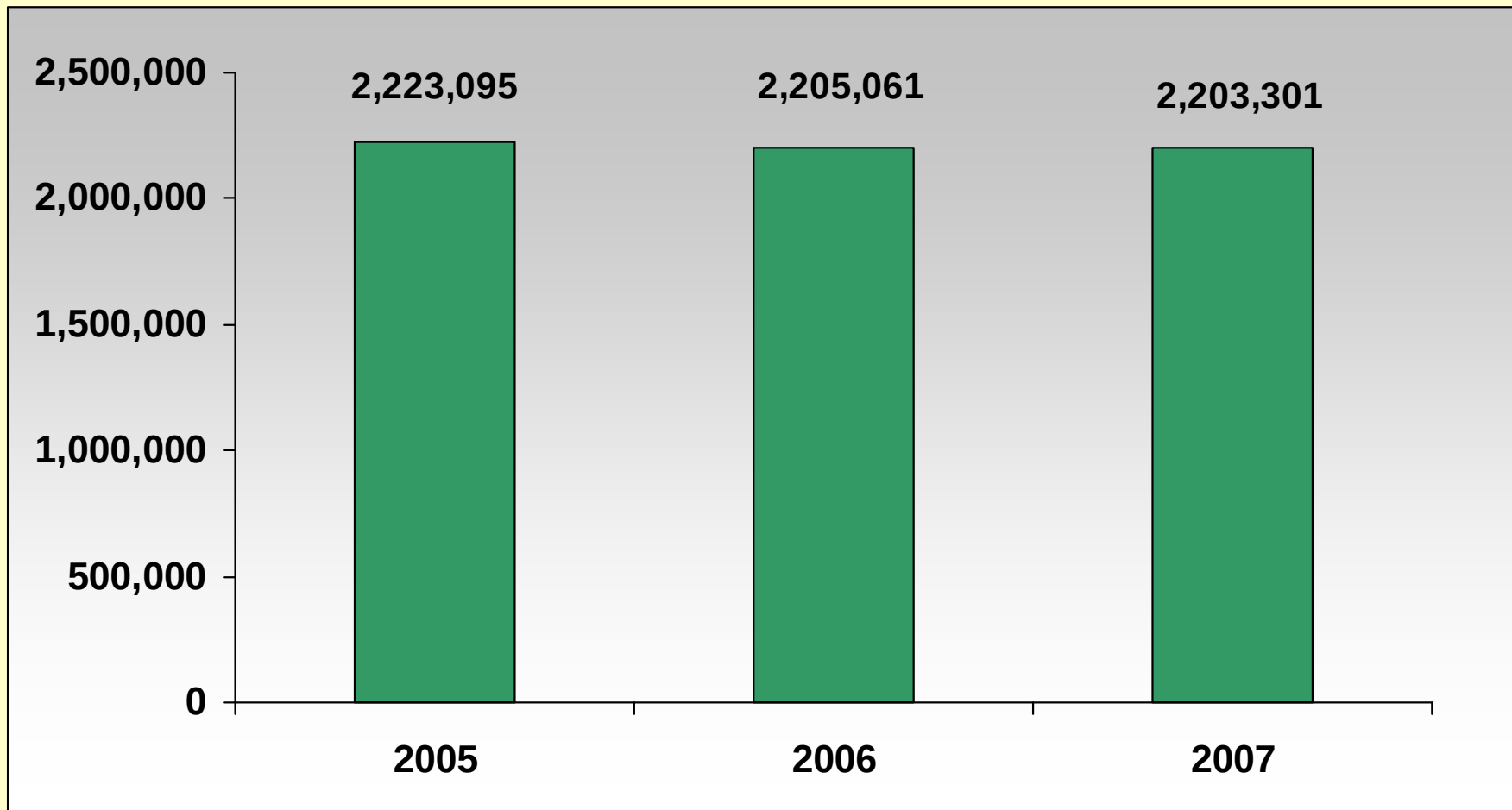

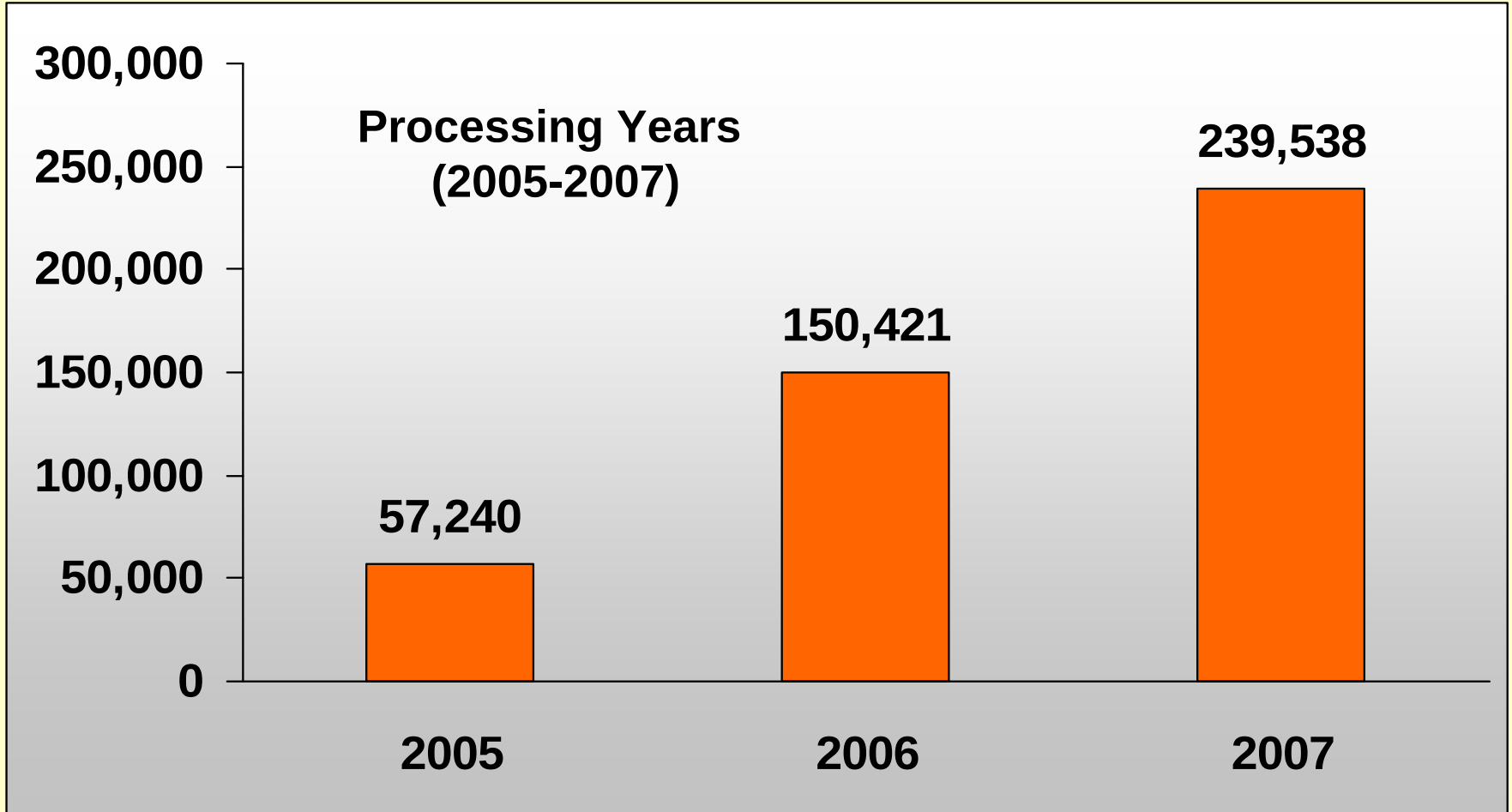


Form 1120 Annual Filing Volume

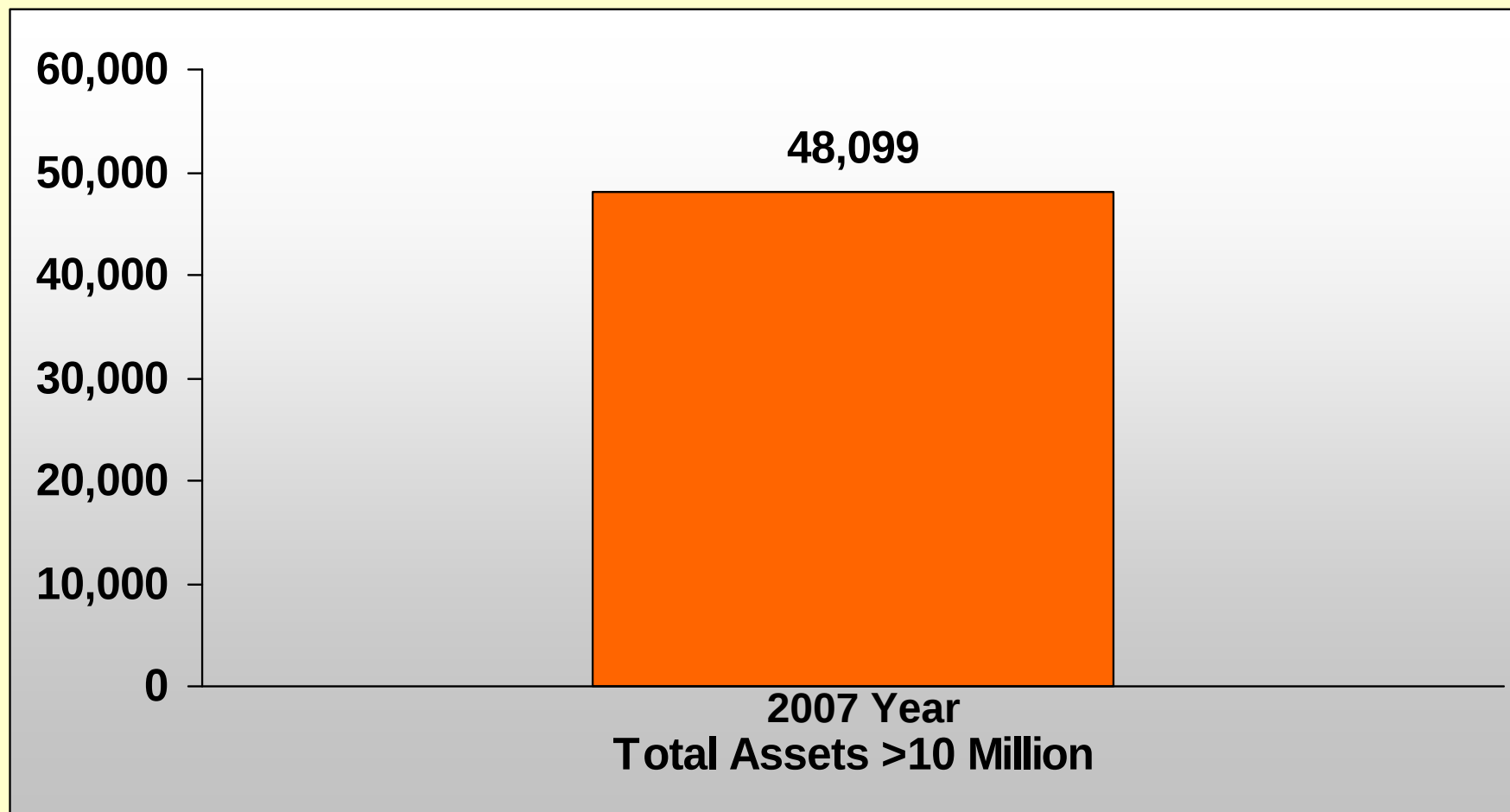

Form 1120 Taxpayers Impacted by Mandating *e-filing* for Asset Thresholds

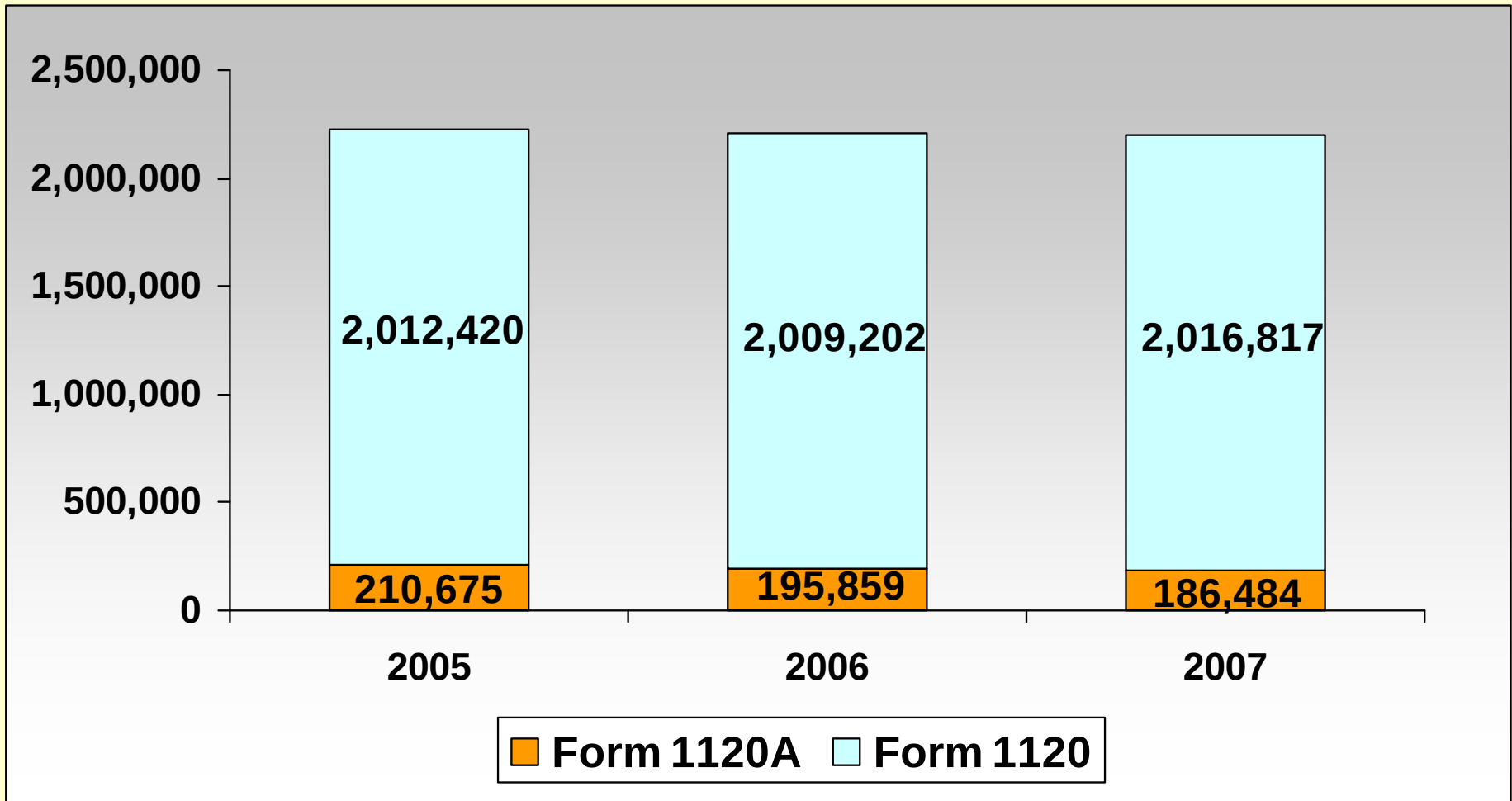

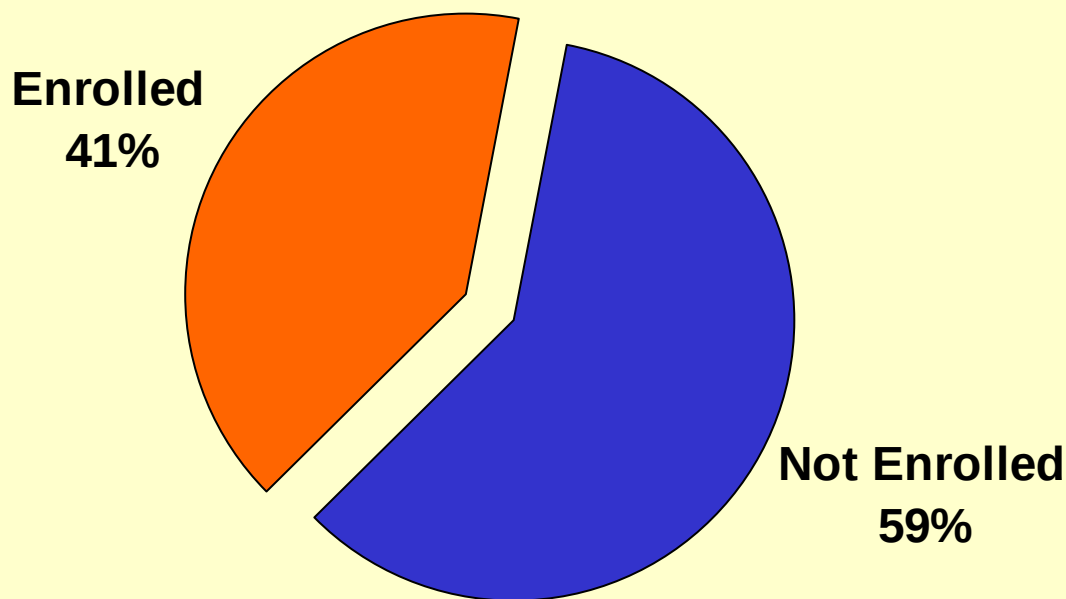
Form 1120 by Series

Processing Years 2005-2007



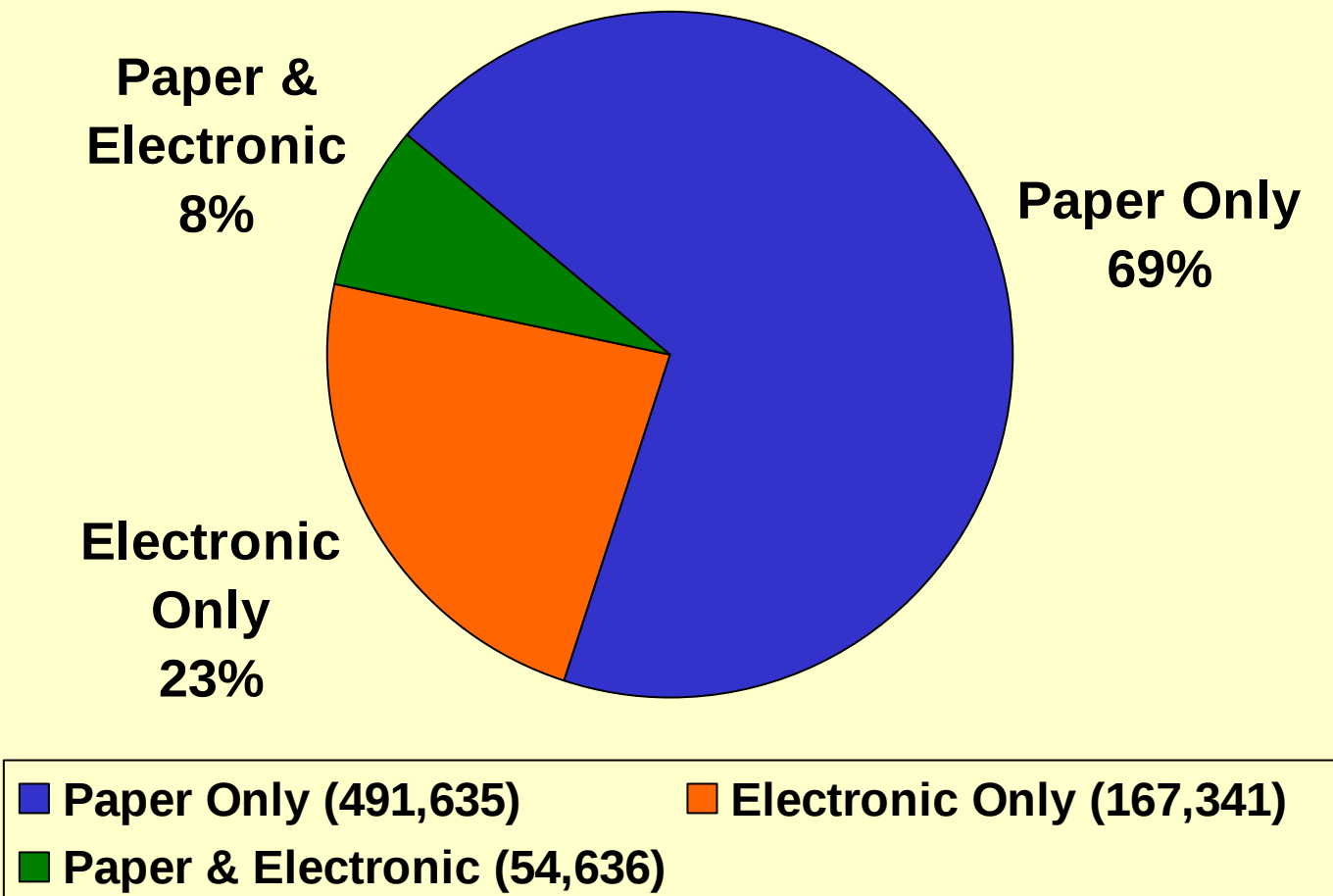

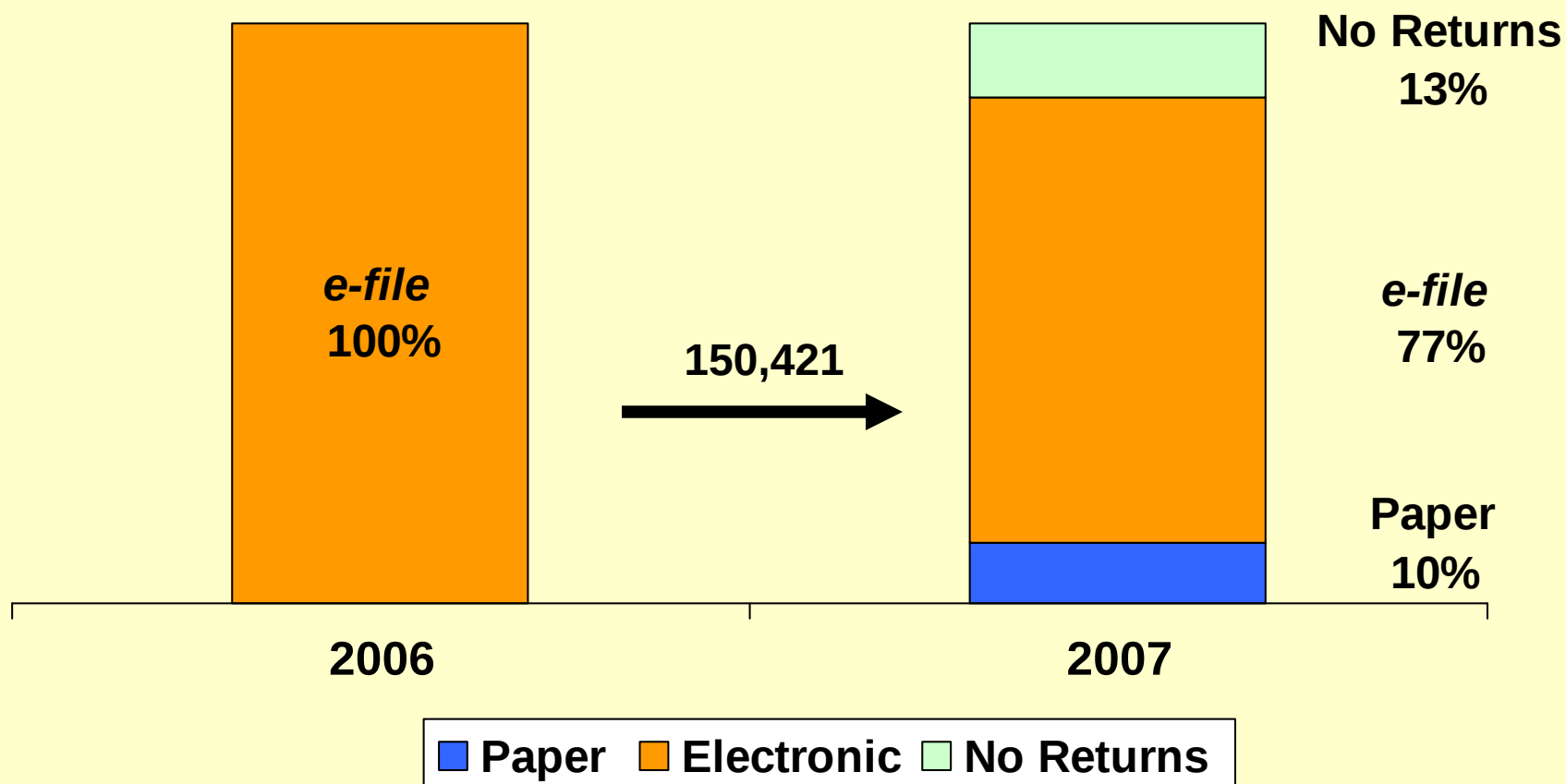

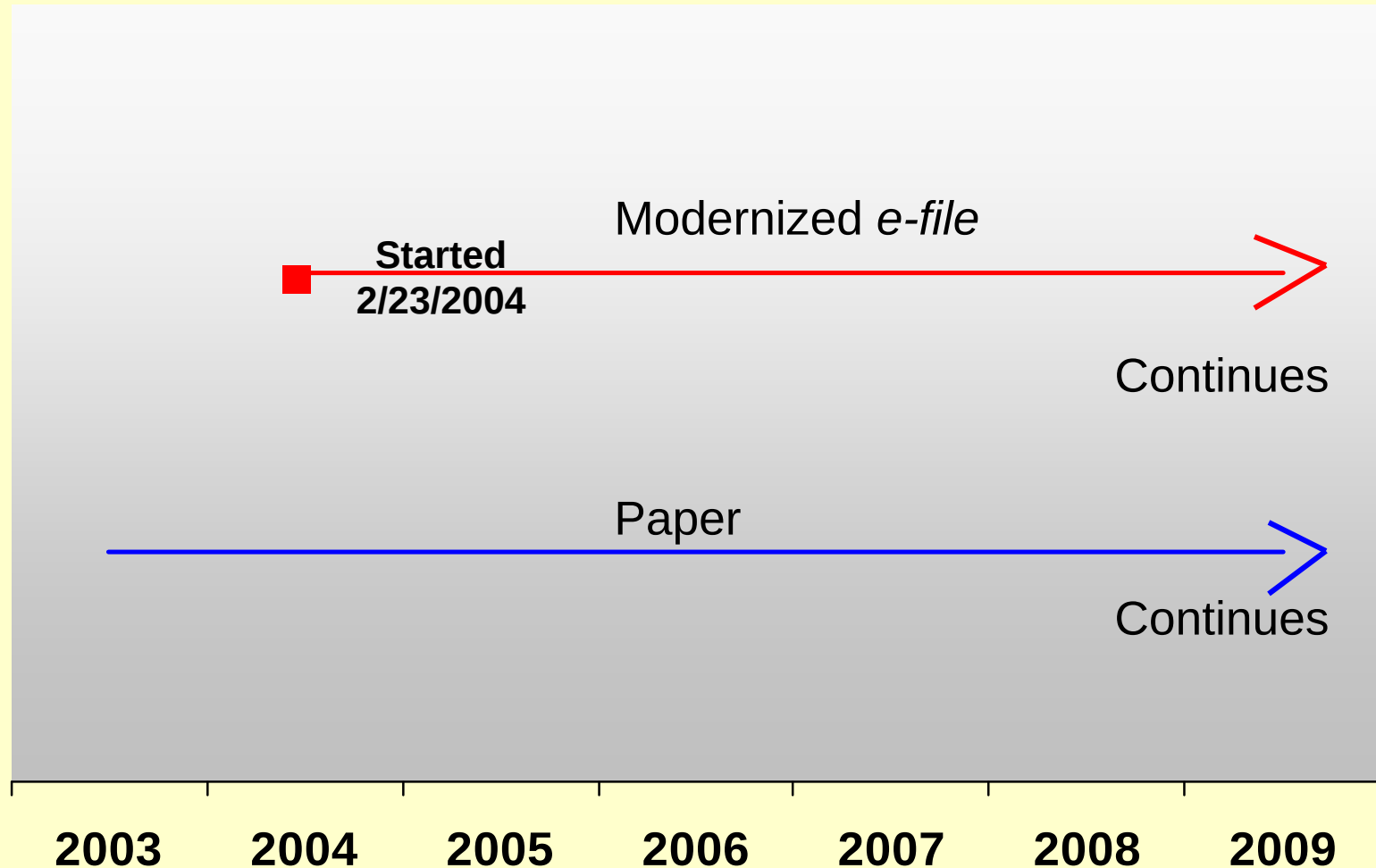

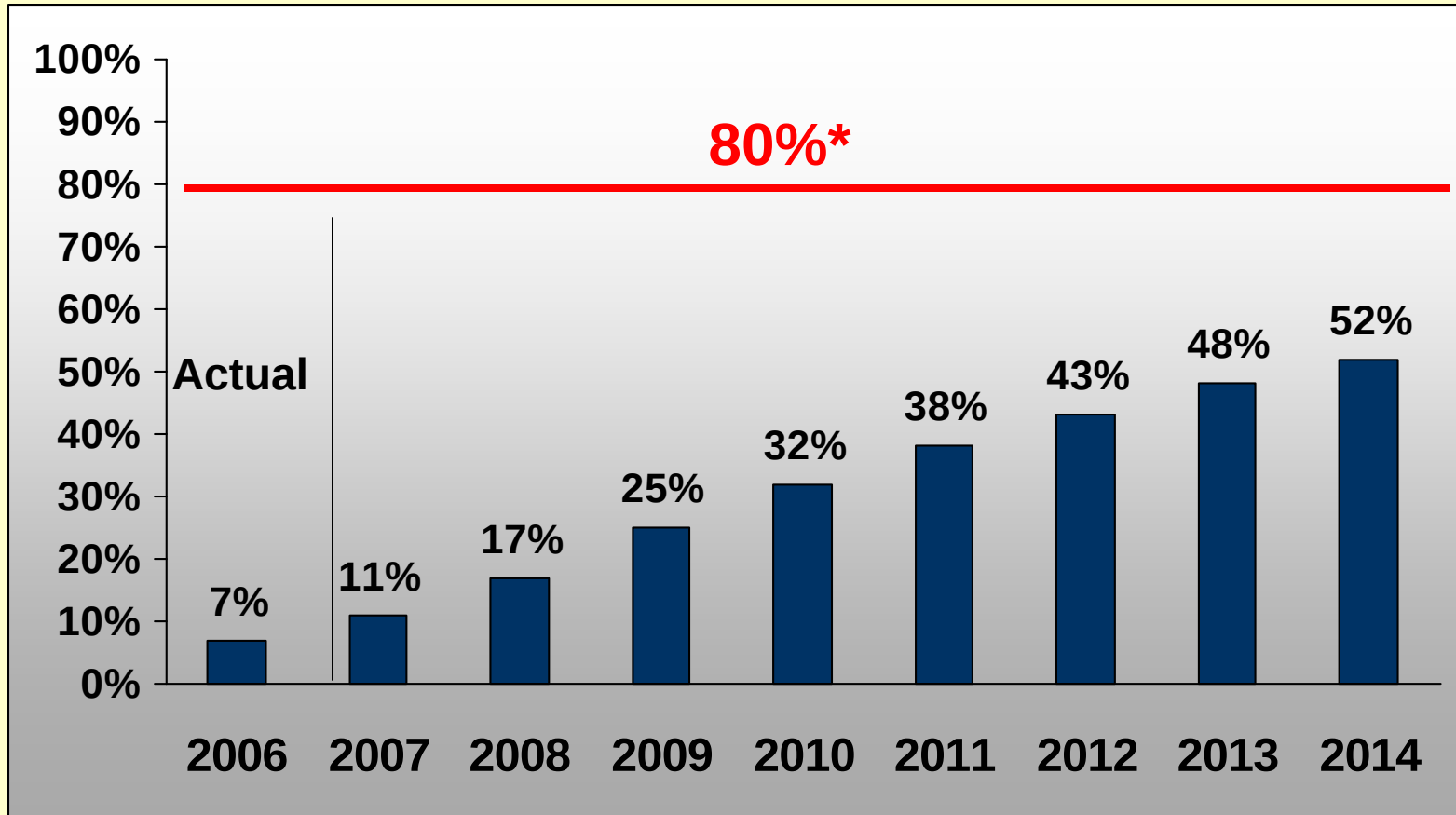

Form 1120: Implementation Schedule

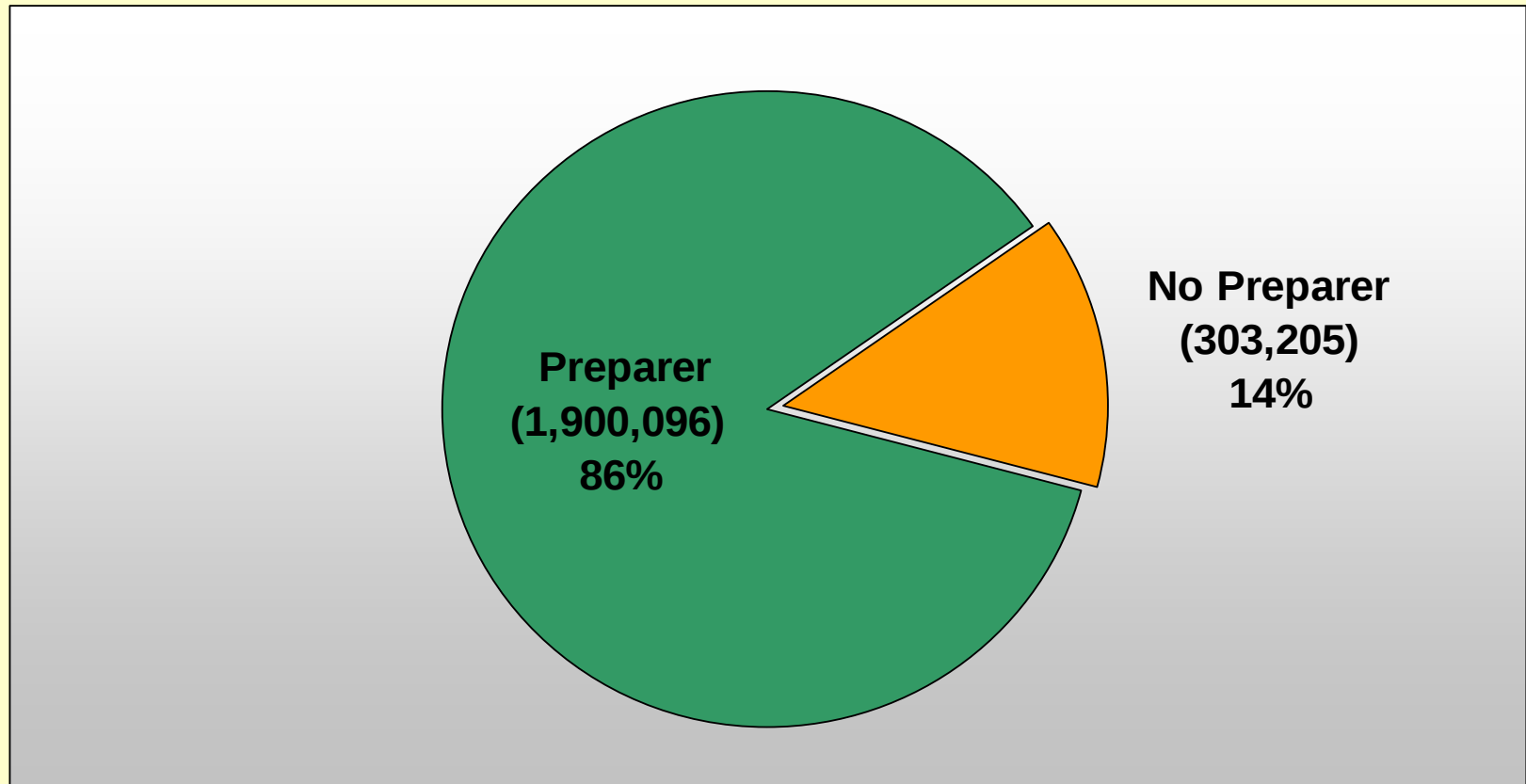


Form 1120 Projected *e-file* Penetration Rate



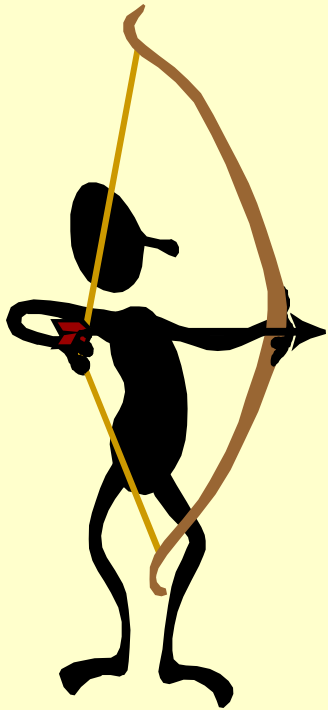

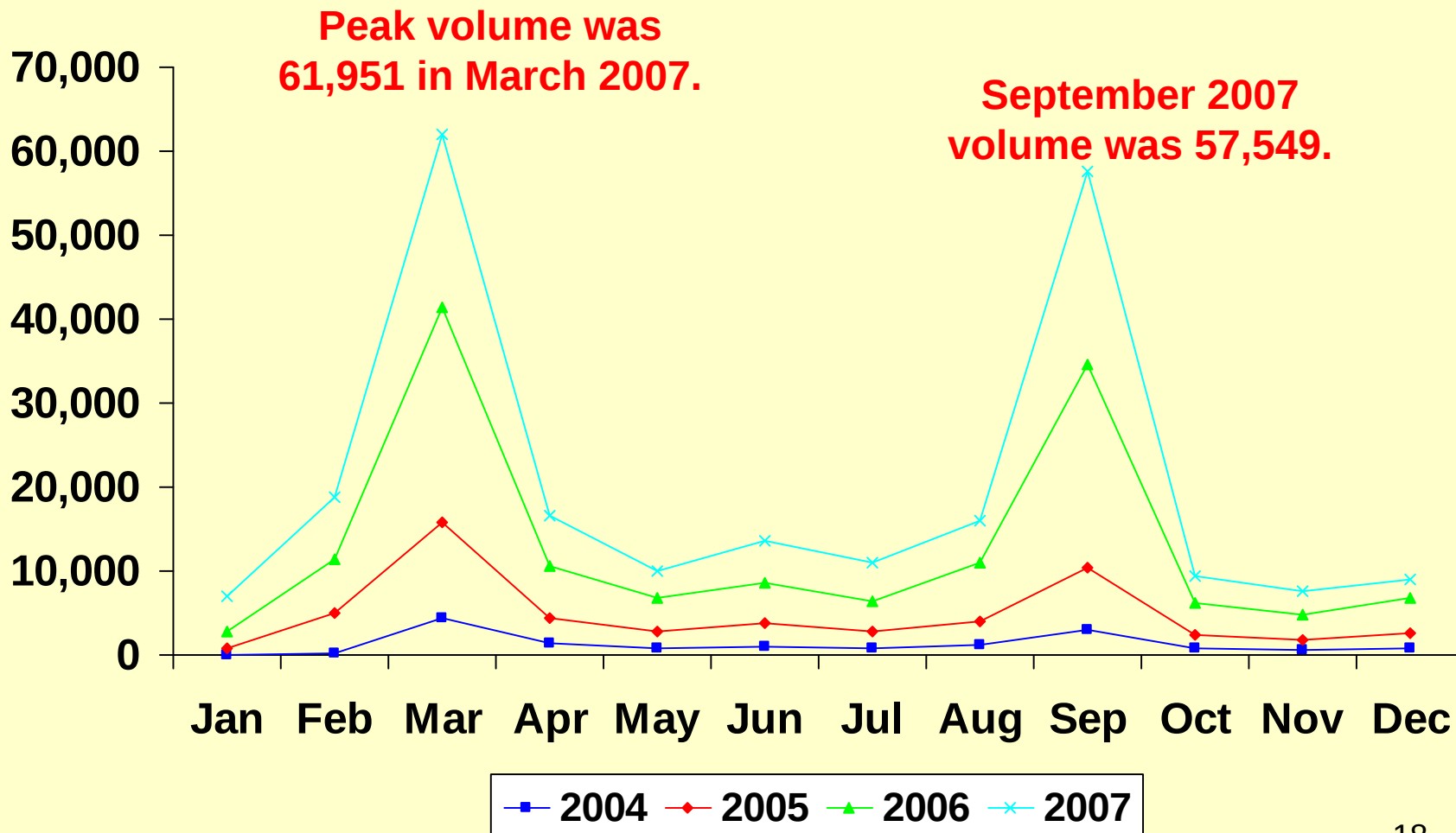

Form 1120: Monthly Filing Patterns

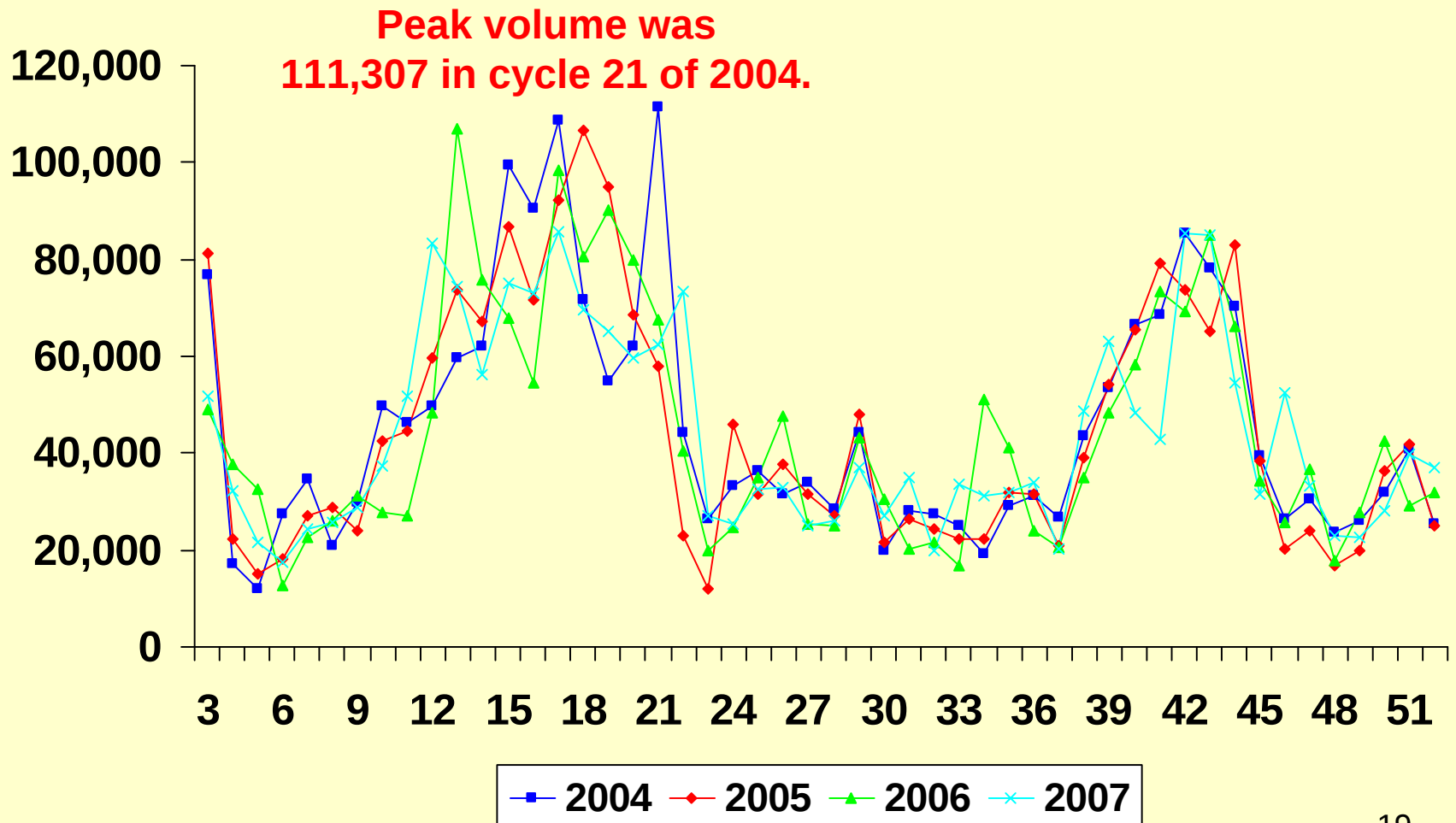

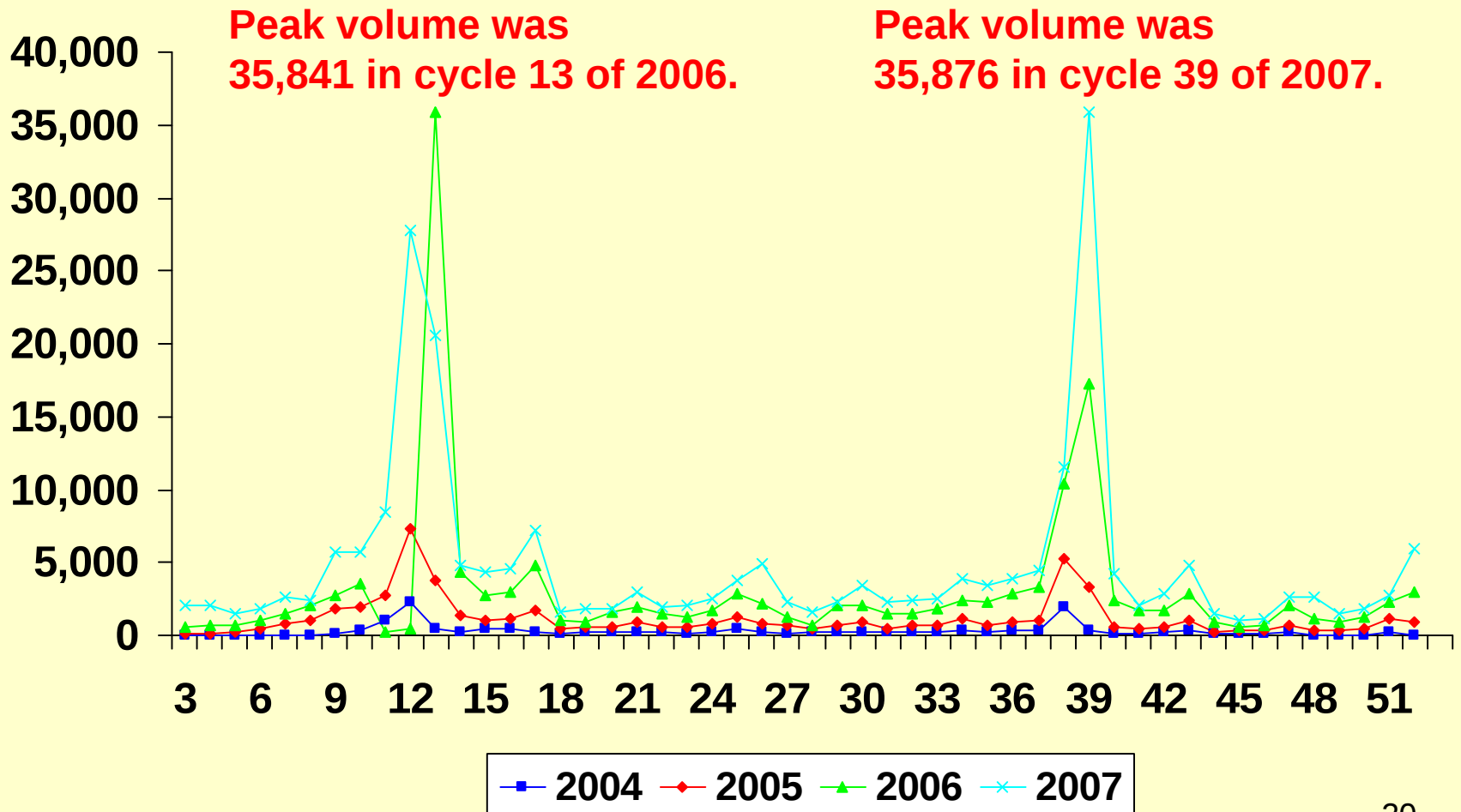

Filing Pattern by Cycle Posted

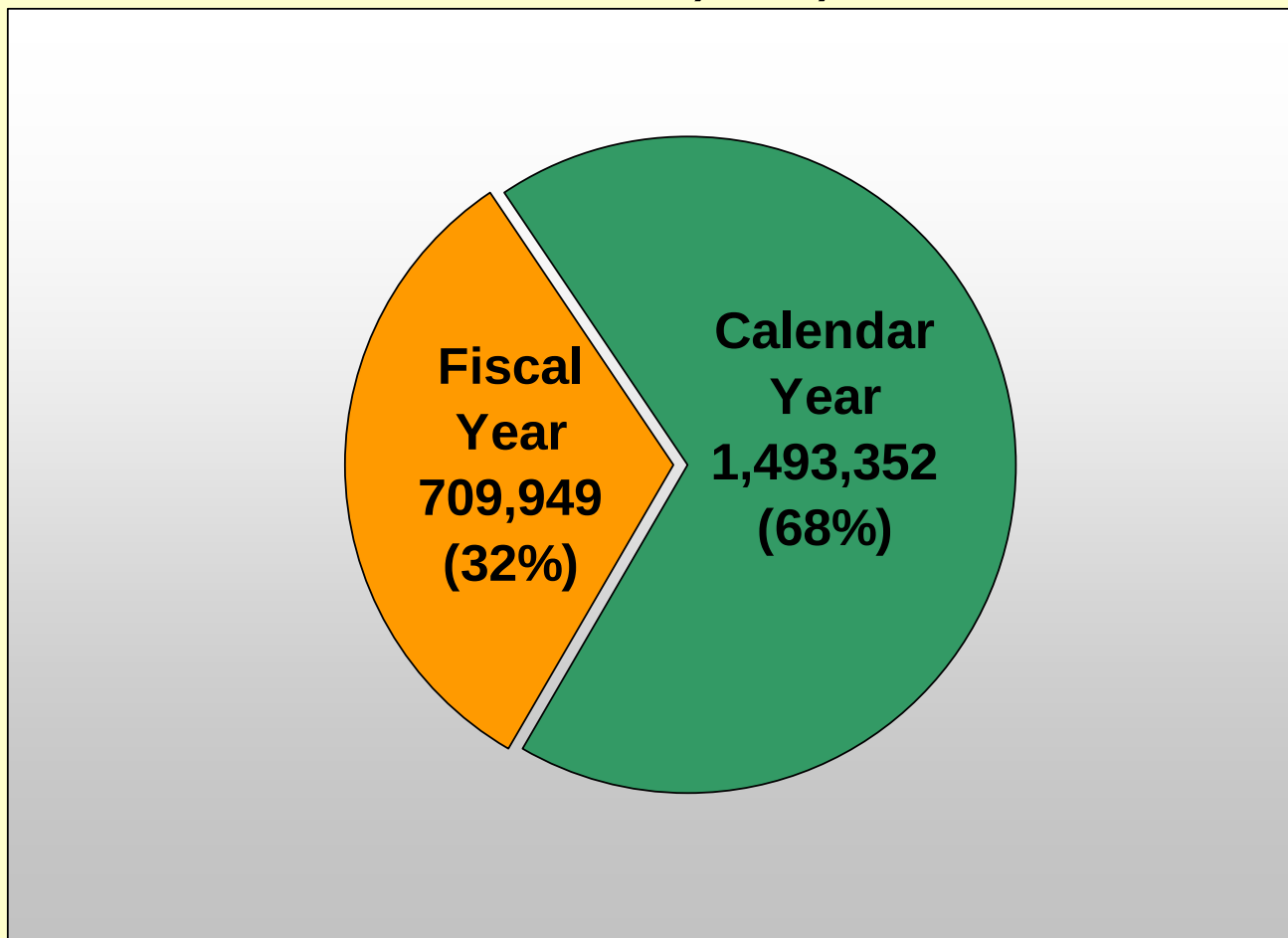


Form 1120 e-file Filing Pattern by Cycle Posted



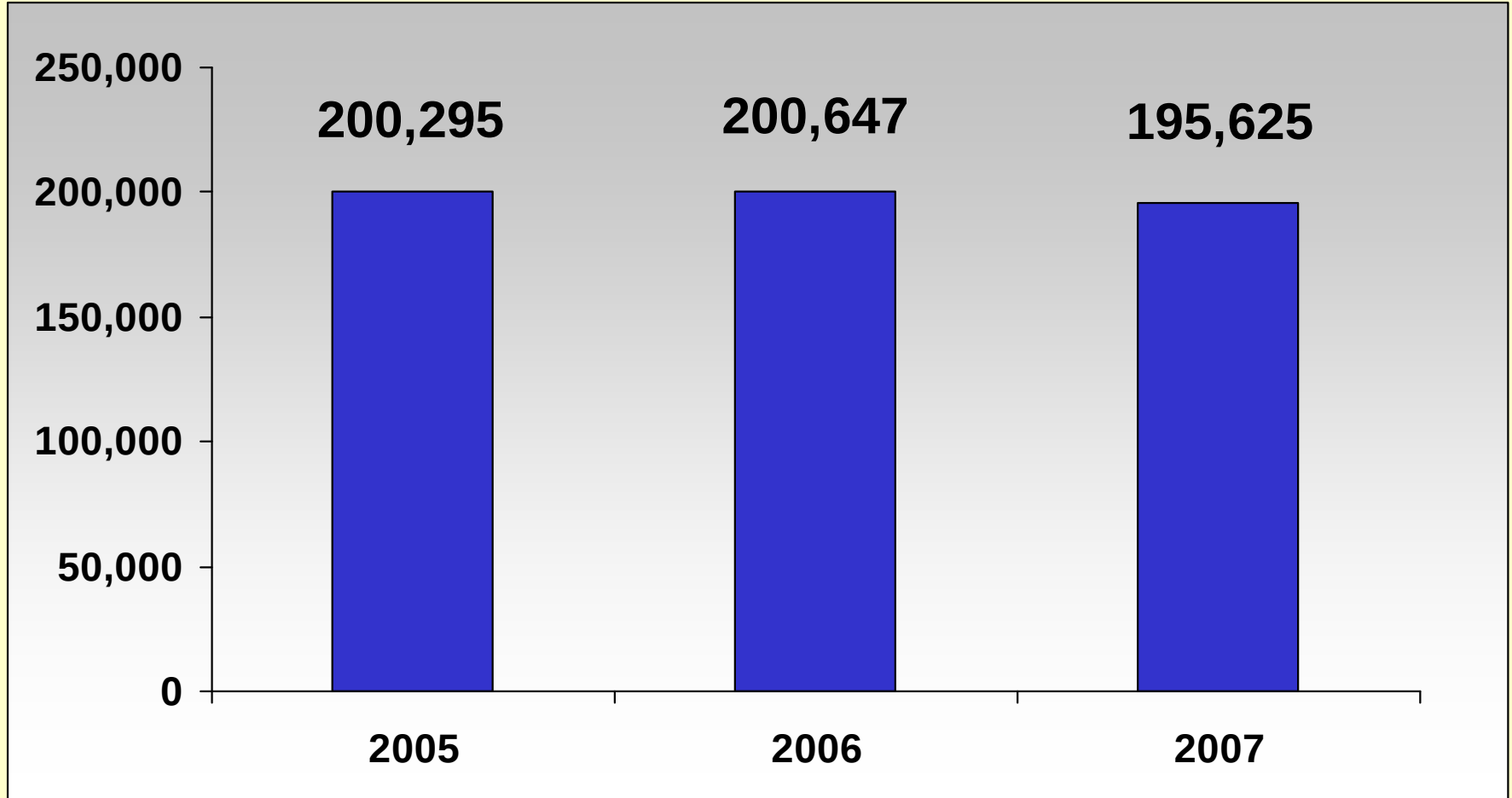
Form 1120 Fiscal Year Returns vs. Calendar Year Returns

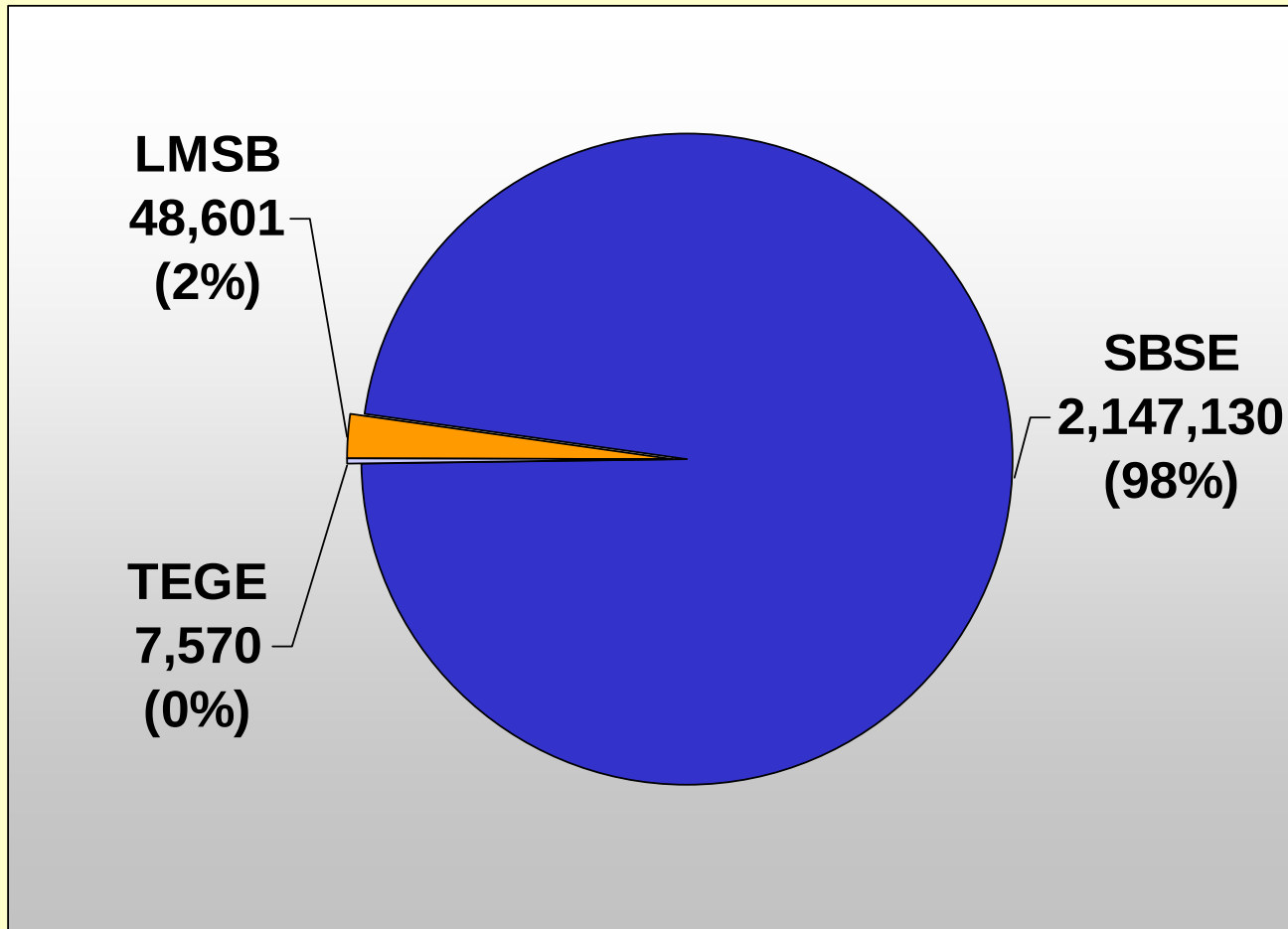

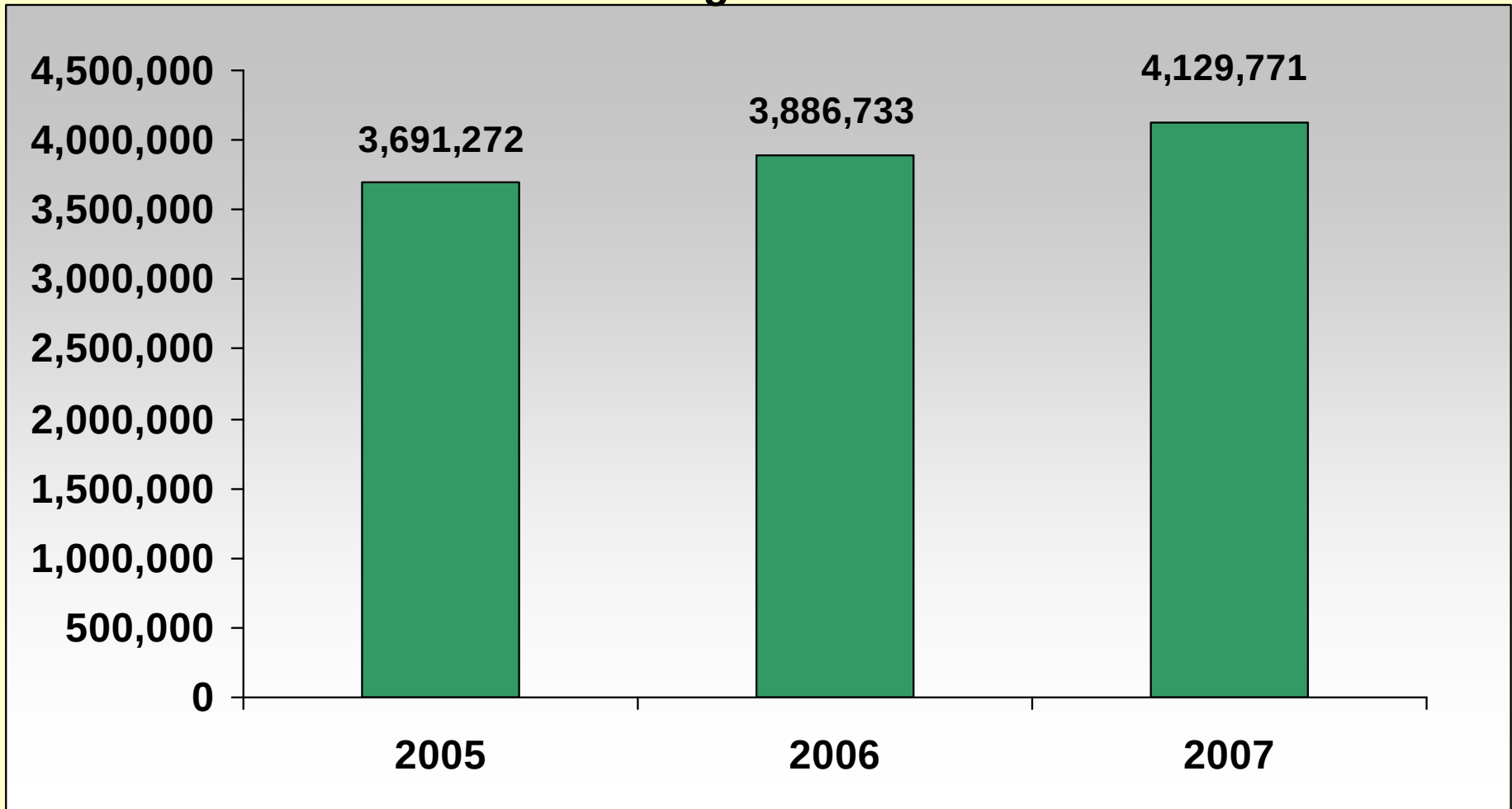

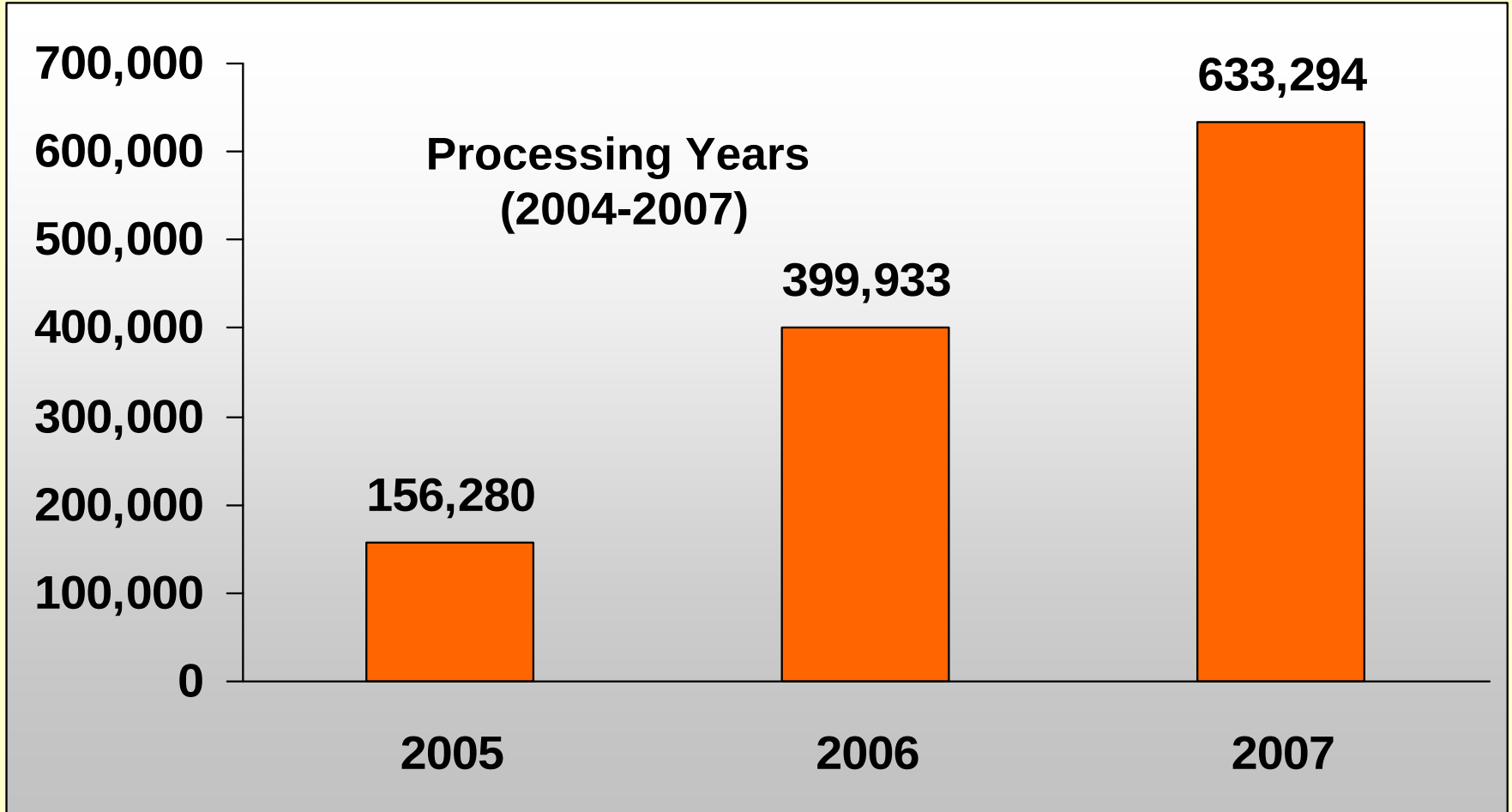


Form 1120S Annual Filing Volume

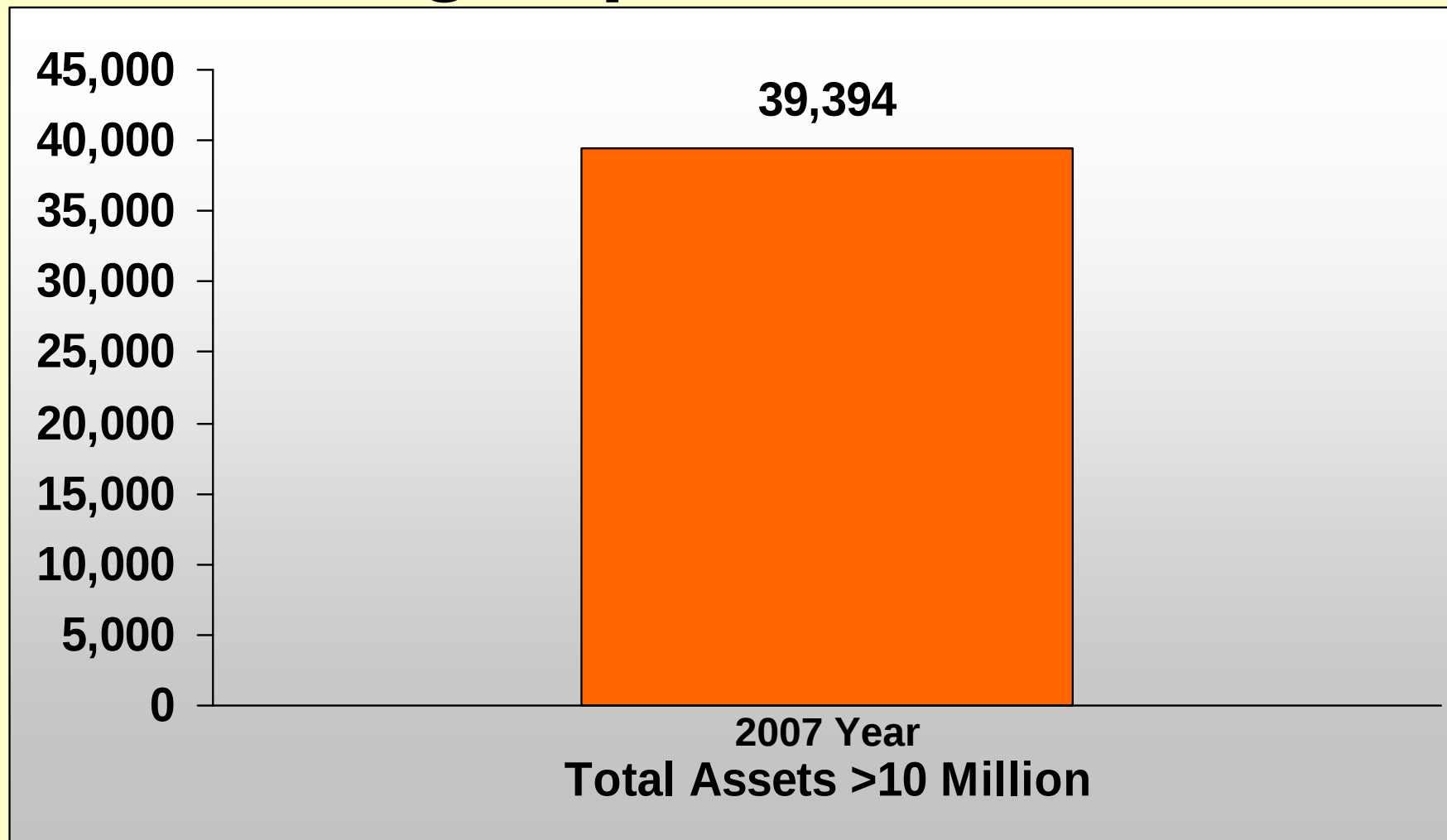


Annual e-file Volume for Form 1120S

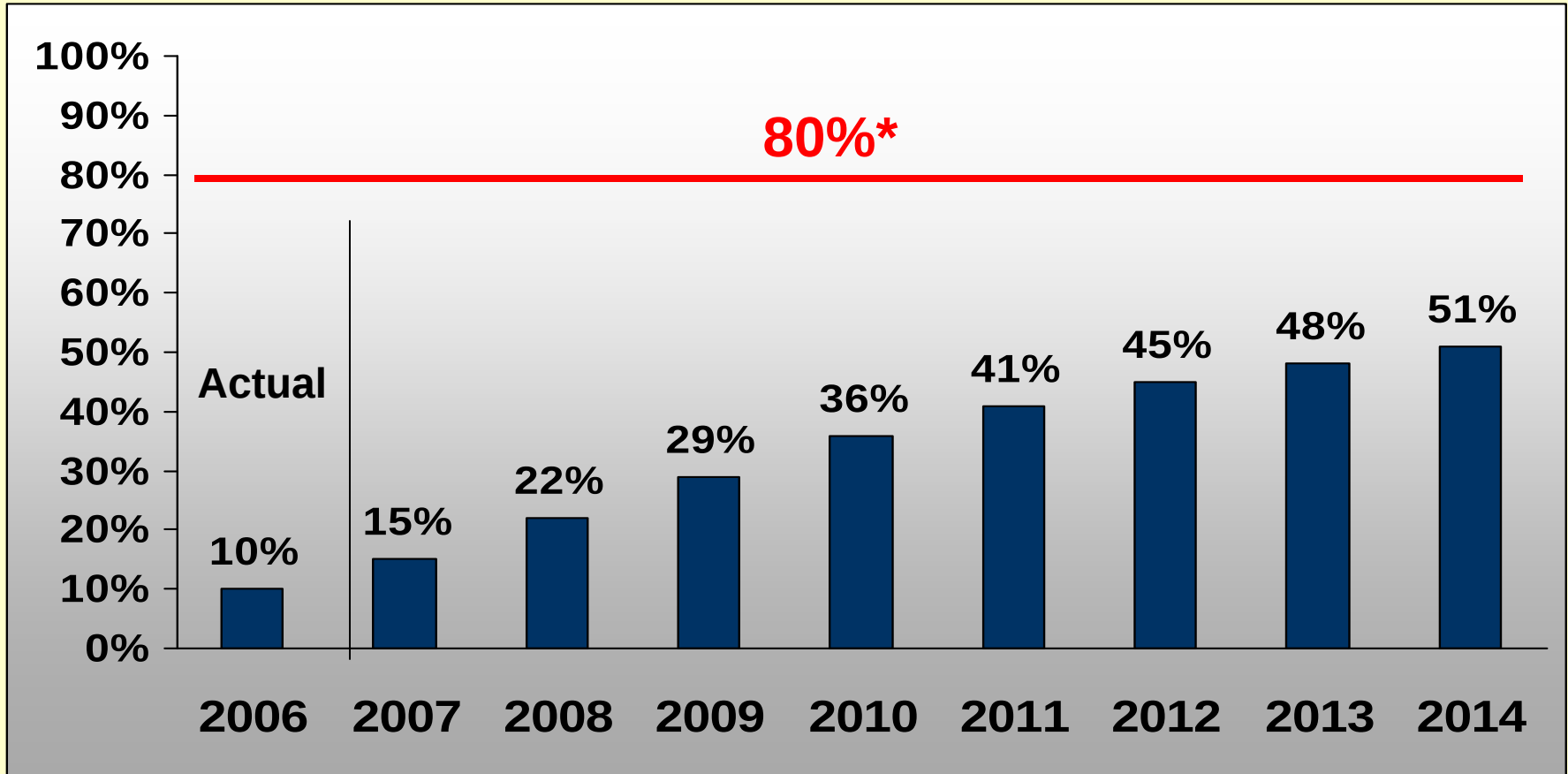

Form 1120S: Implementation Schedule

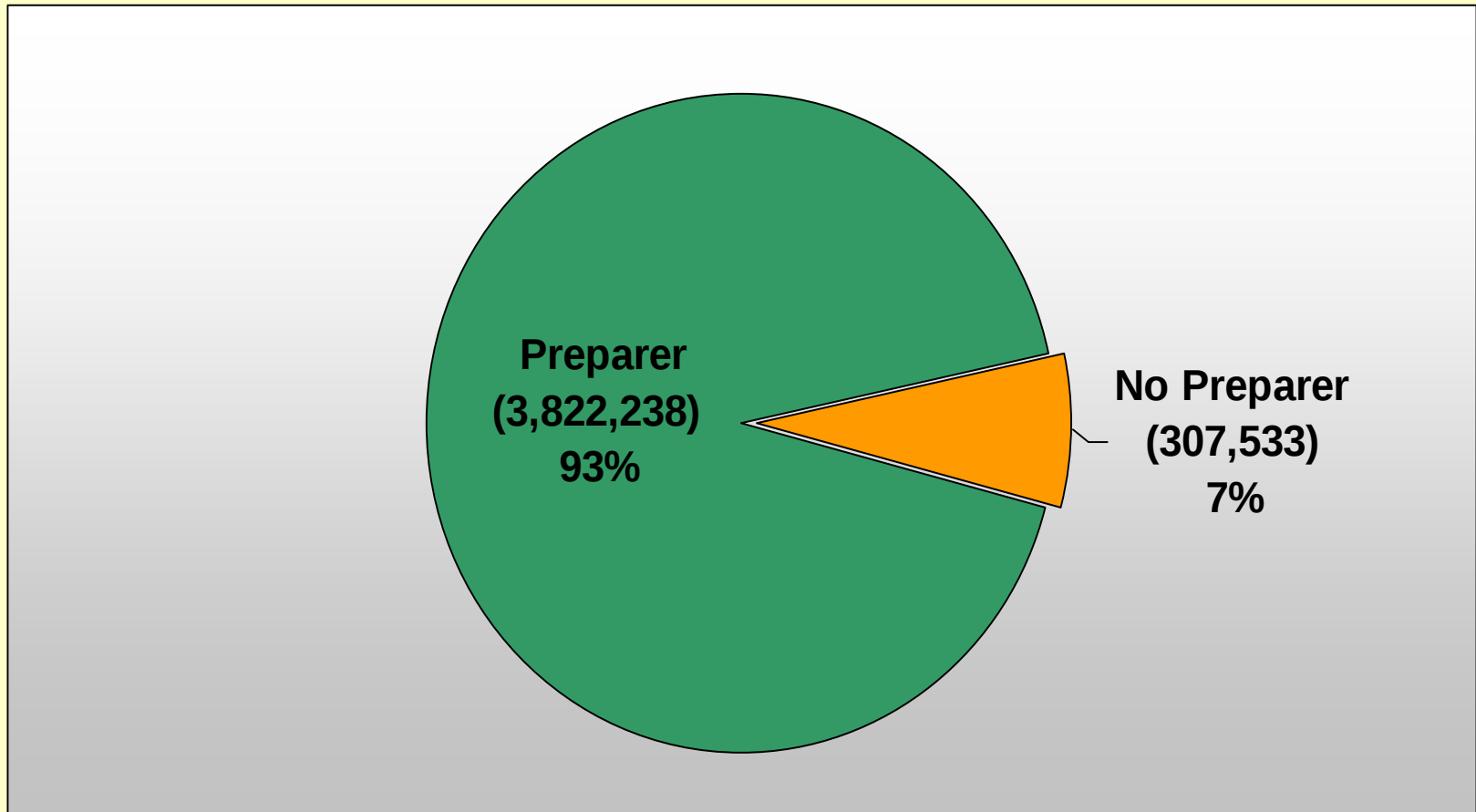


Form 1120S Projected *e-file* Penetration Rate



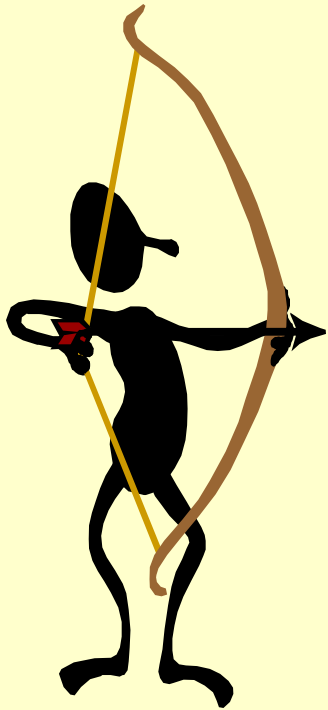

Form 1120S: Monthly Filing Patterns

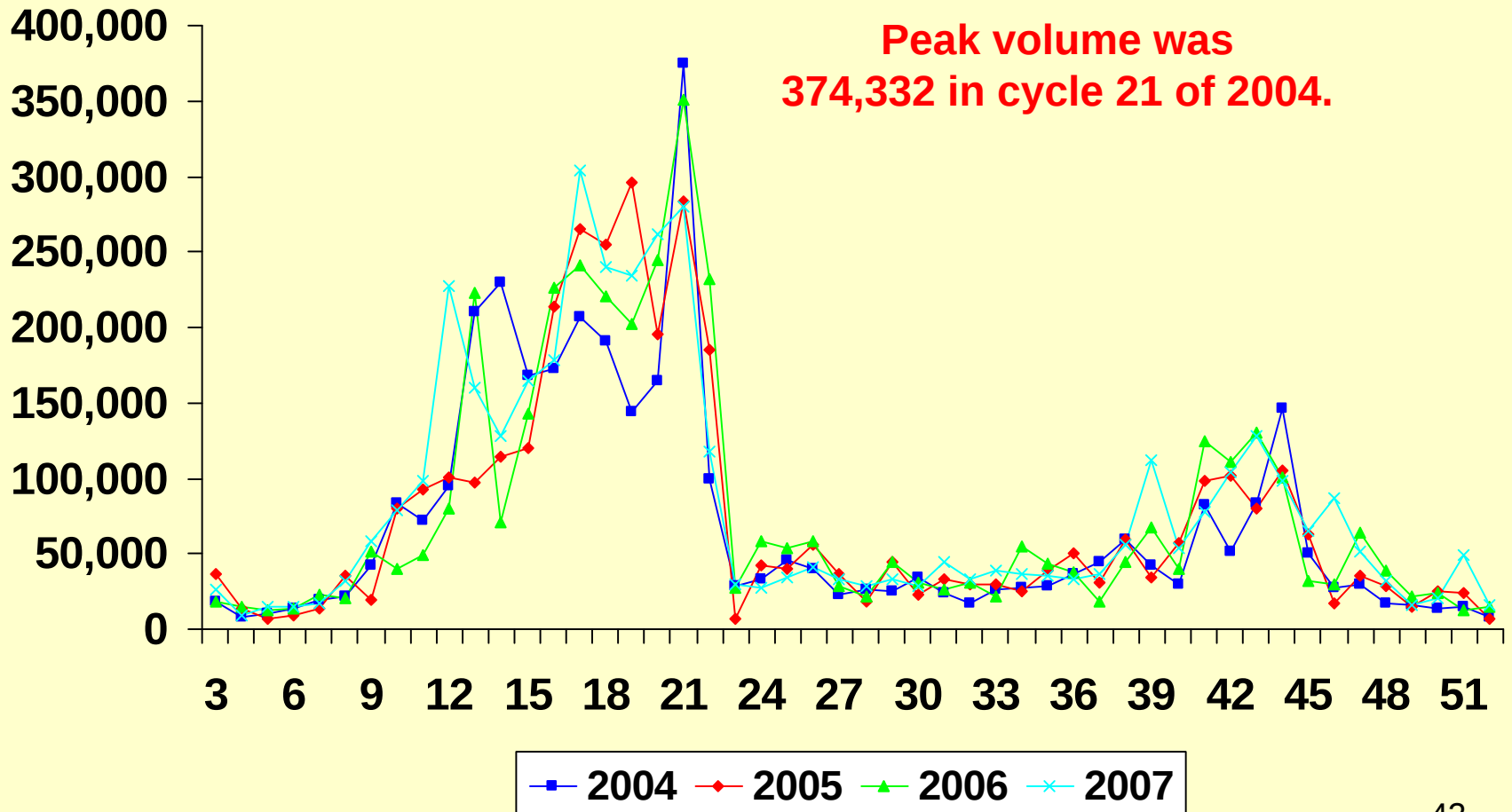

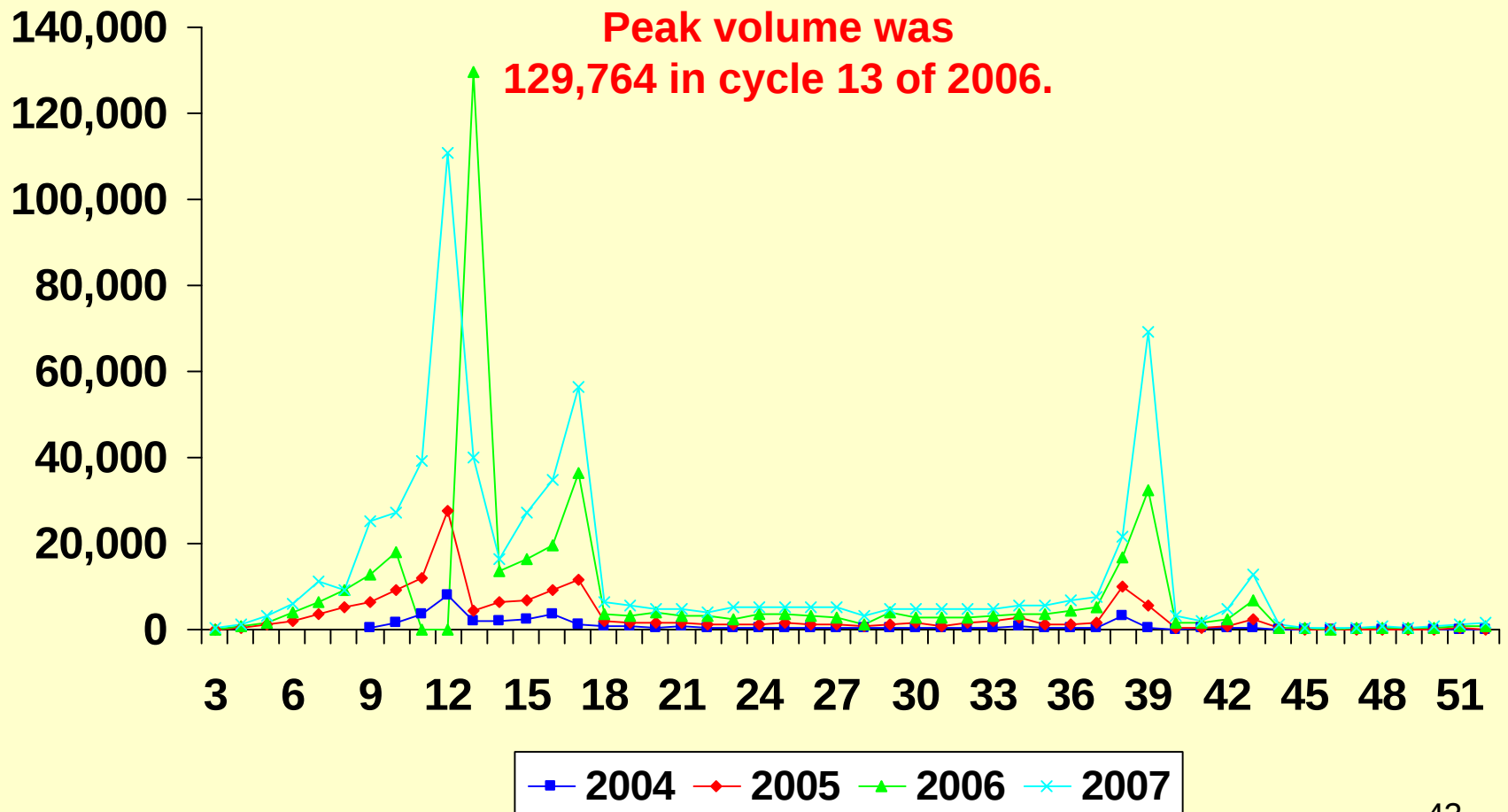

Filing Pattern by Cycle Posted

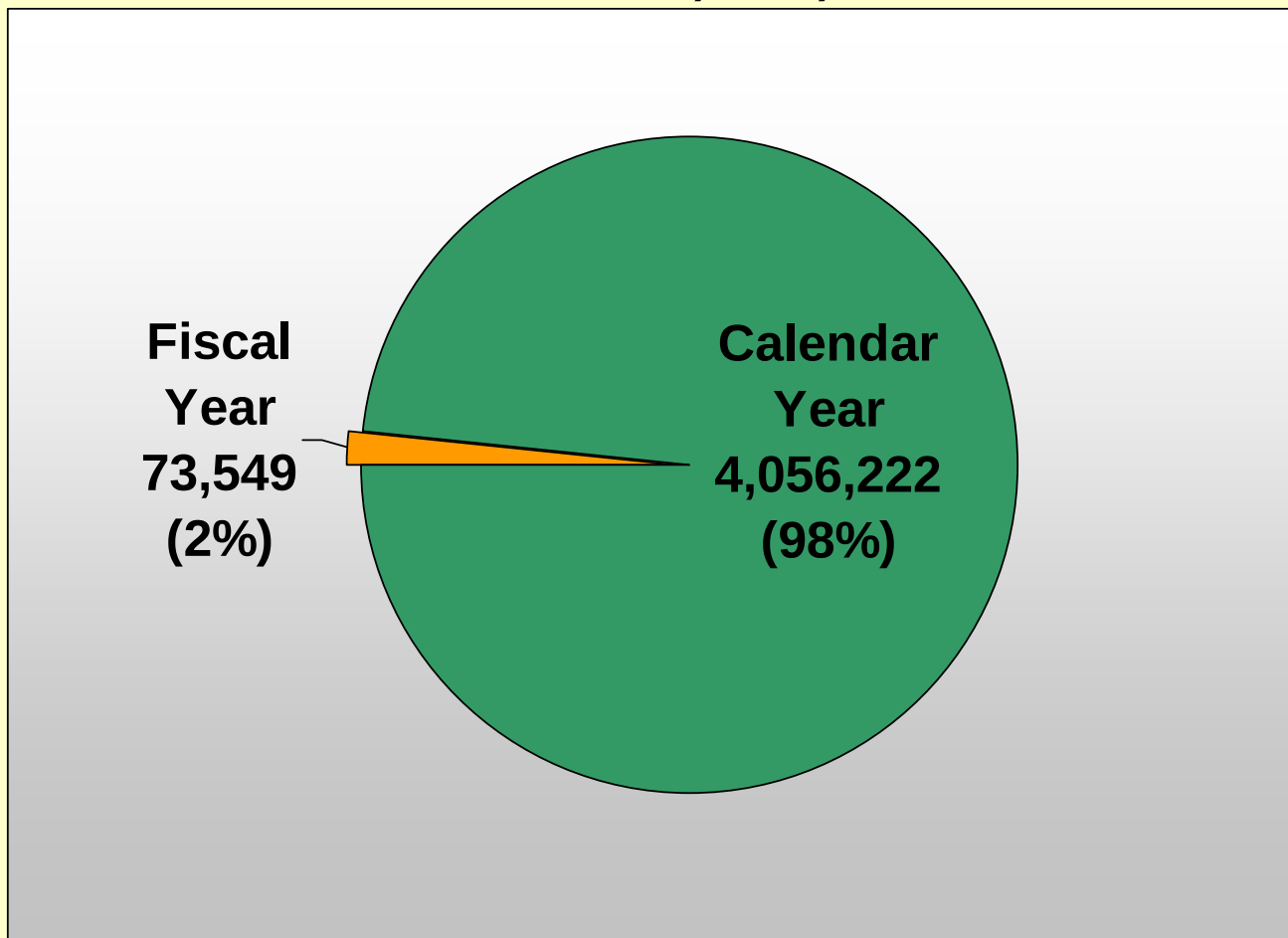


Form 1120S e-file Filing Pattern by Cycle Posted



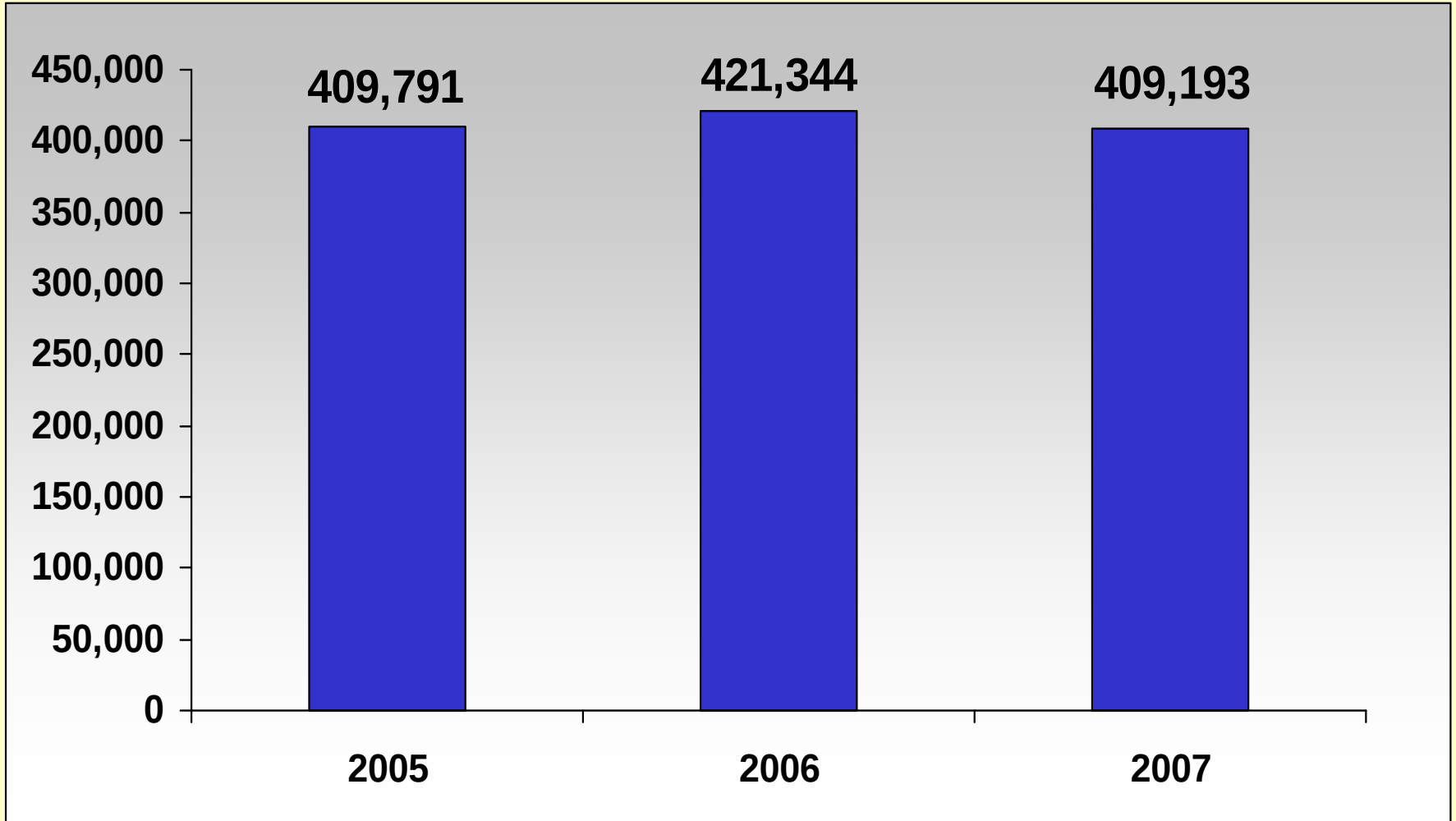
Form 1120S Fiscal Year Returns vs. Calendar Year Returns

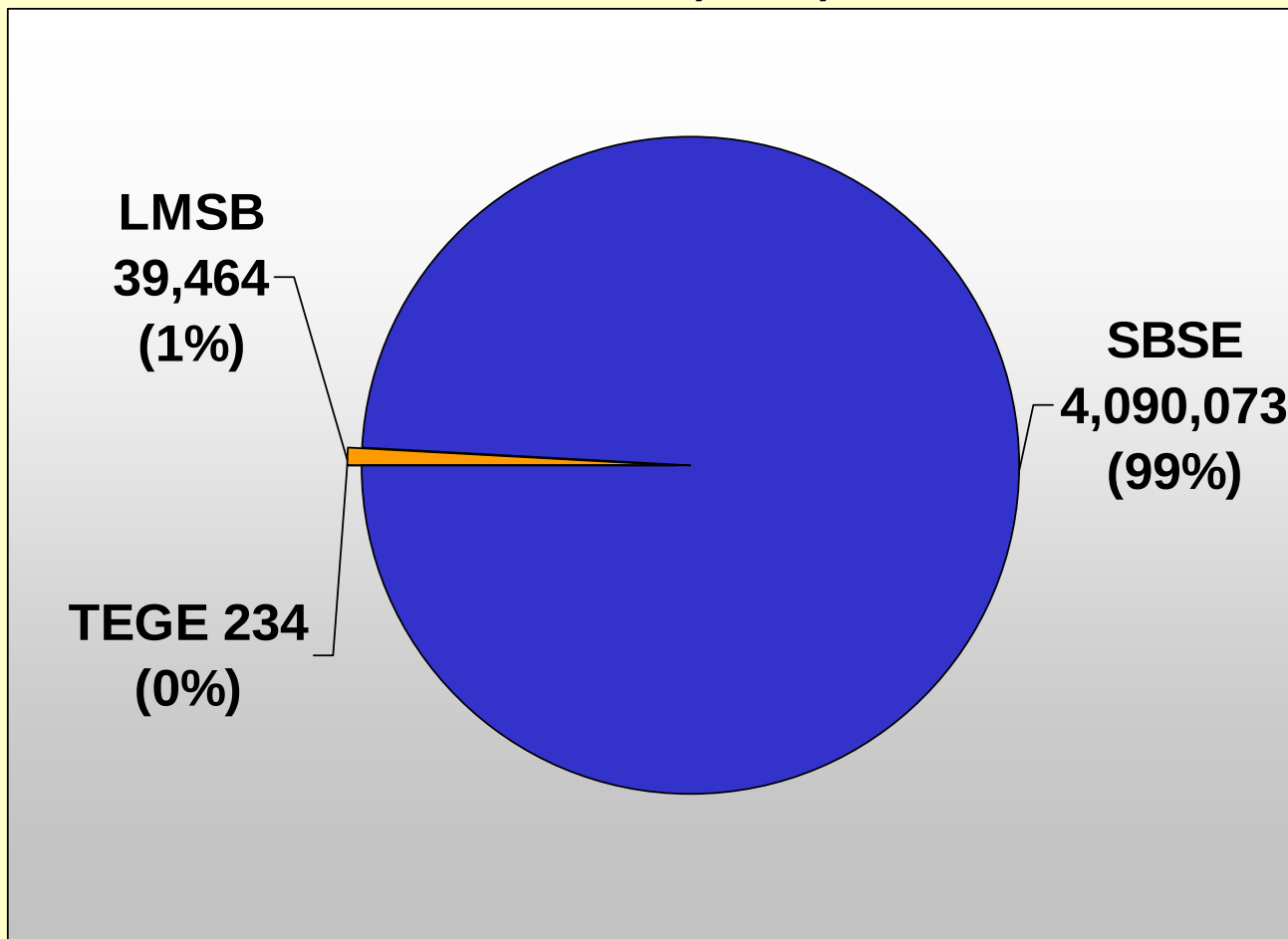

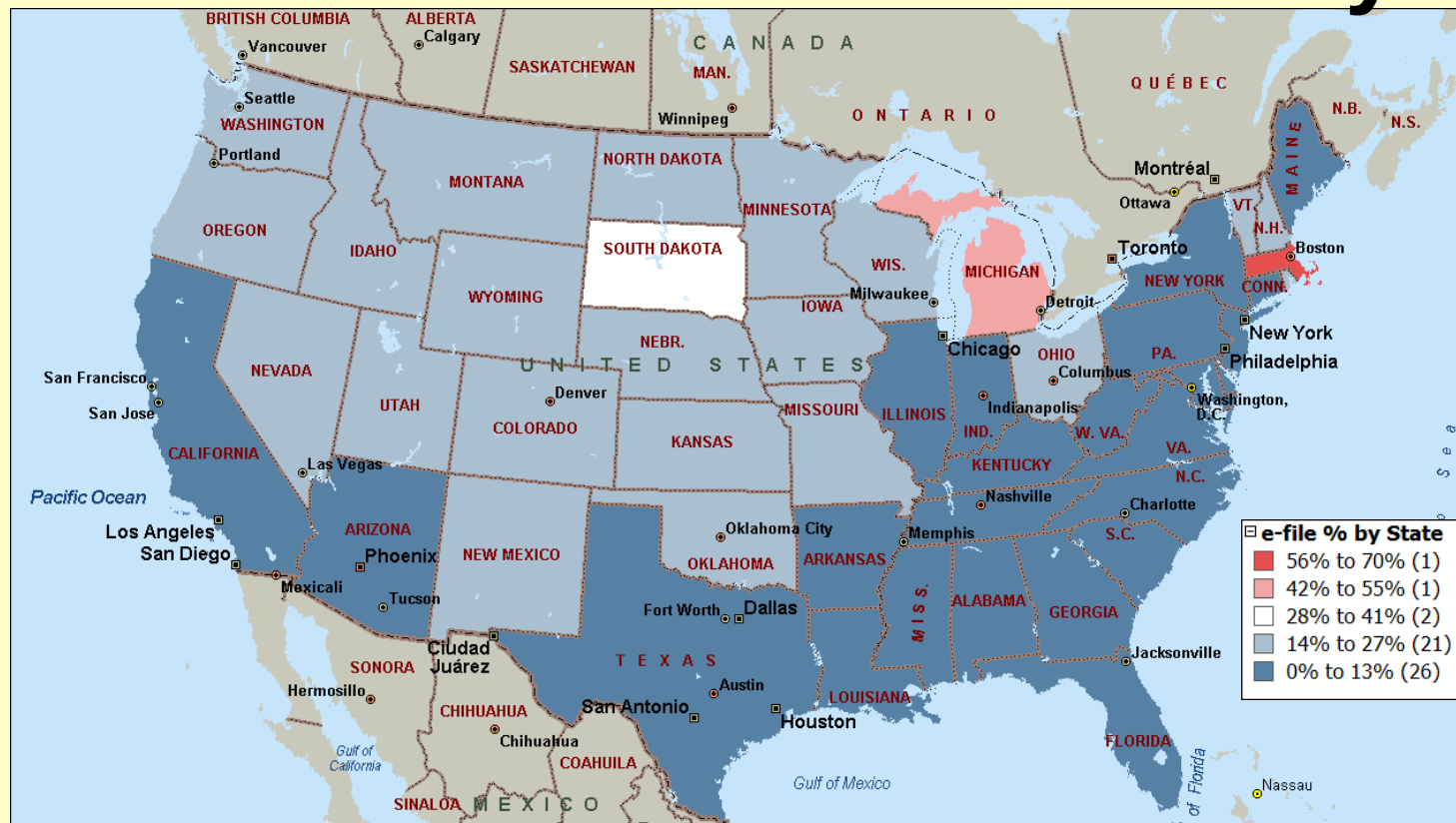

- 41% of Form 1120 & 38% of Form 1120S taxpayers are enrolled in EFTPS.
- 31% of Form 1120 Series payments are electronic.
- Forms 1120 & 1120S have two peak volume filing months: March and September.
- SB/SE accounts for 98% of Forms 1120 and 99% of Forms 1120S filed.
- 86% of Form 1120 & 93% of Form 1120S filers use a preparer.

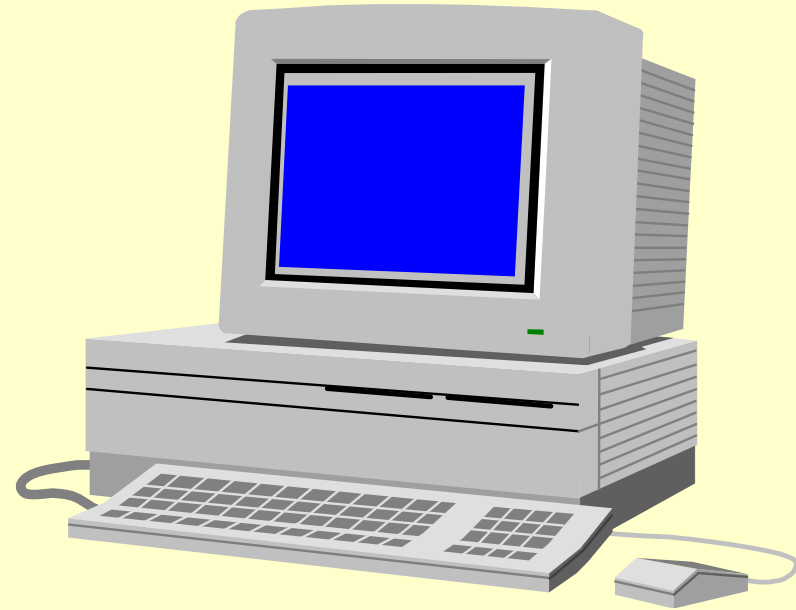

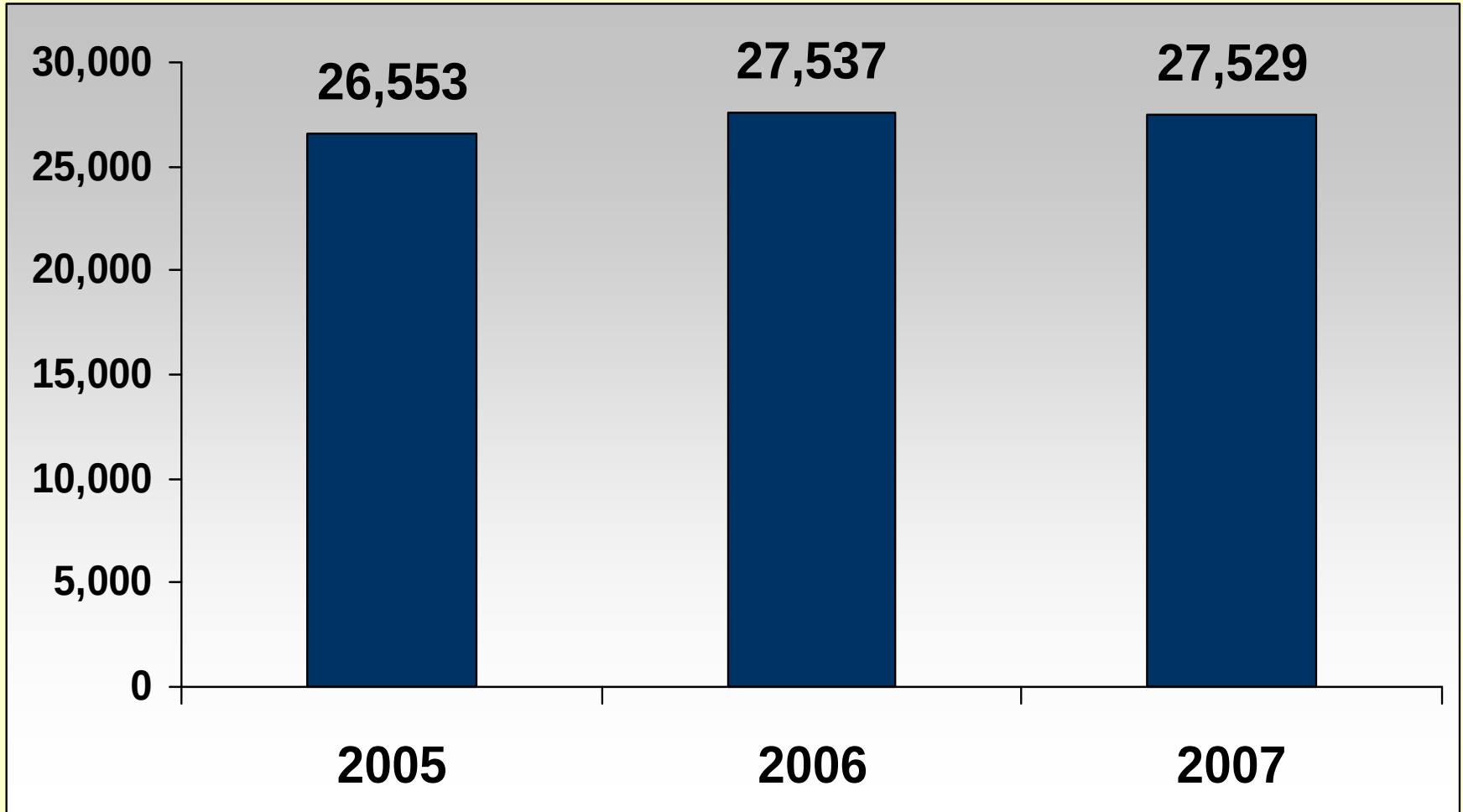
U.S. Income Tax Return of a Foreign Corporation

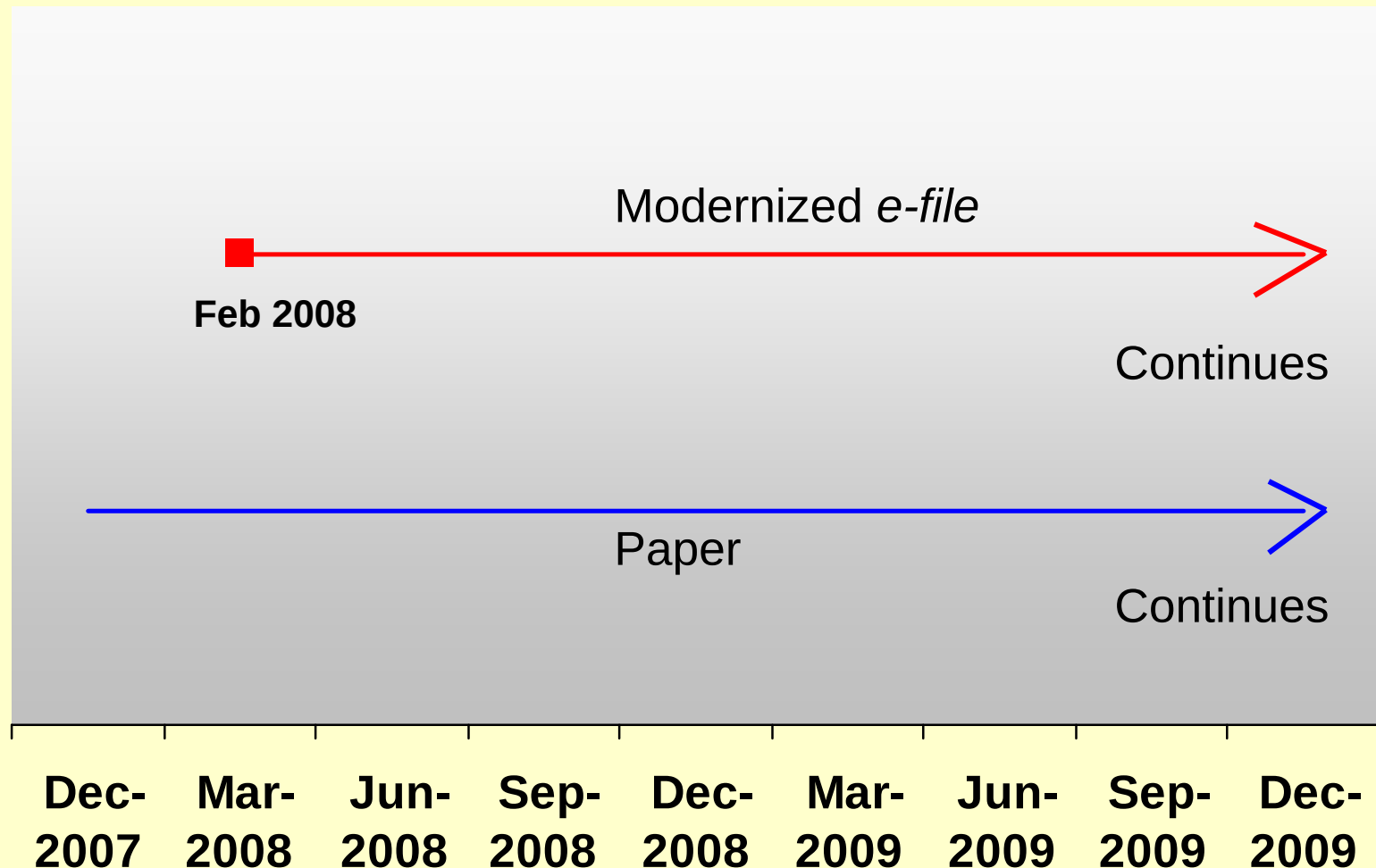

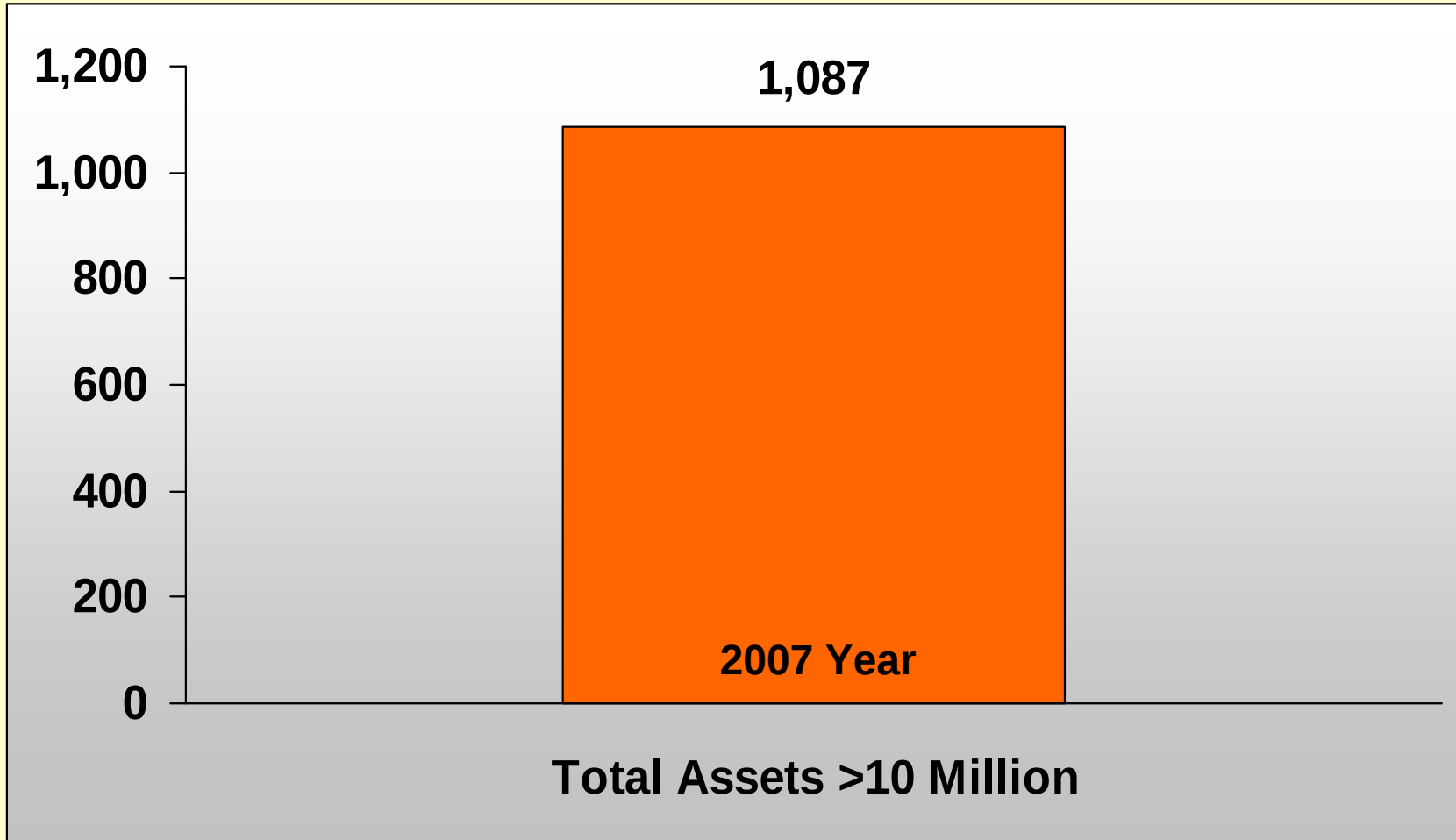

Form 1120F: Implementation Schedule



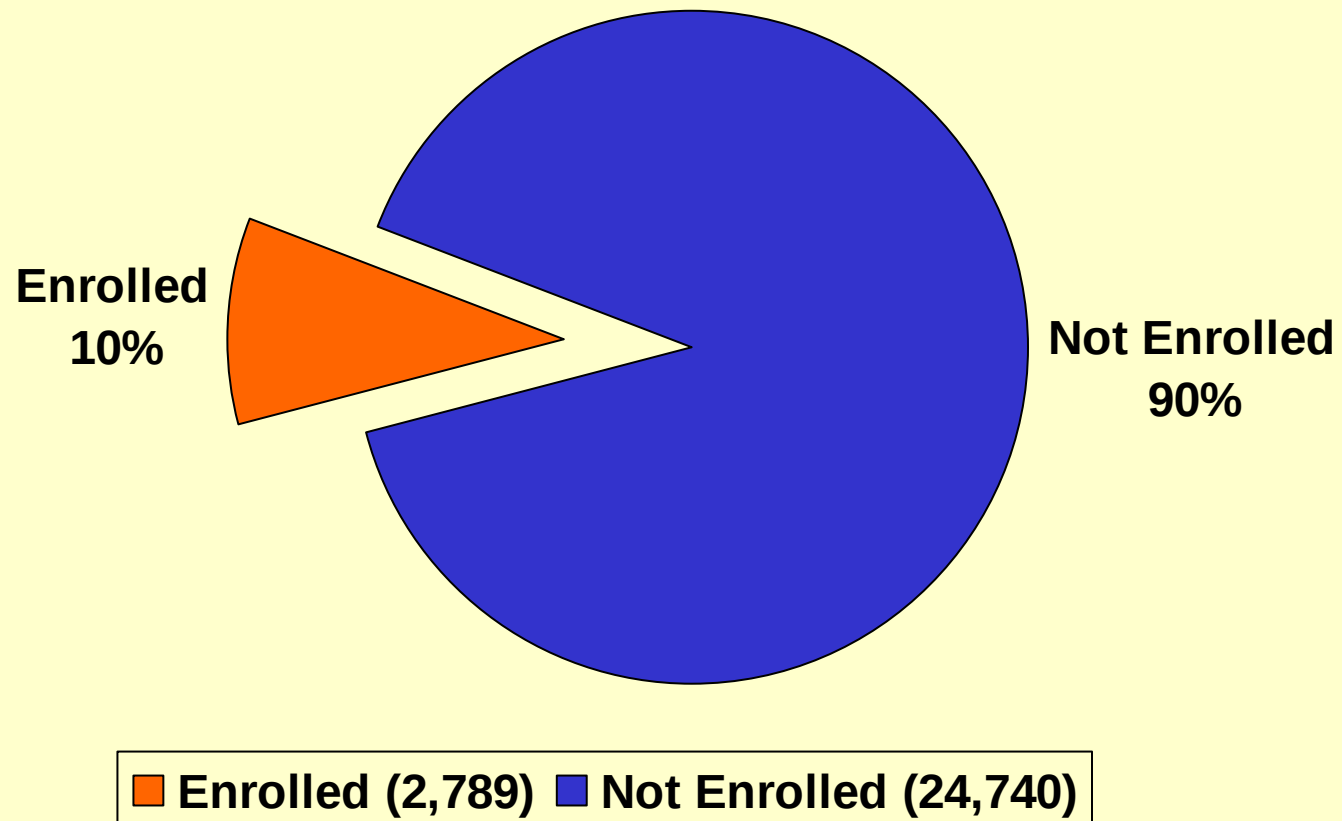
Form 1120F Filers Impacted If *e-file* Mandates Implemented



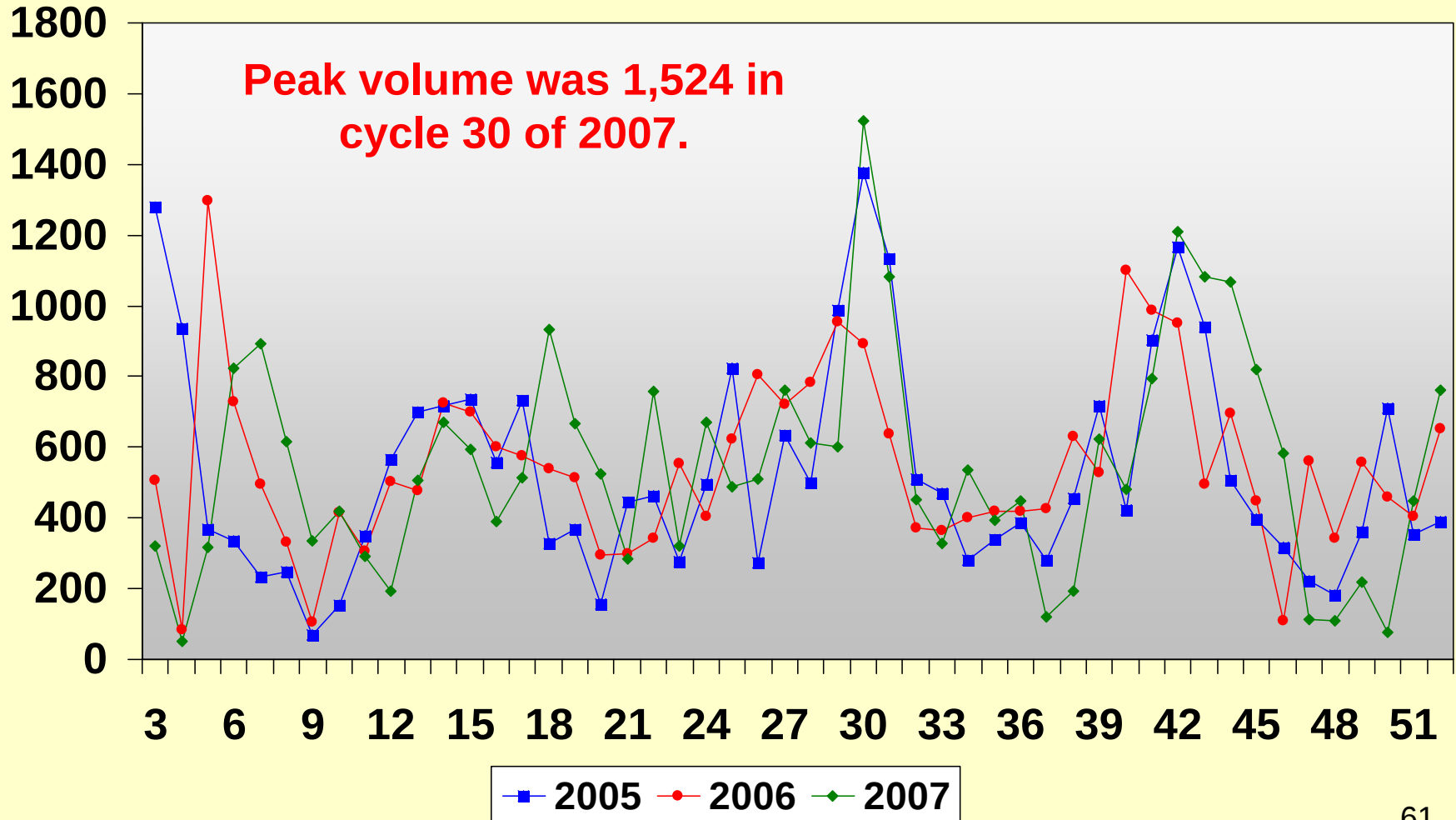

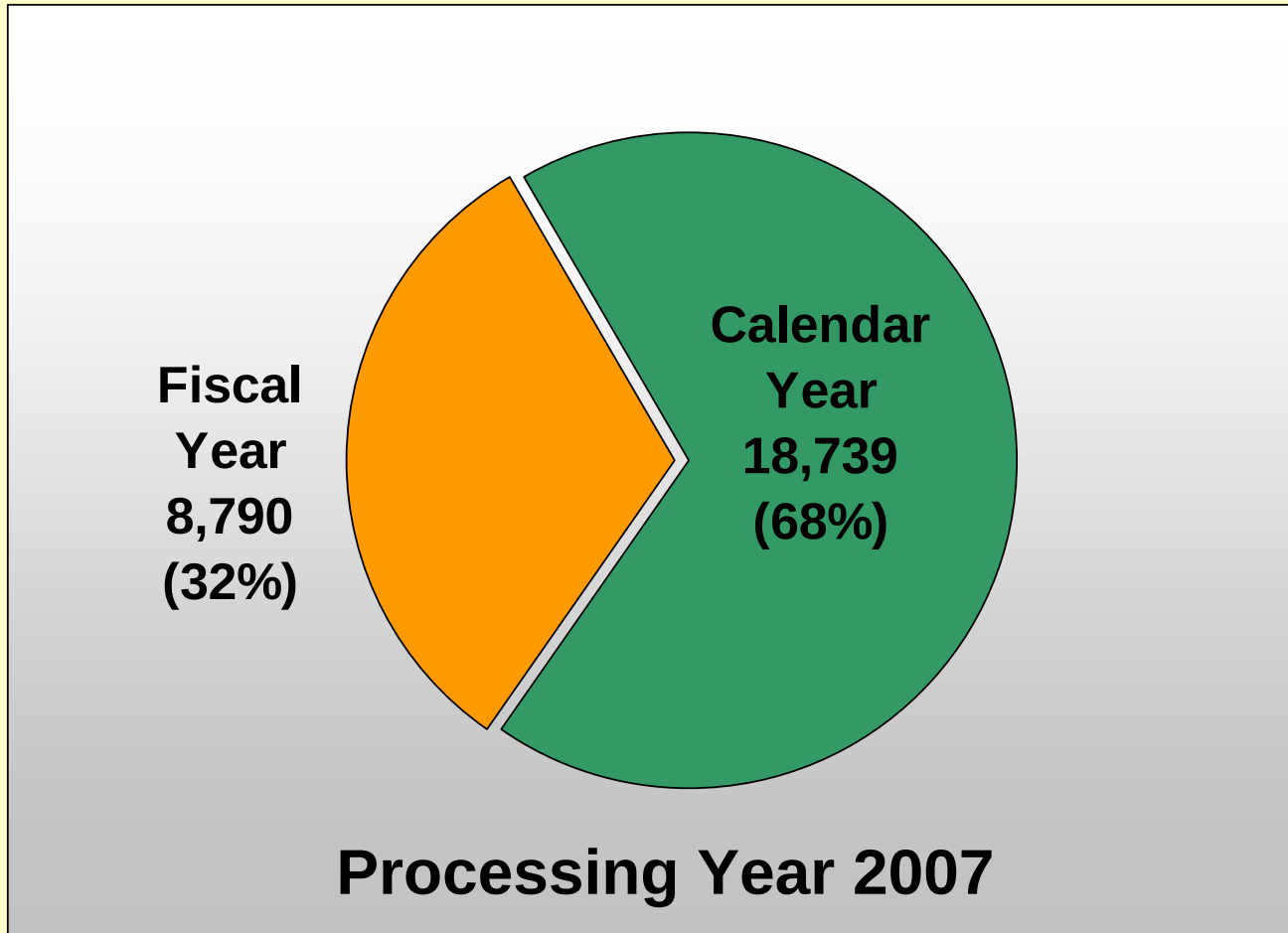


Form 1120F Filing Patterns by Cycle Posted



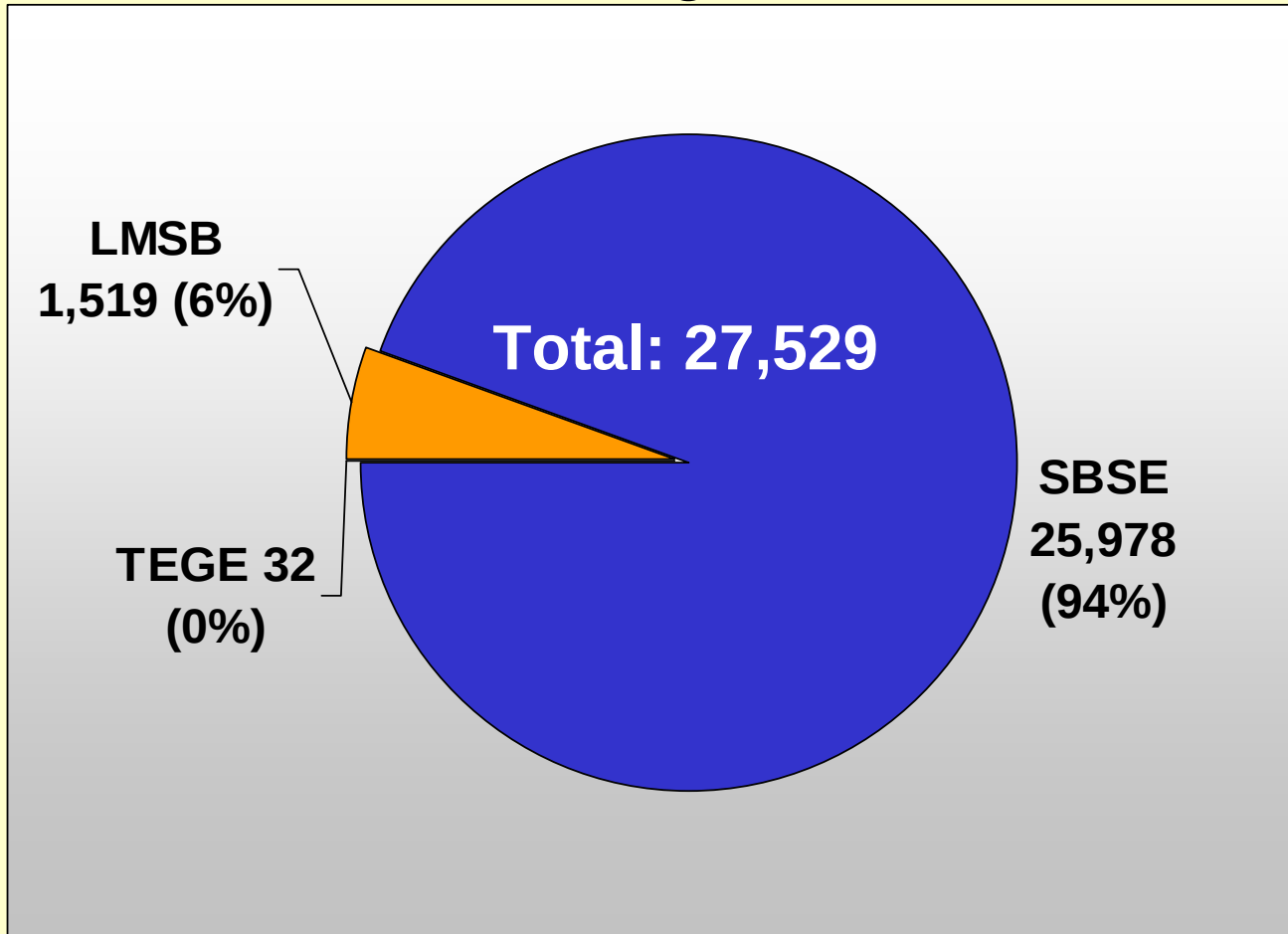
Form 1120F Fiscal Year Returns vs. Calendar Year Returns

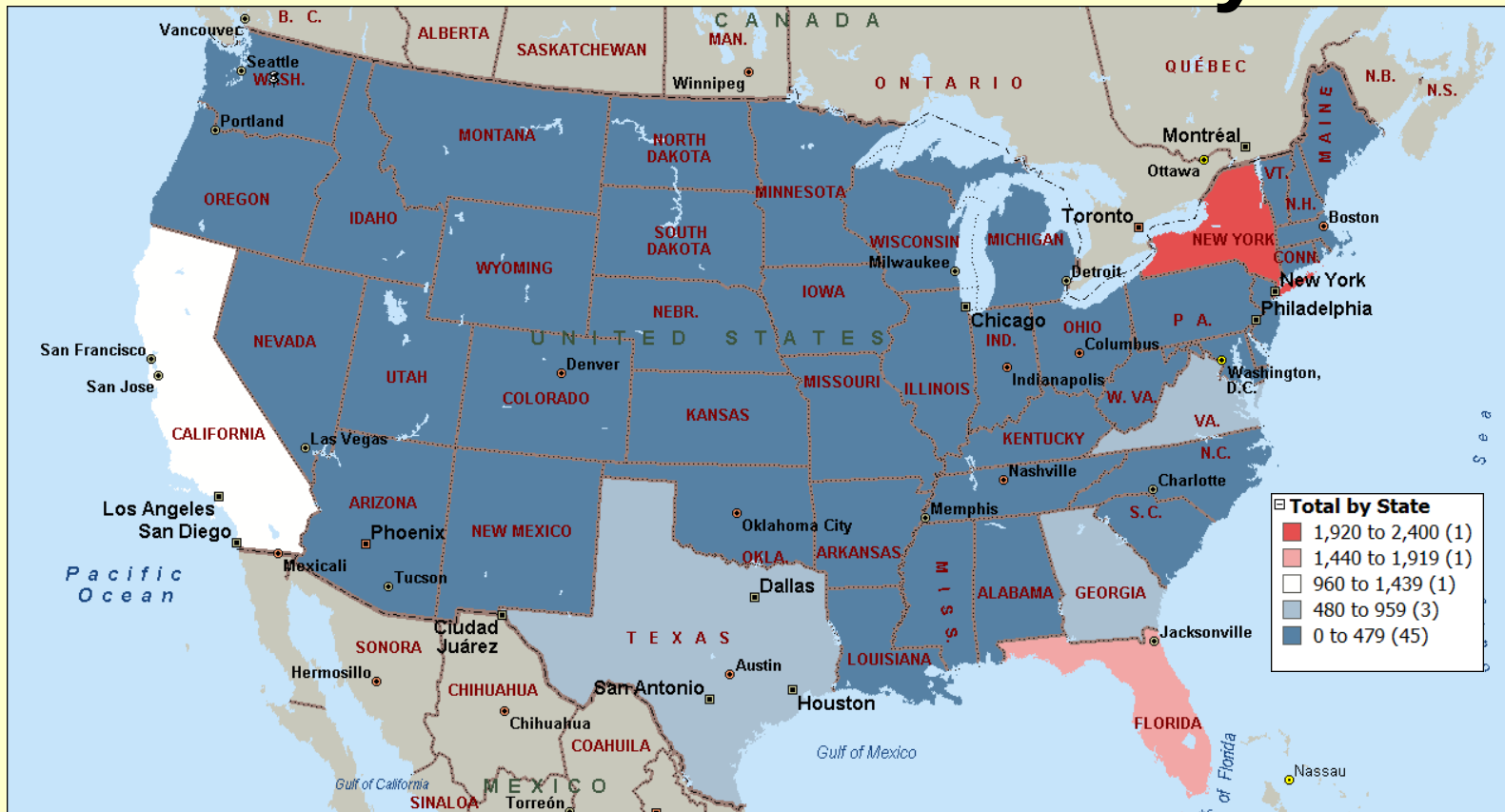

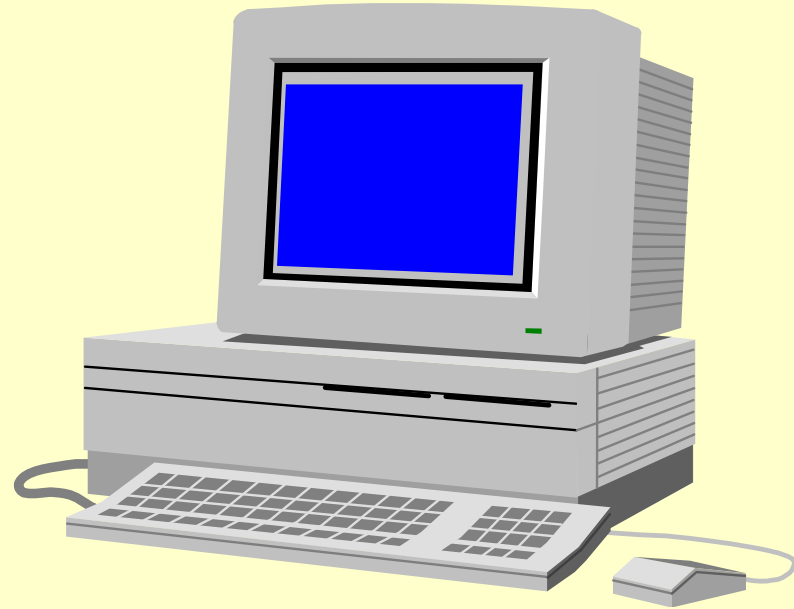
Return of Partnership Income

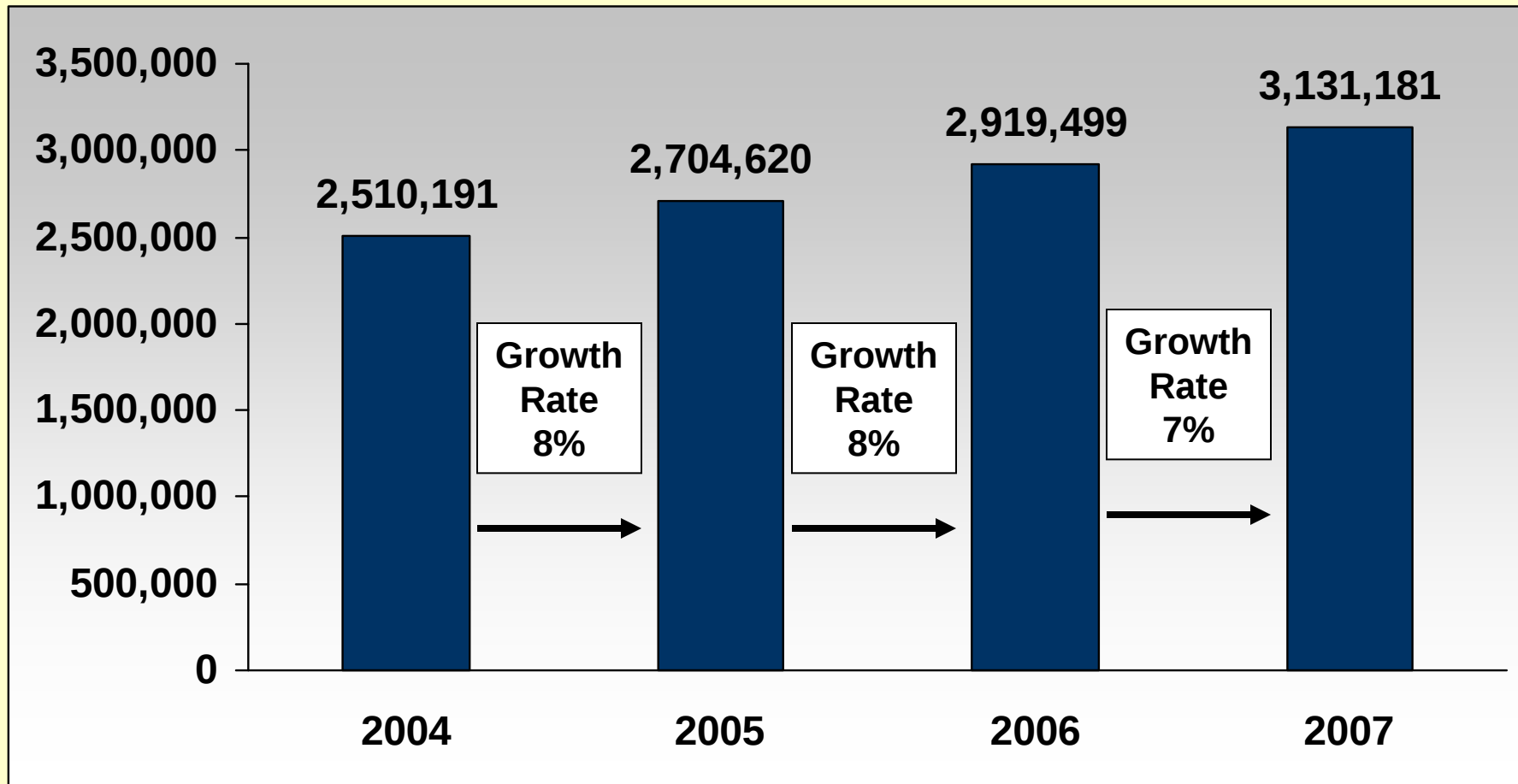

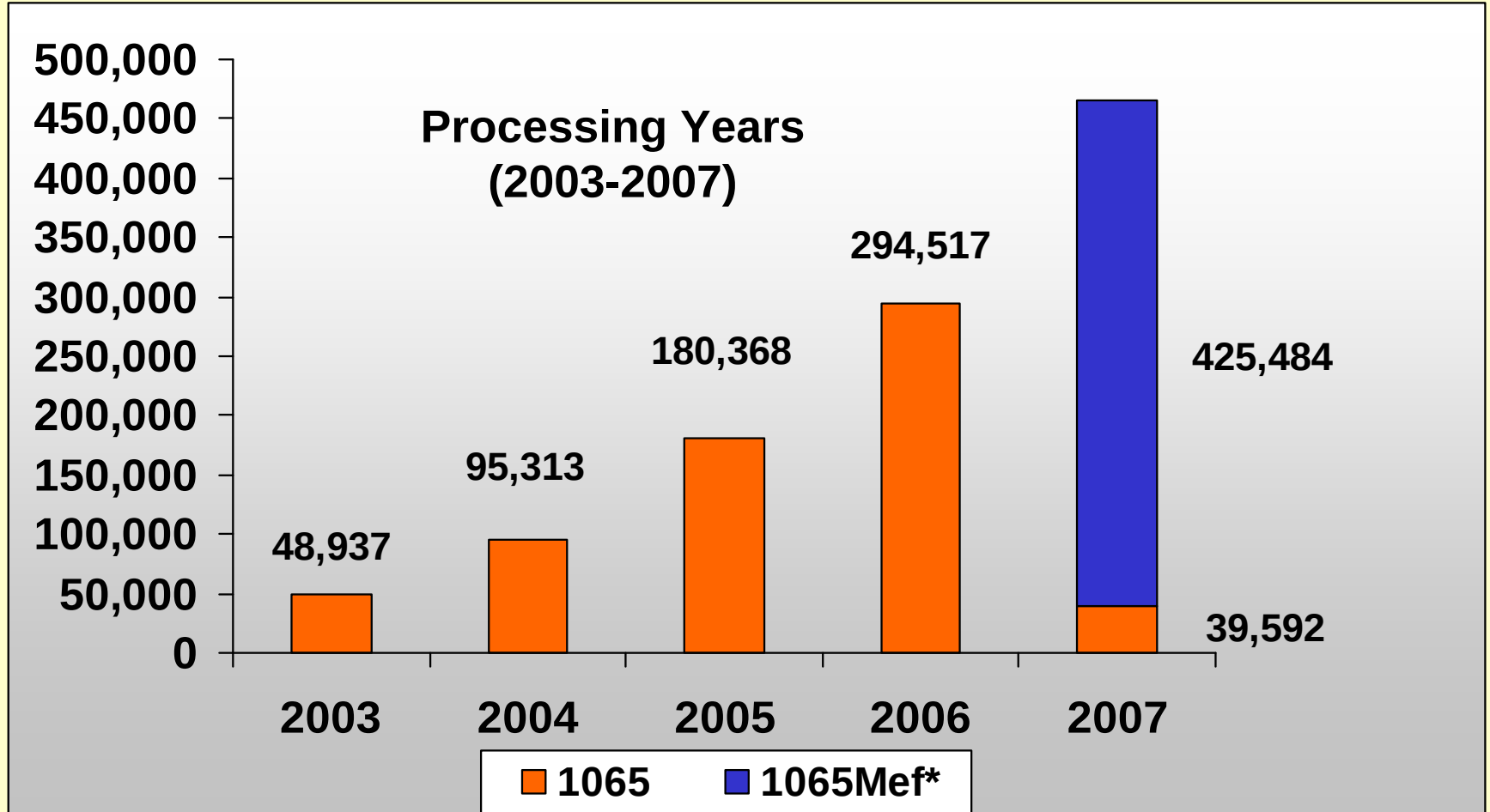

Processing Years 2004-2007



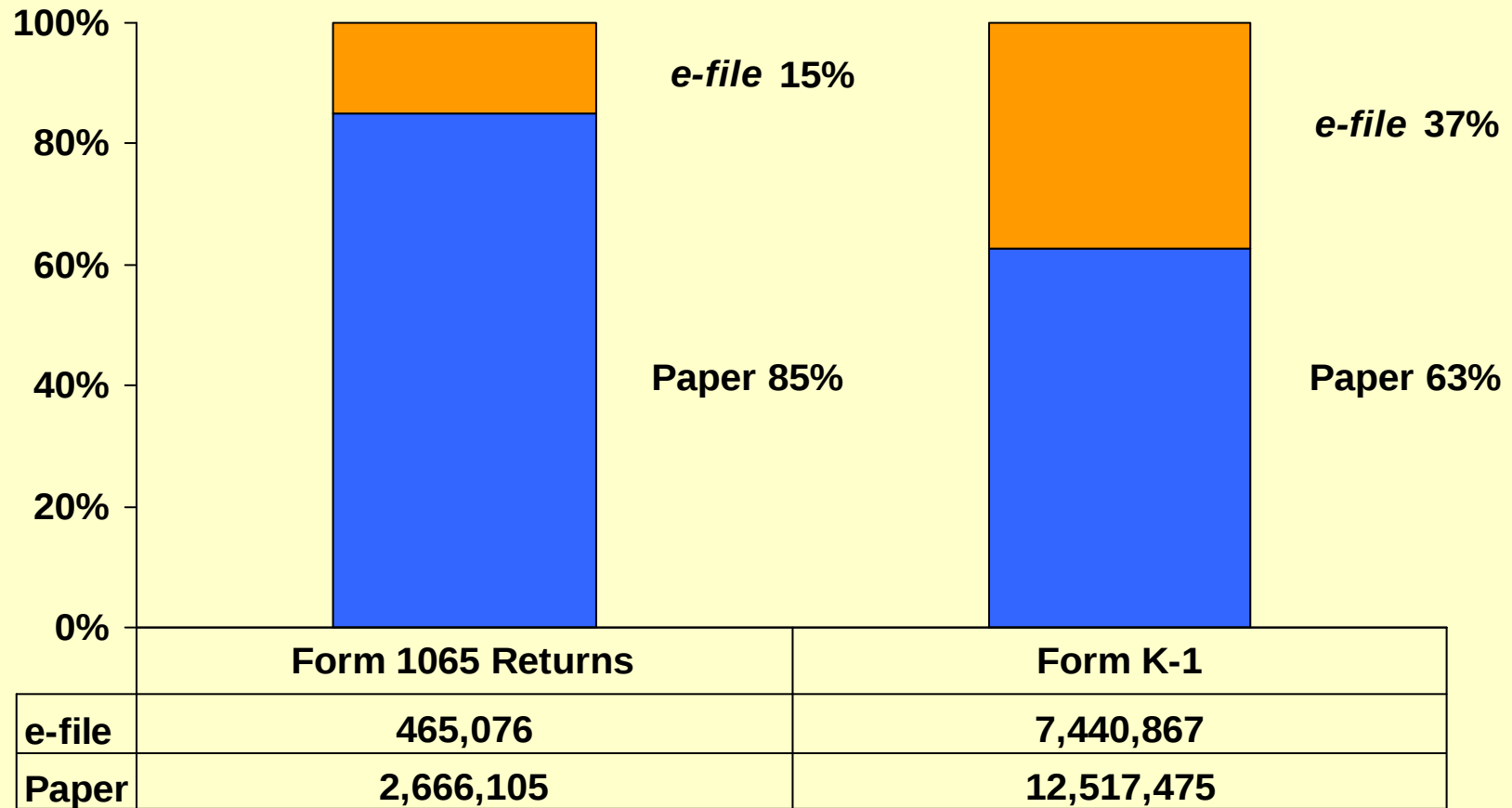
Annual Filing Volume for *e-file* Form 1065

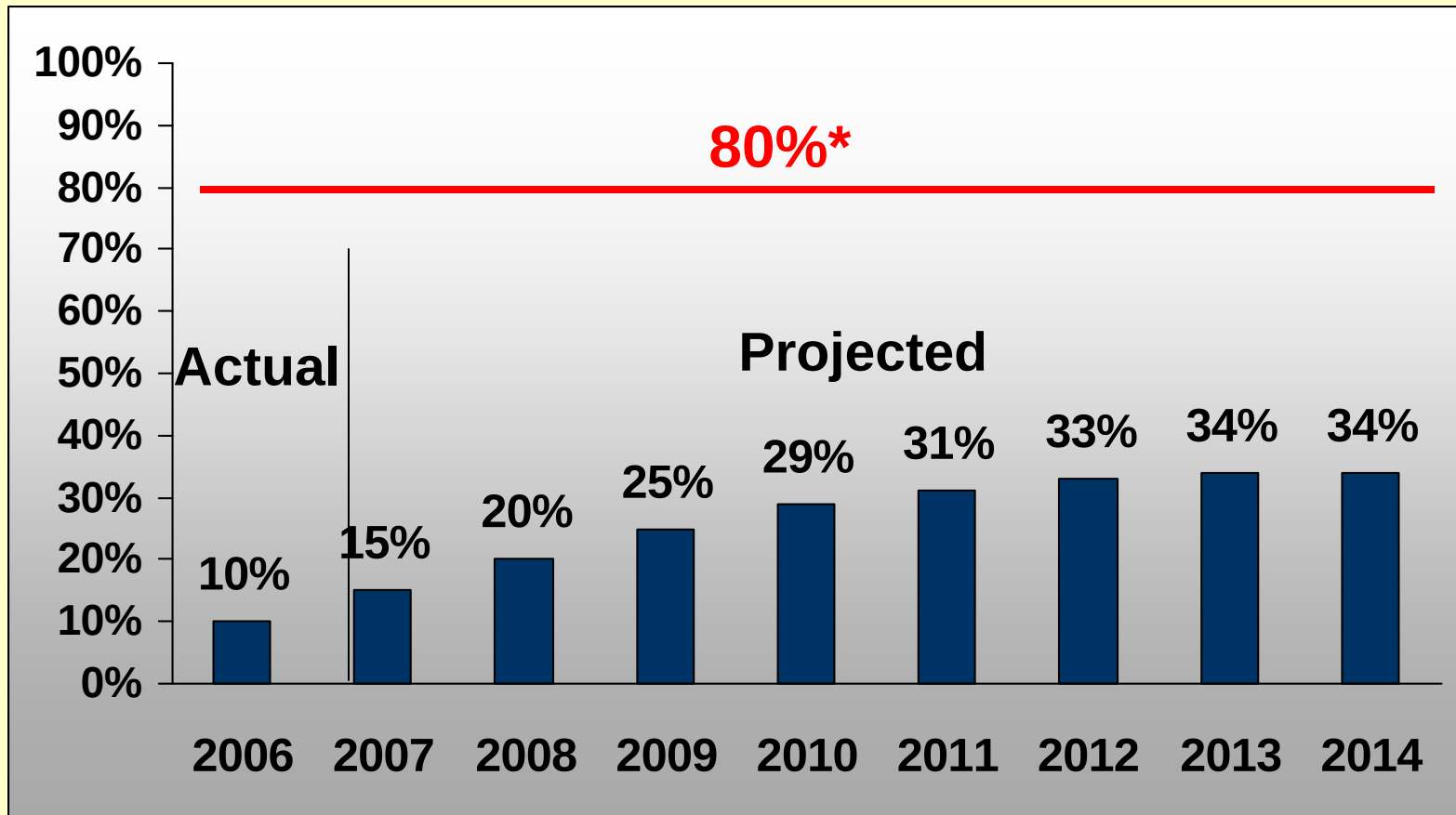

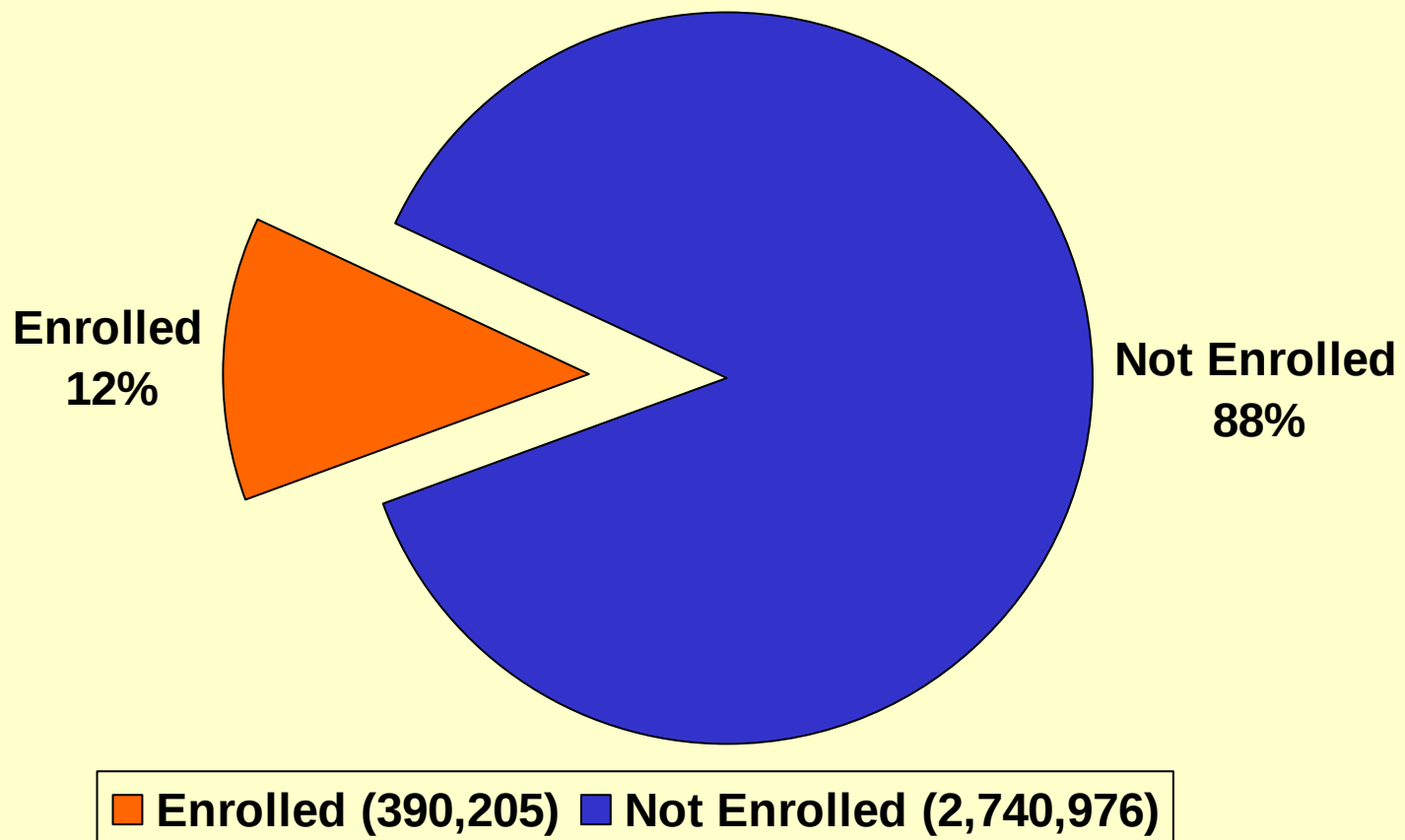

Form 1065 Projected Electronic Filing Penetration Rate

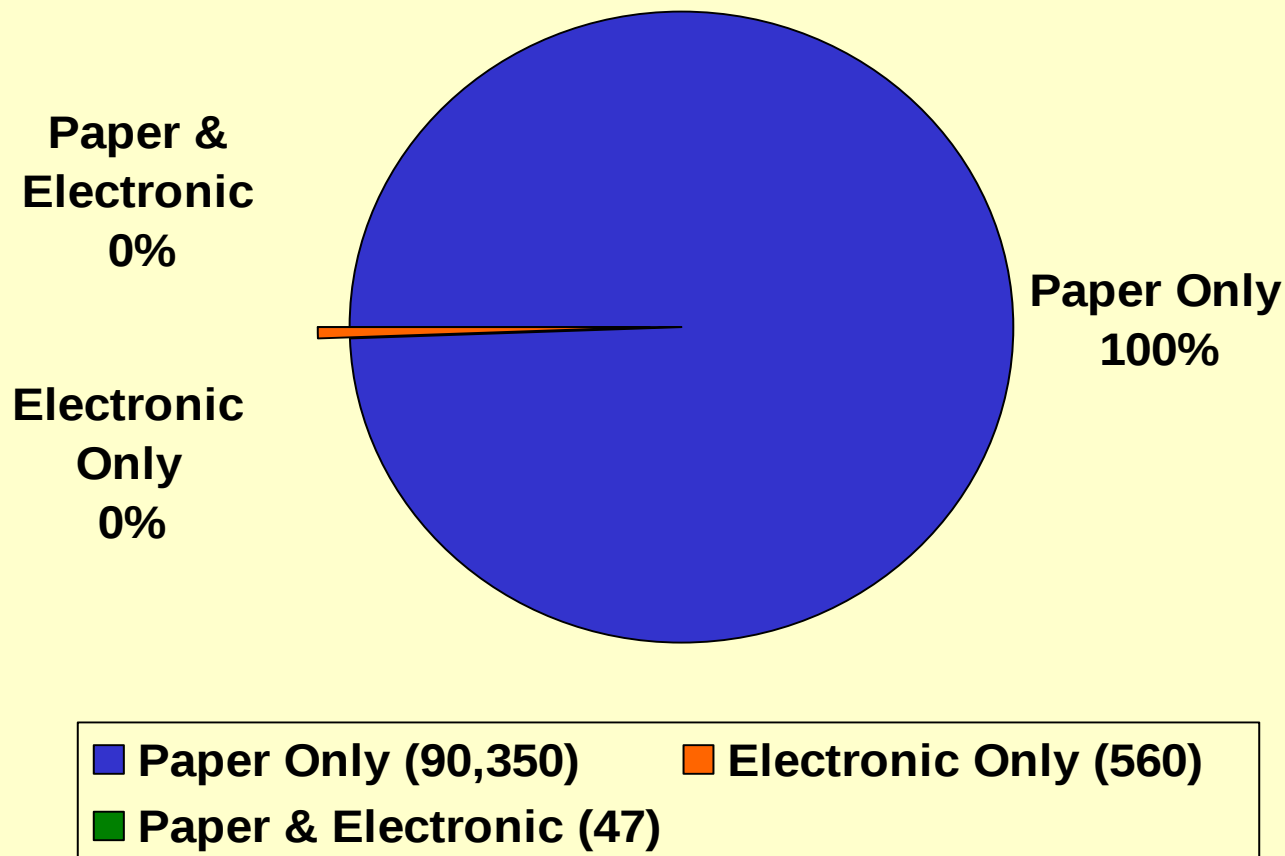


Form 1065 Taxpayers Enrolled in EFTPS (Electronic Federal Tax Payment System)

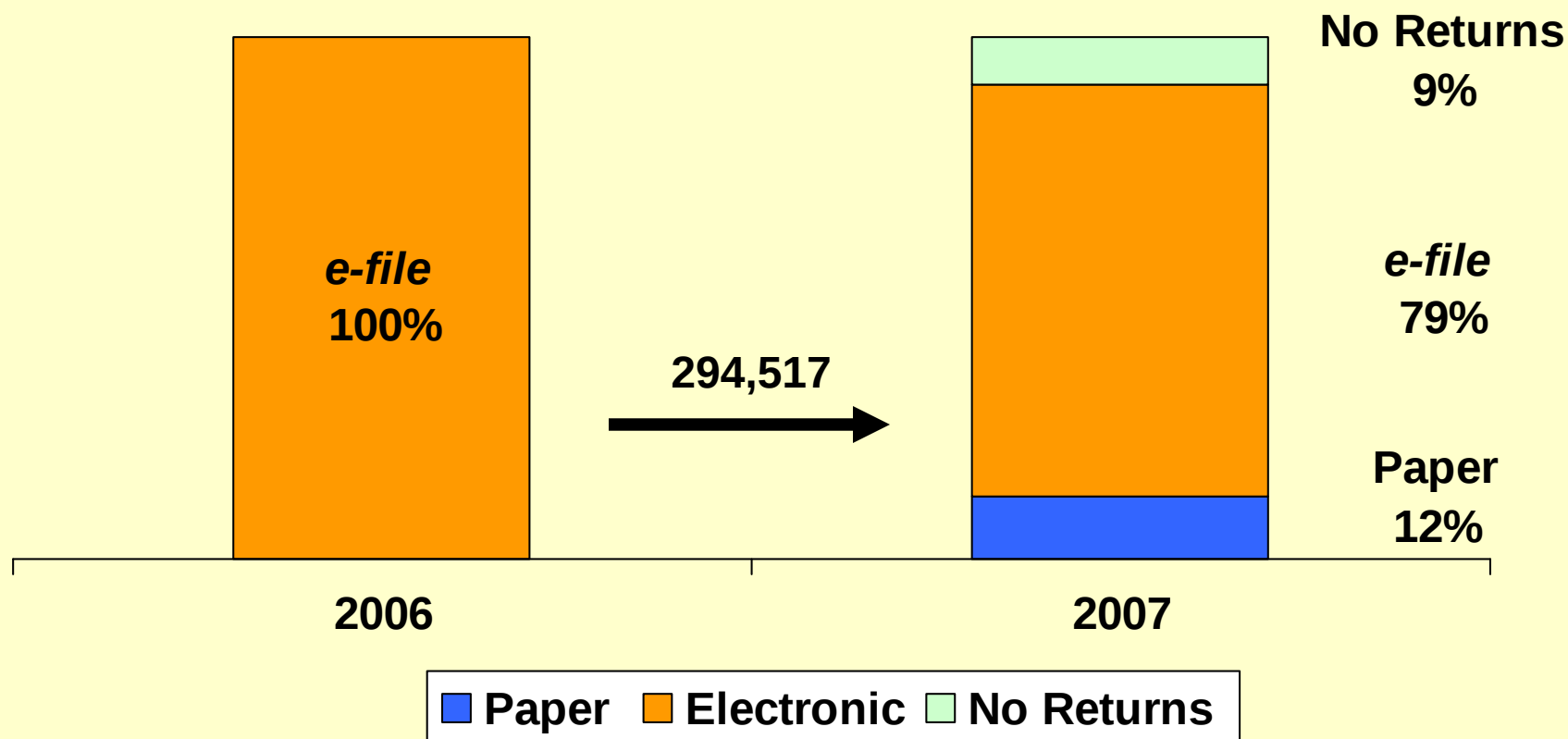

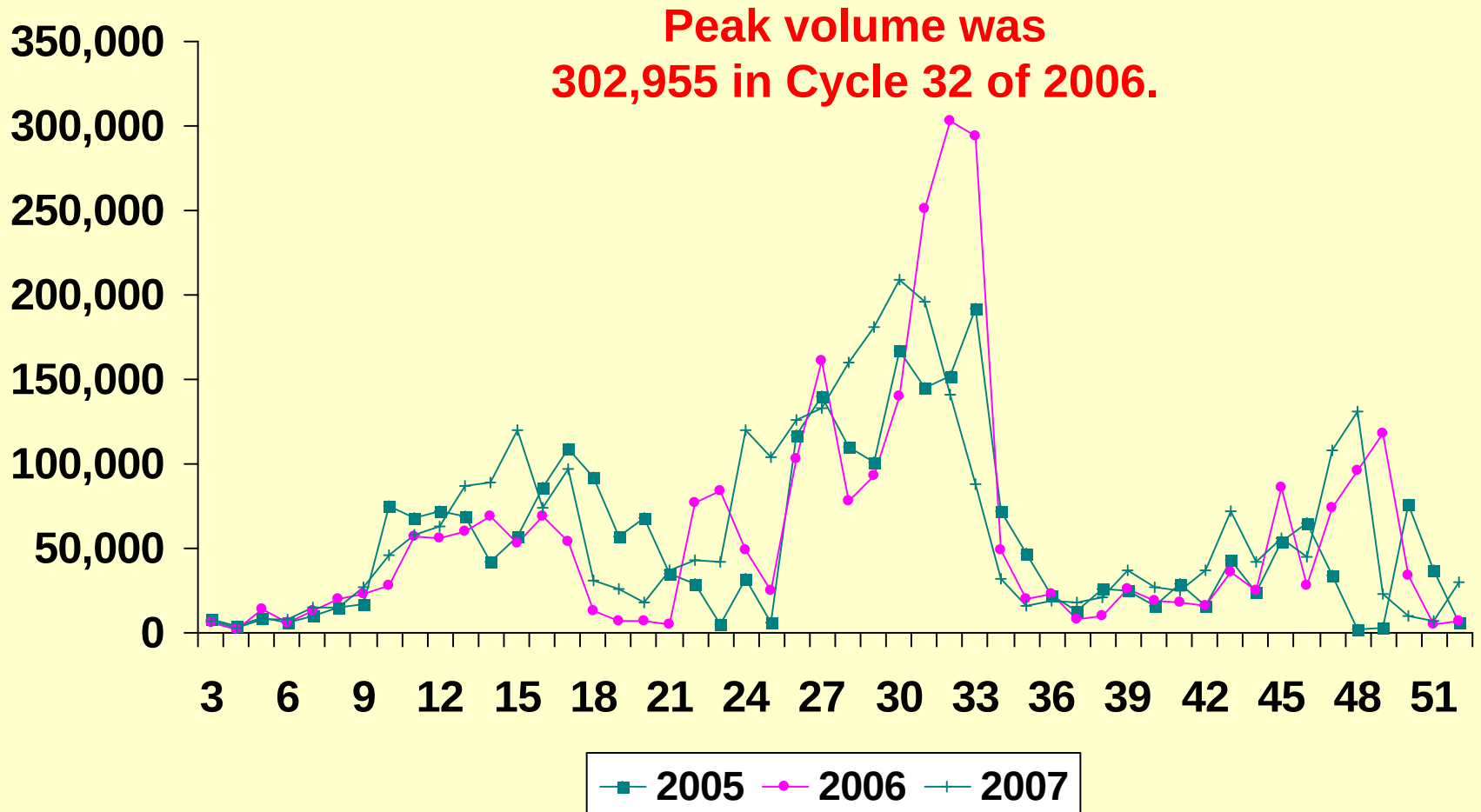

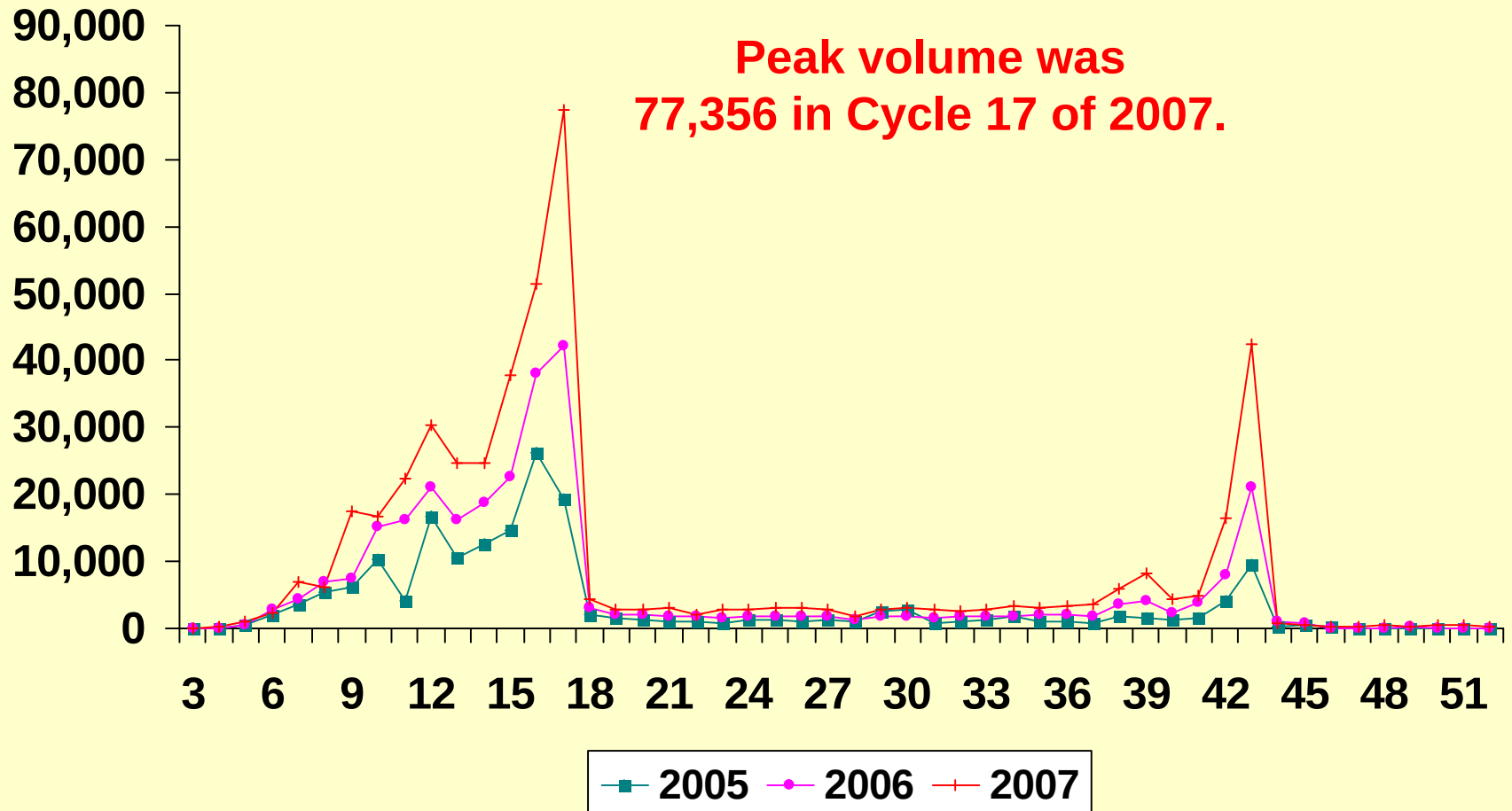

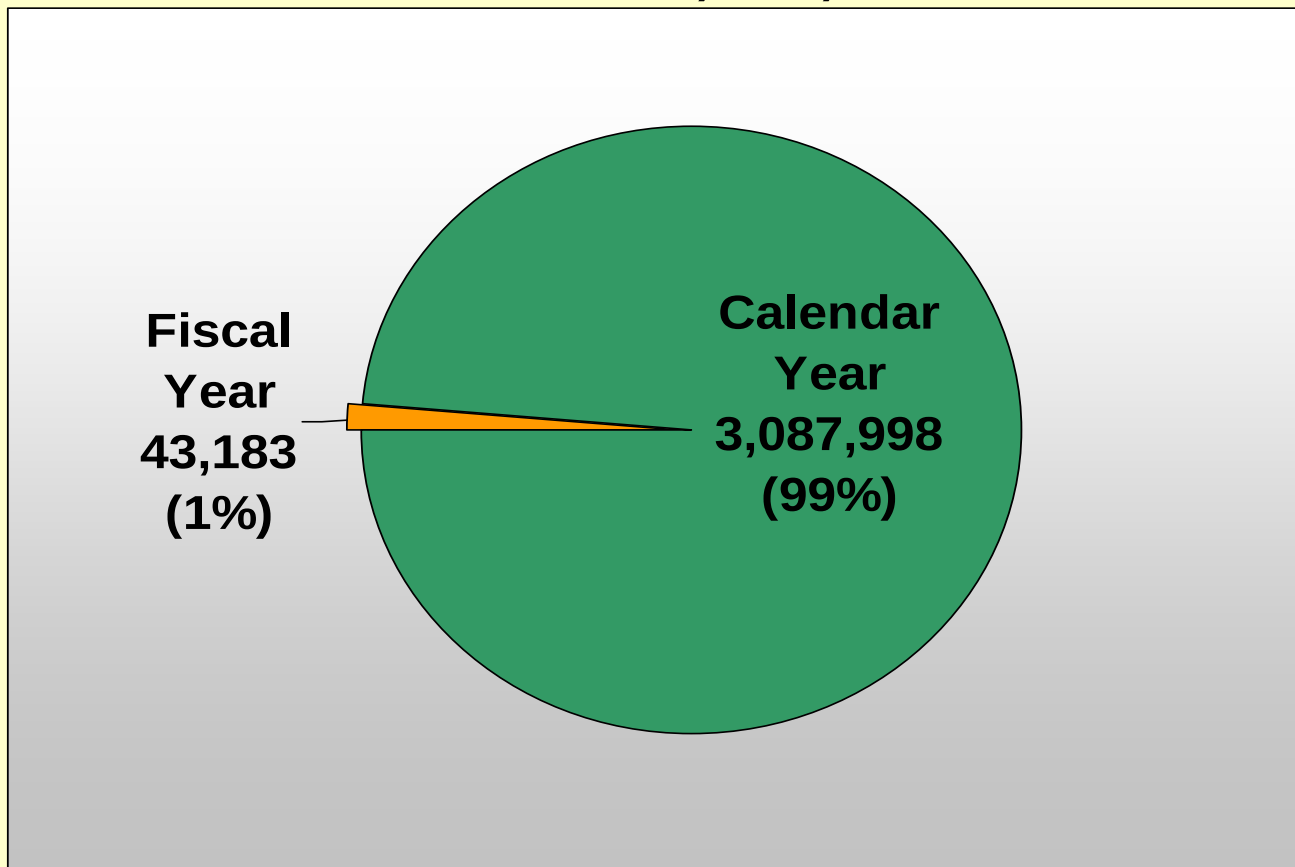


Form 1065 e-file Filing Pattern by Cycle Posted

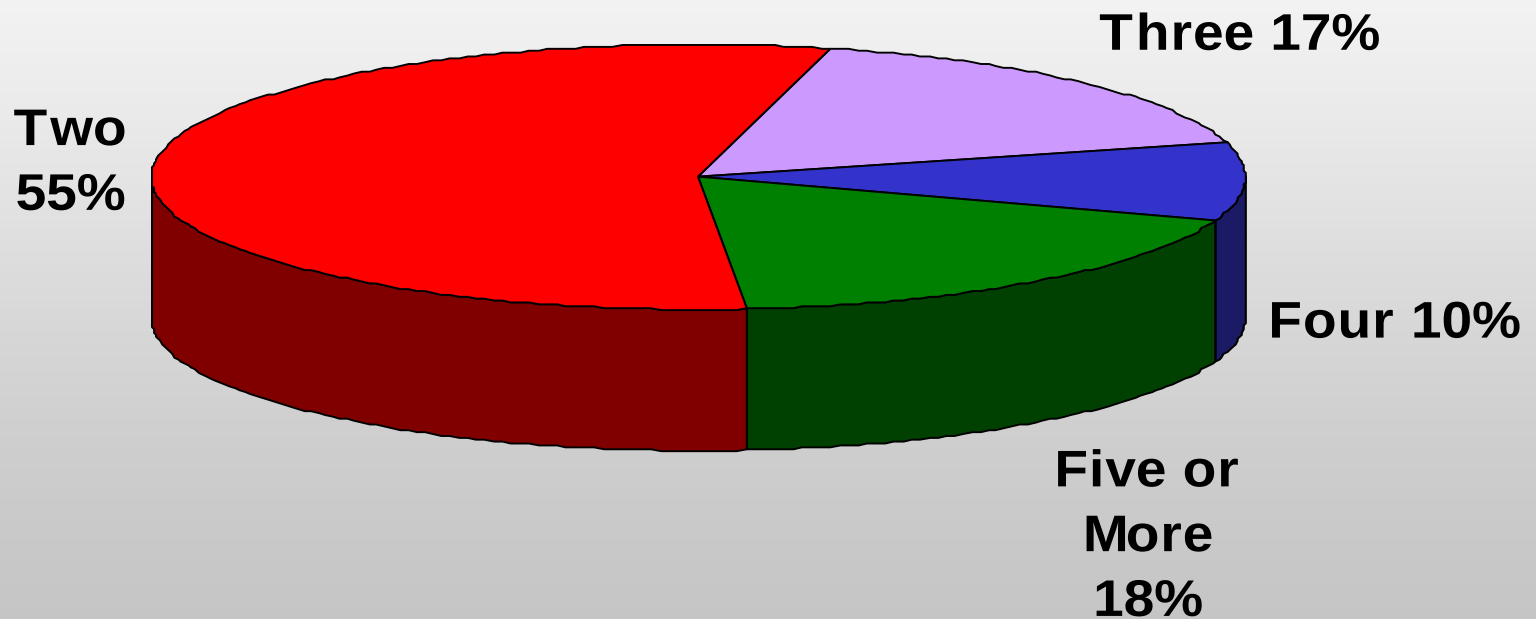
Form 1065 Return Partnership Start Dates*

Number of Partners for Form 1065 Returns



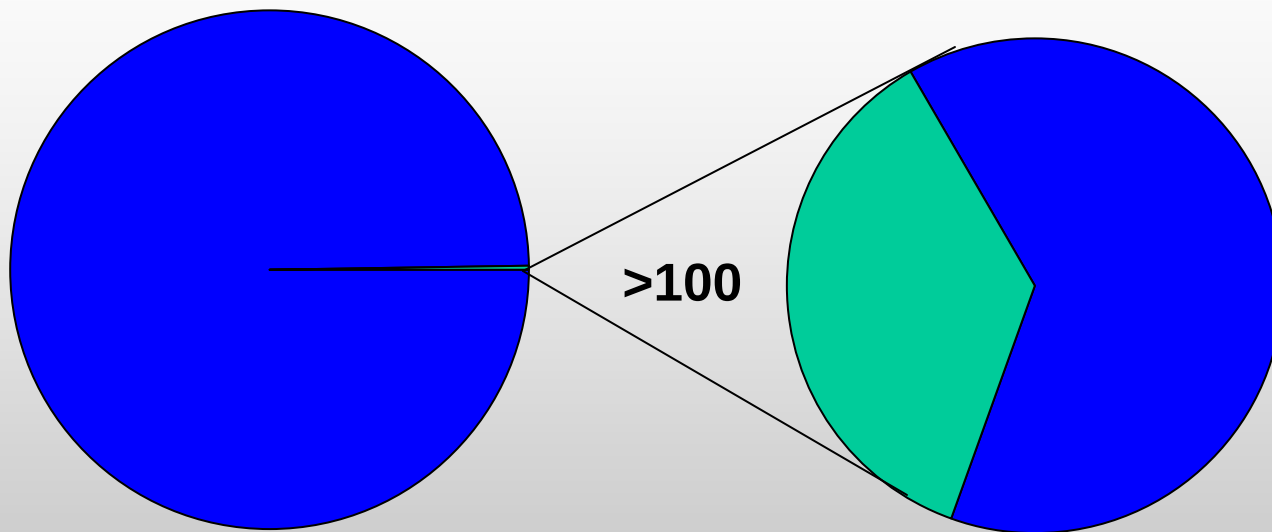

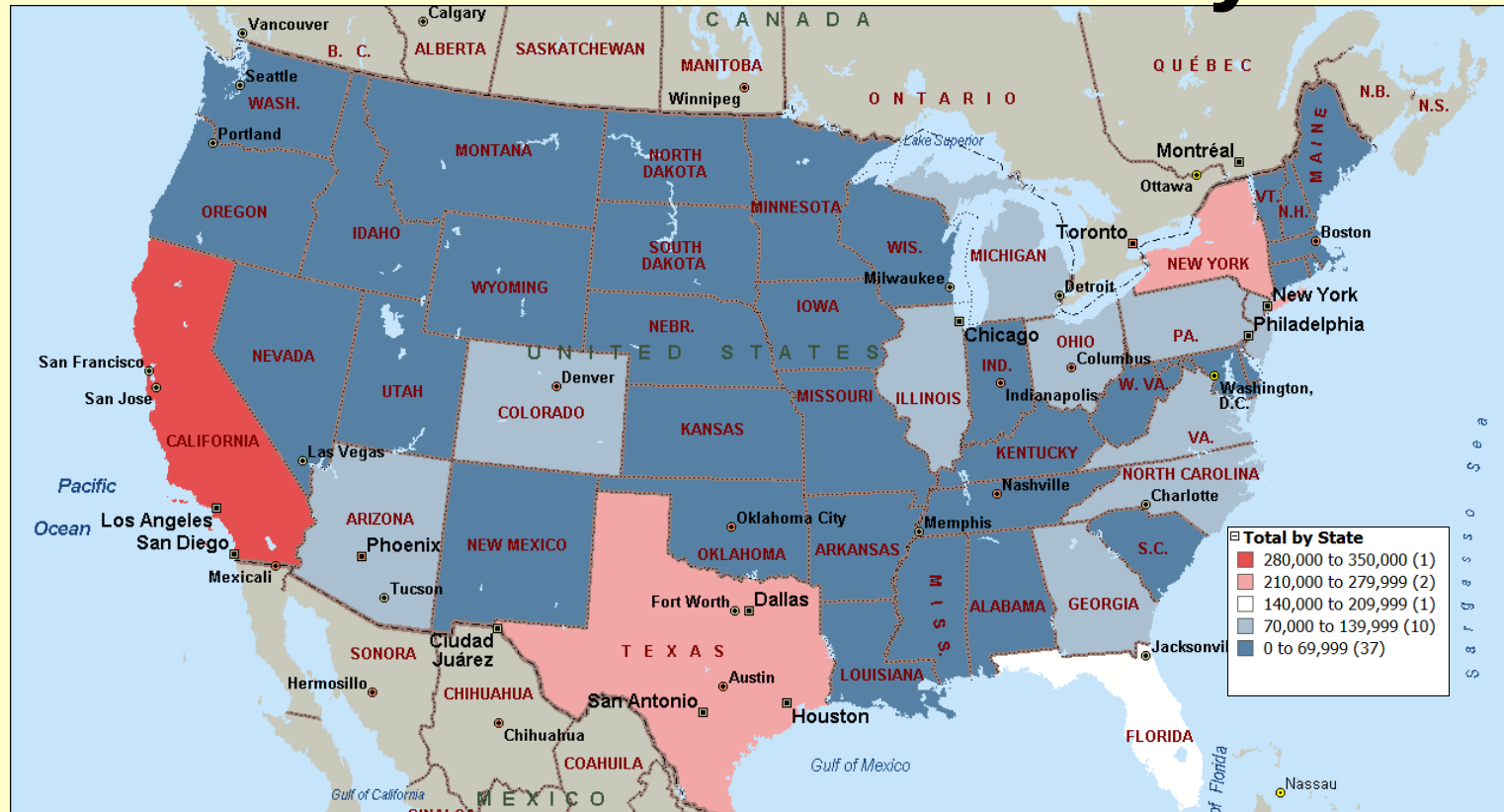

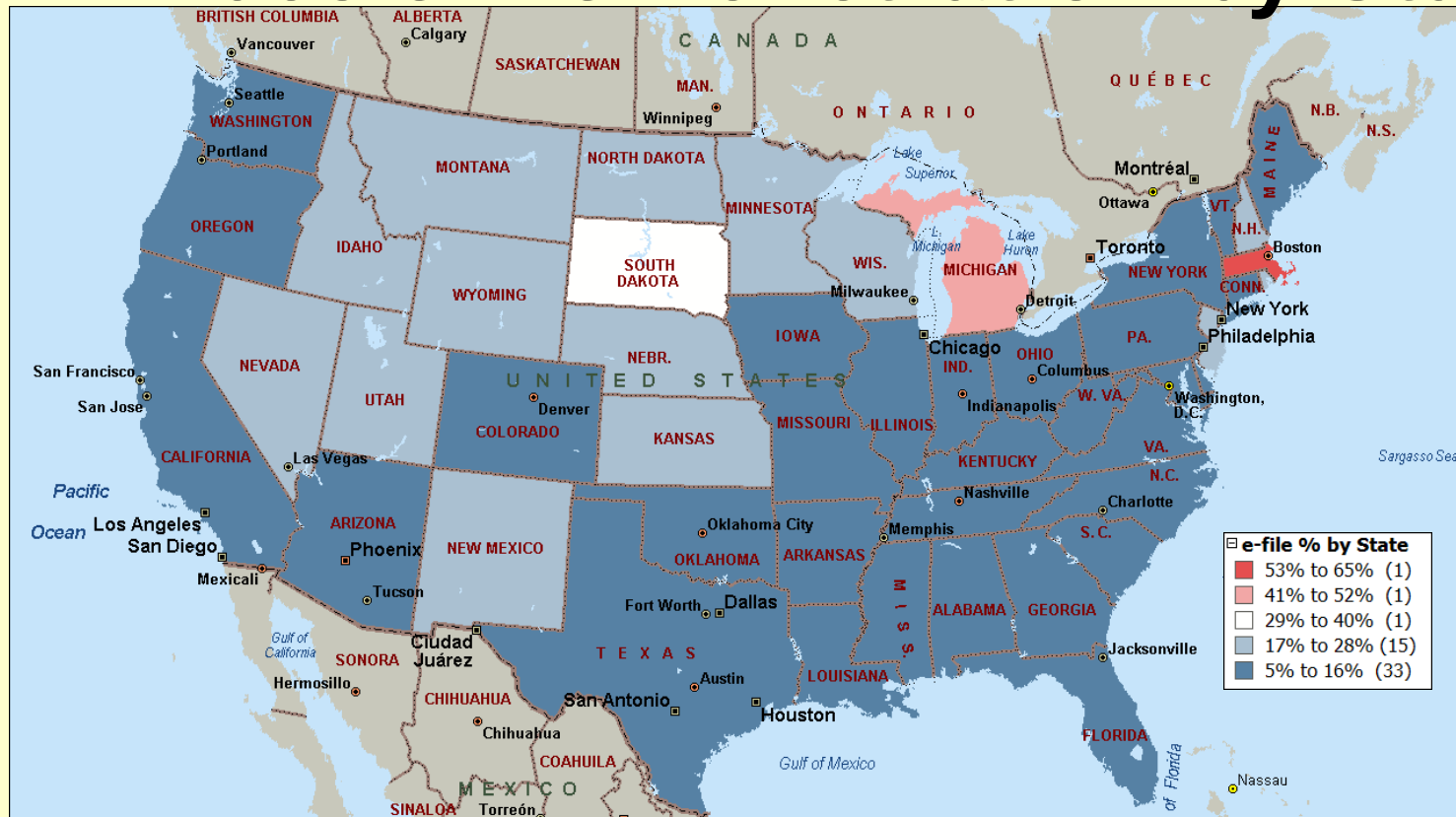

Form 1065 Summary

- 1065's have been *e-filed* since 2000, yet only 20% of all 1065's are projected to be *e-filed* in 2008.
- 12% of all 1065 taxpayers are enrolled in EFTPS.
- Form 1065 filers have a 79% *e-file* loyalty rate.
- 1065's have two peak volume filing times: April and October.
- 1,364,211 (44%) of 1065 returns represent real estate related activities.
- 87% of filers use preparers.
- 44% of partnerships started in 2003 or later.
- 82% of 1065 filers have fewer than five partners.

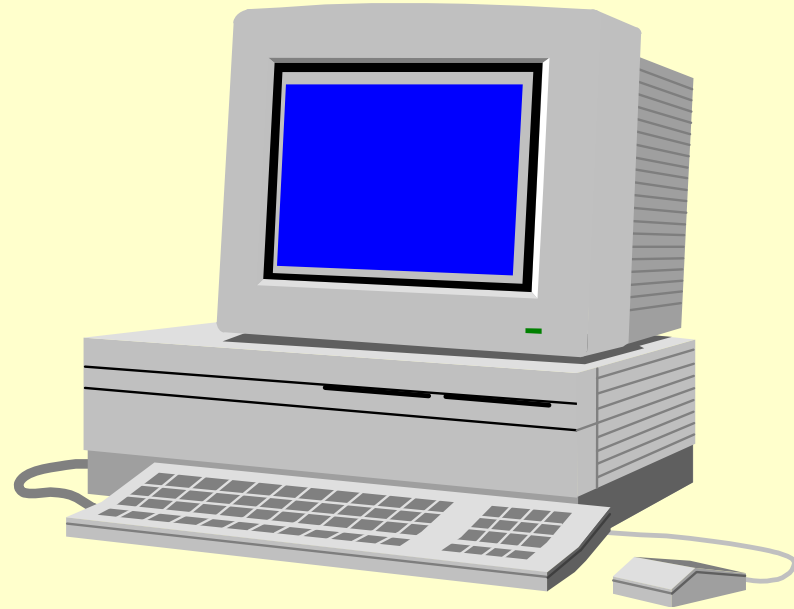

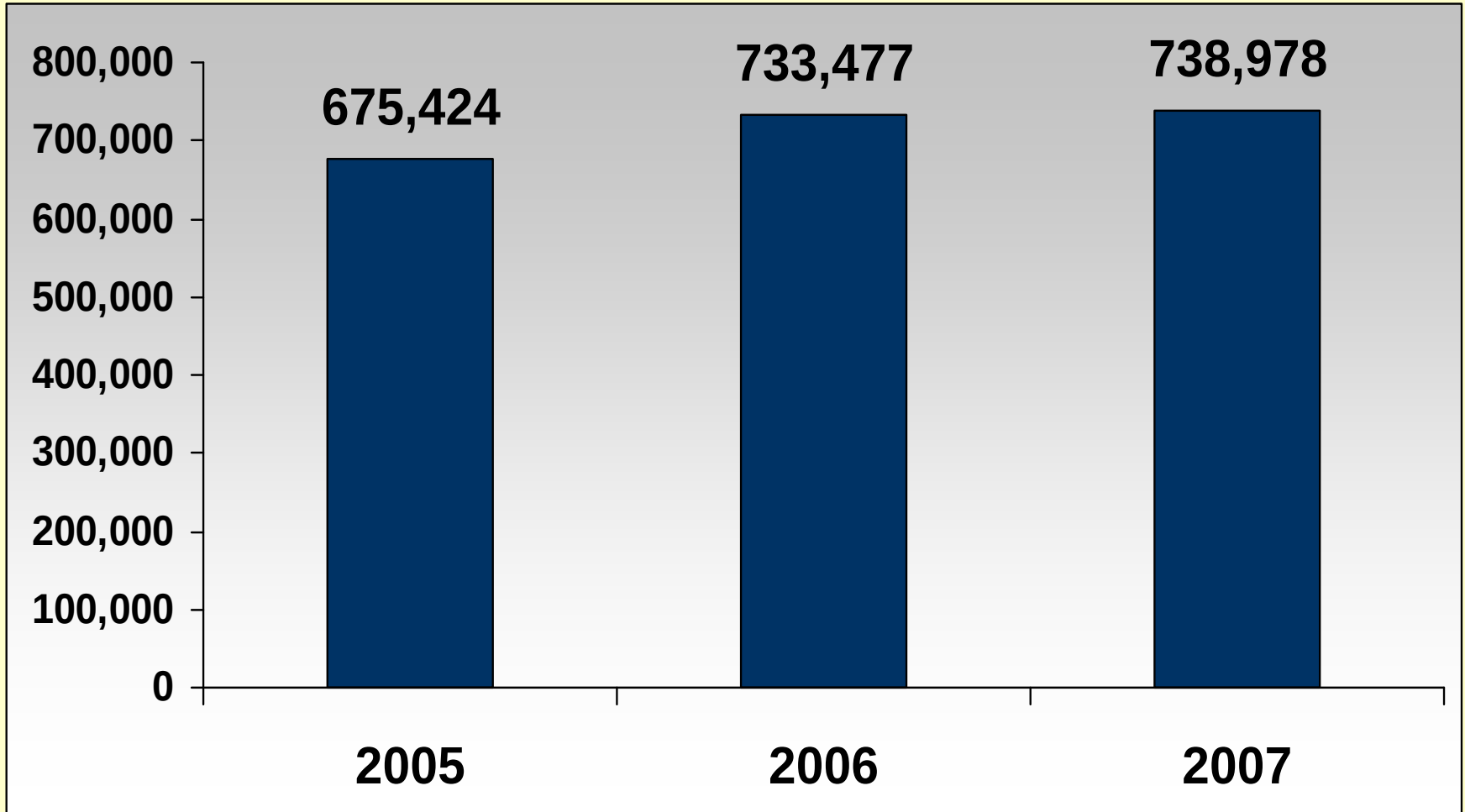
Heavy Highway Vehicle Use Tax

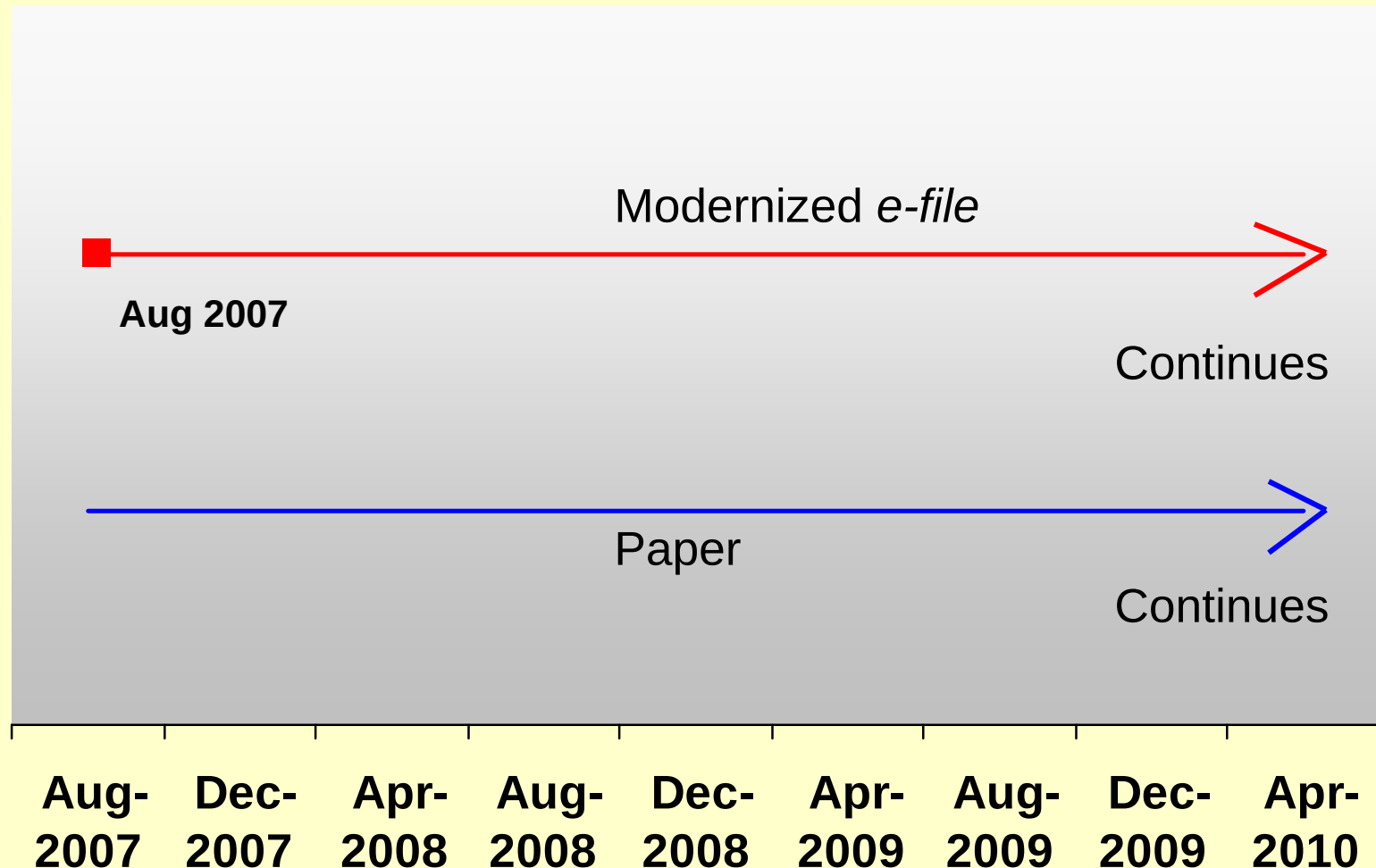

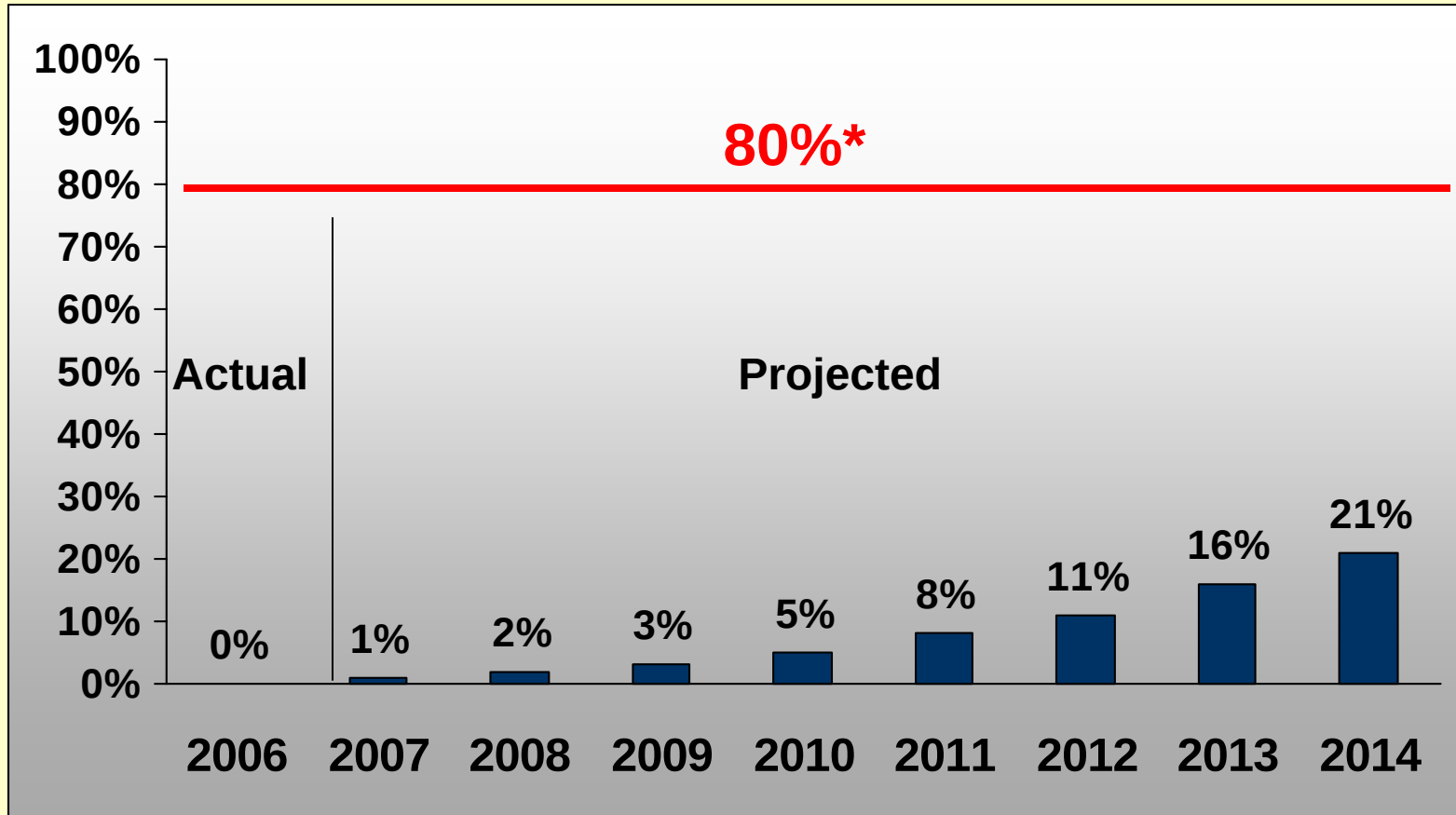

Form 2290: Implementation Schedule

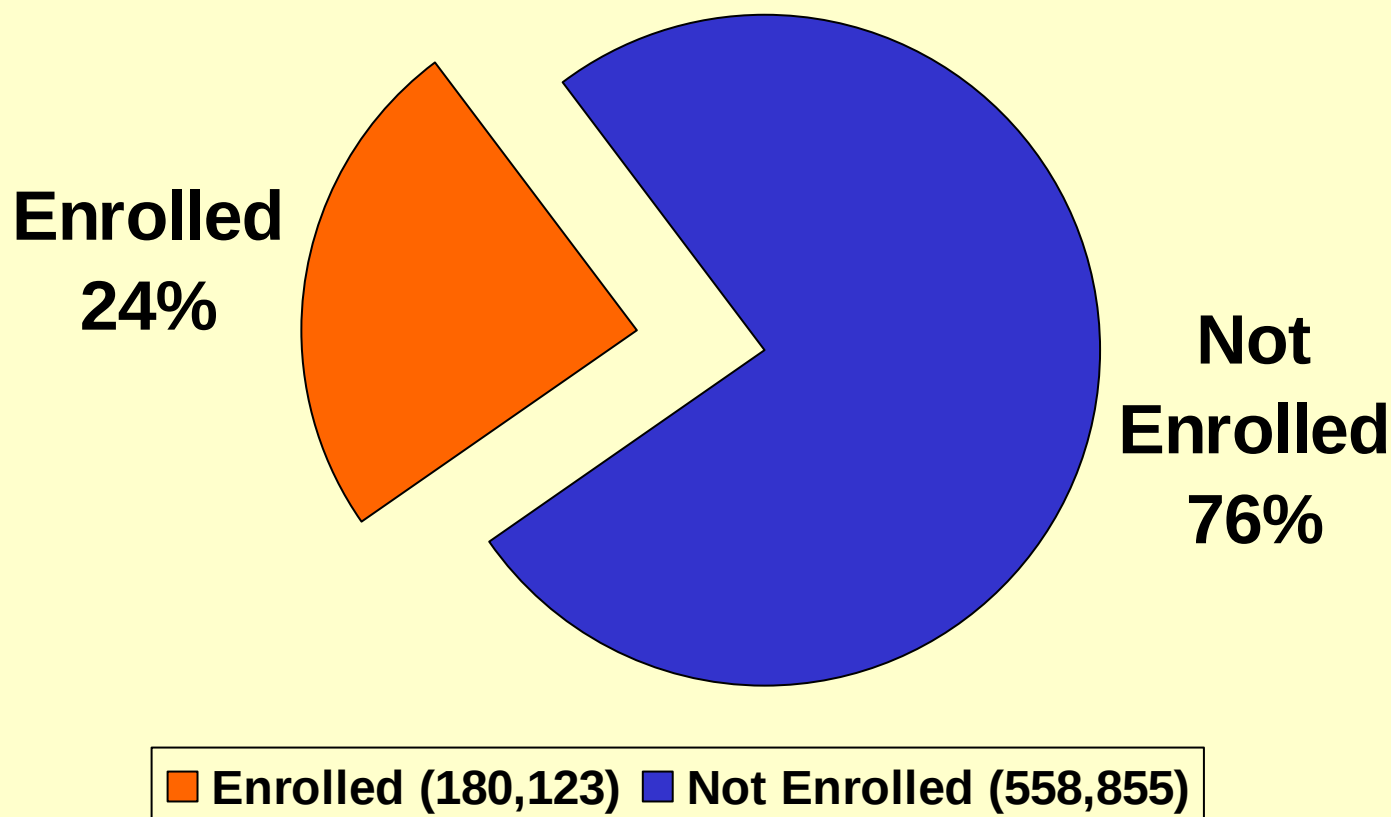


Form 2290 Projected *e-file* Penetration Rate

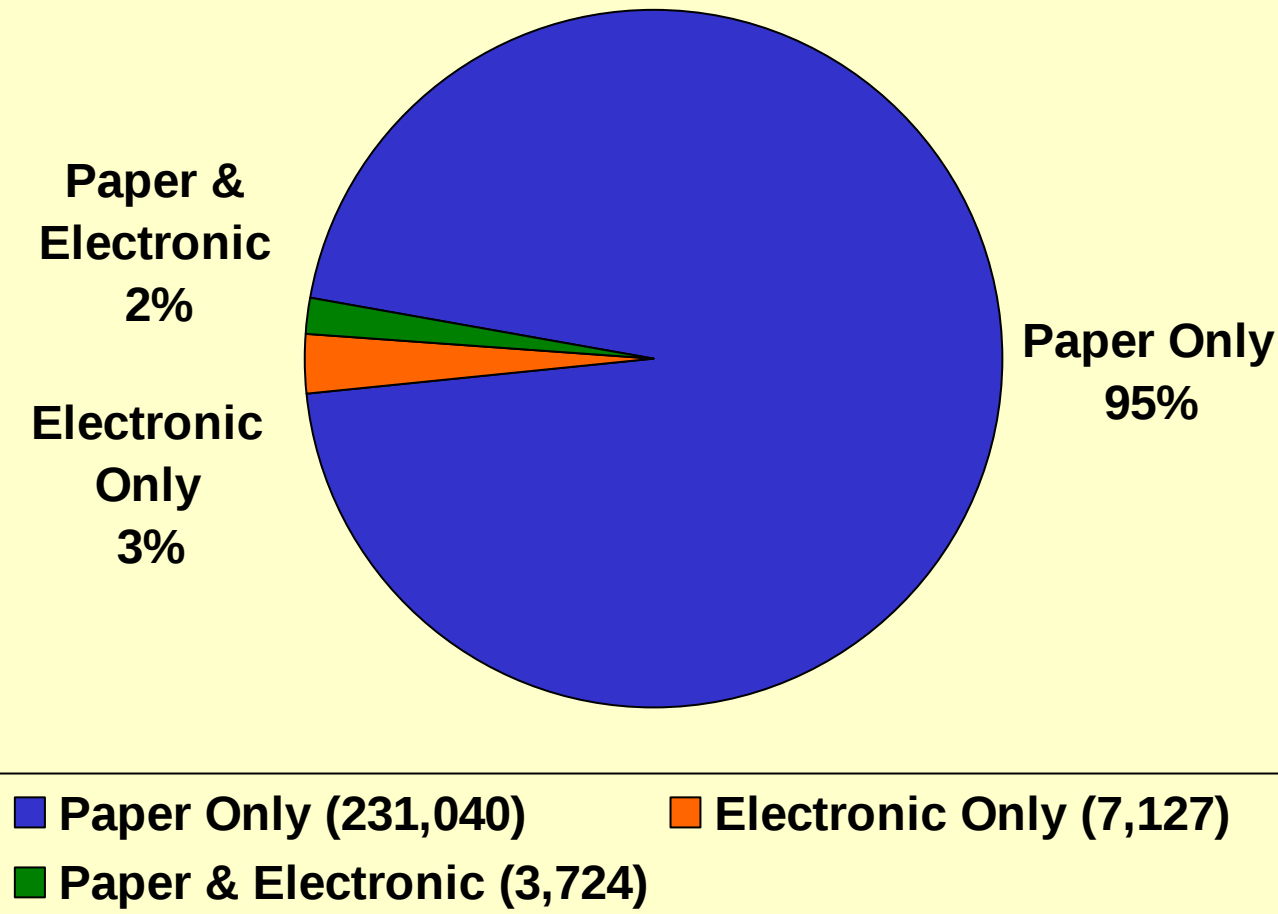


Form 2290 Taxpayers Enrolled in EFTPS (Electronic Federal Tax Payment System)

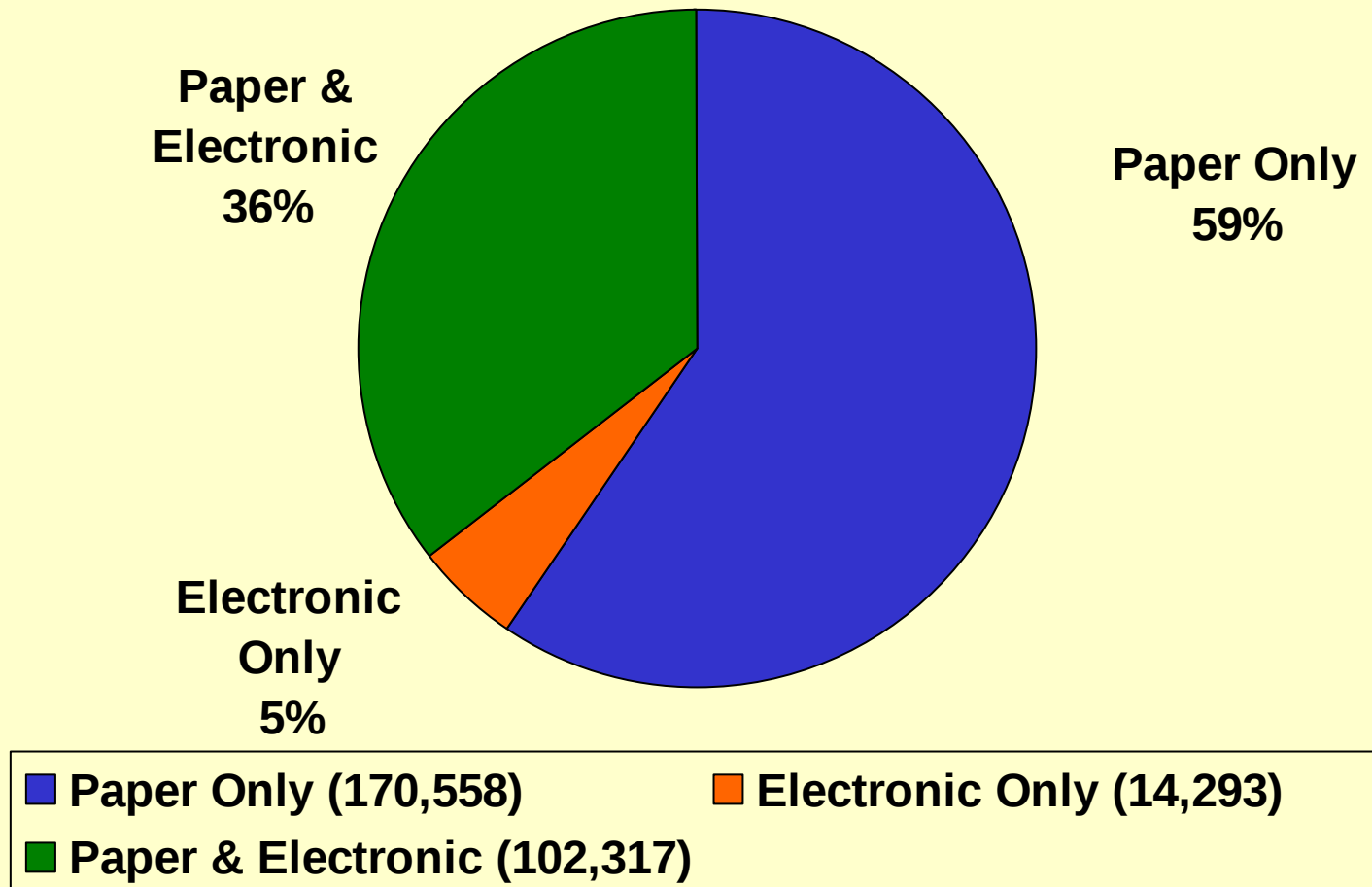

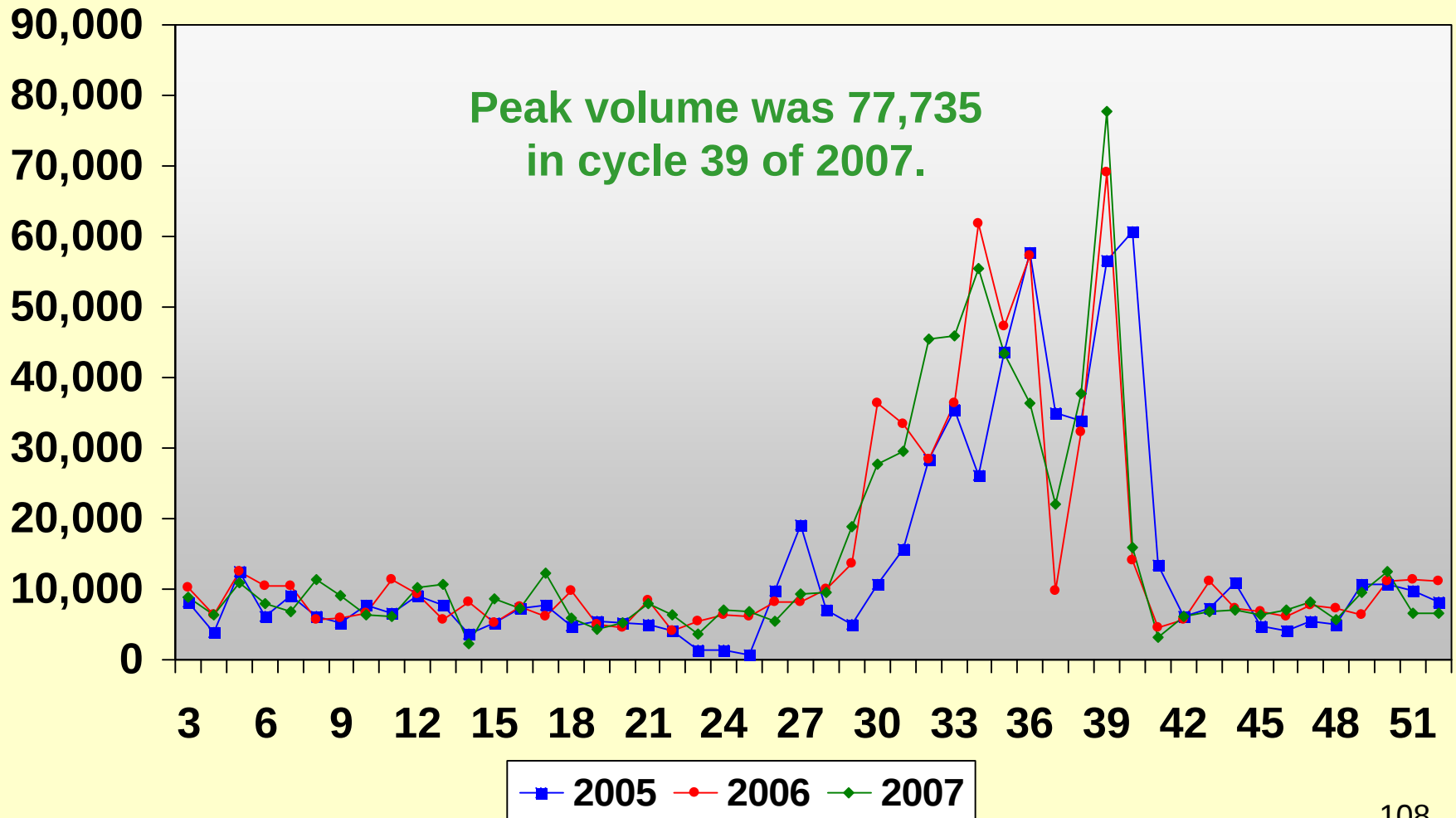
Total Number of Form 2290 Taxpayers Making Payments*



Total Number of Form 2290 Taxpayers Making Payments*

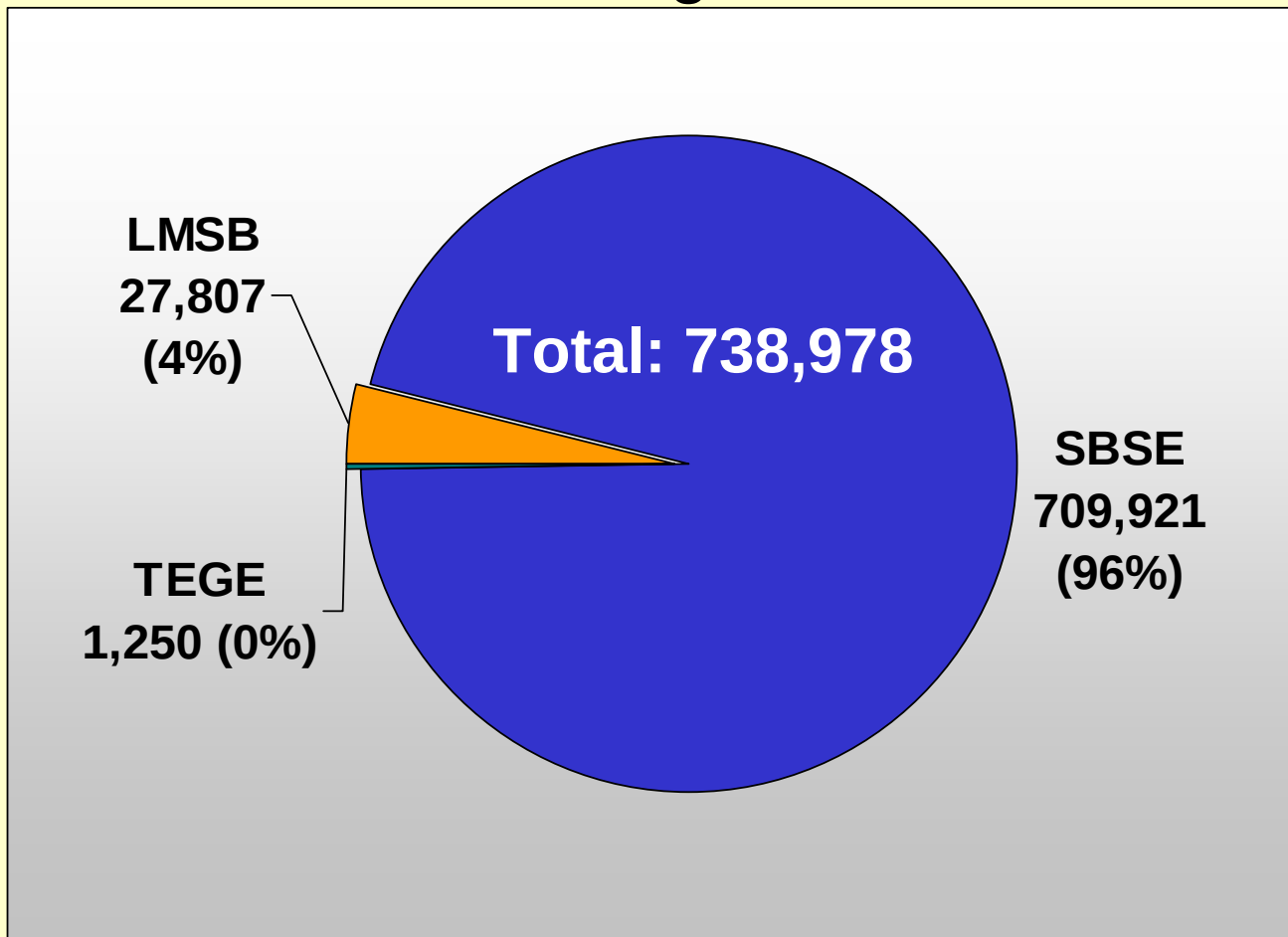


Form 2290 Filing Patterns by Cycle Posted



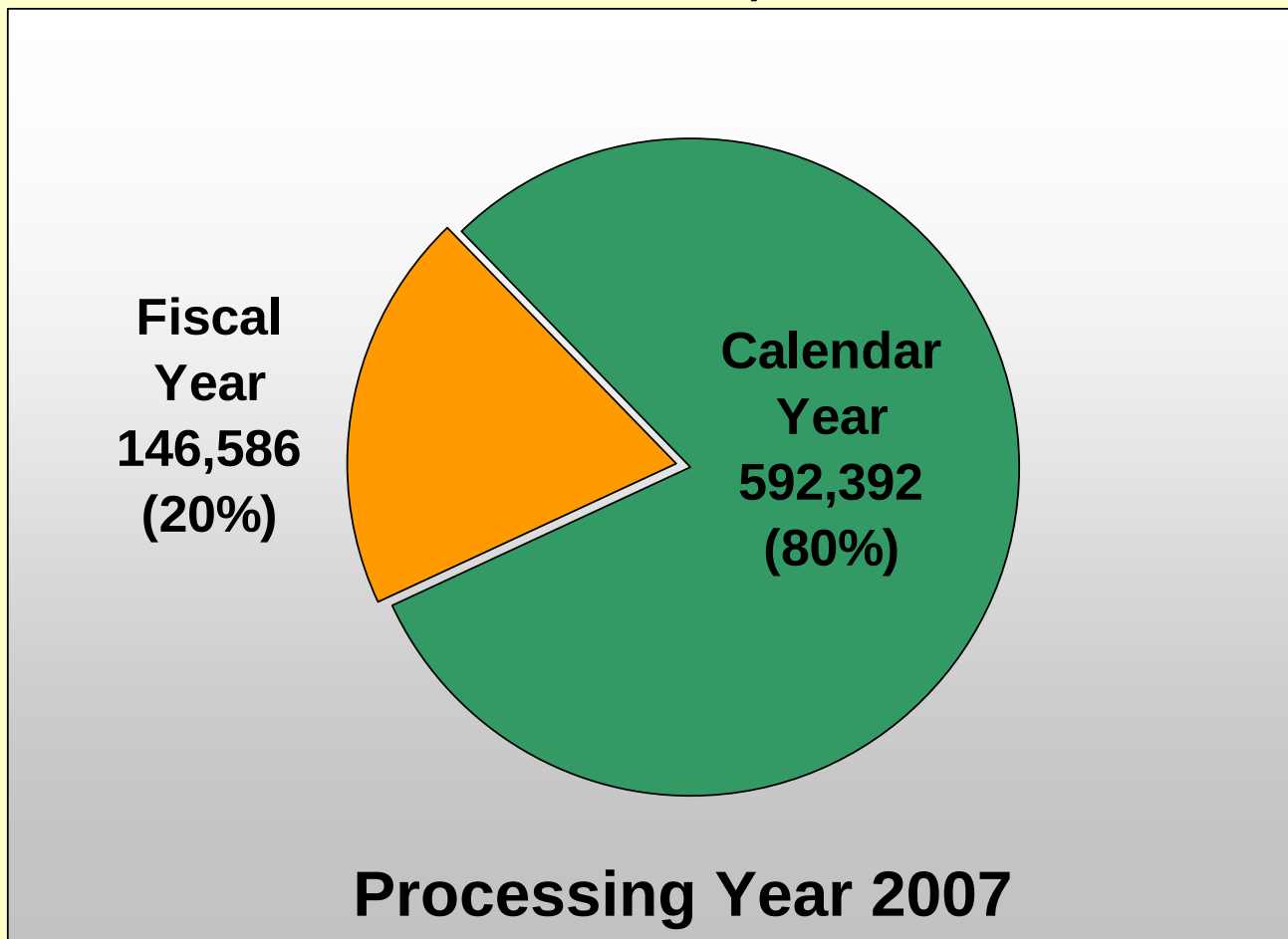
Form 2290 Returns Filed by Business Operating Division

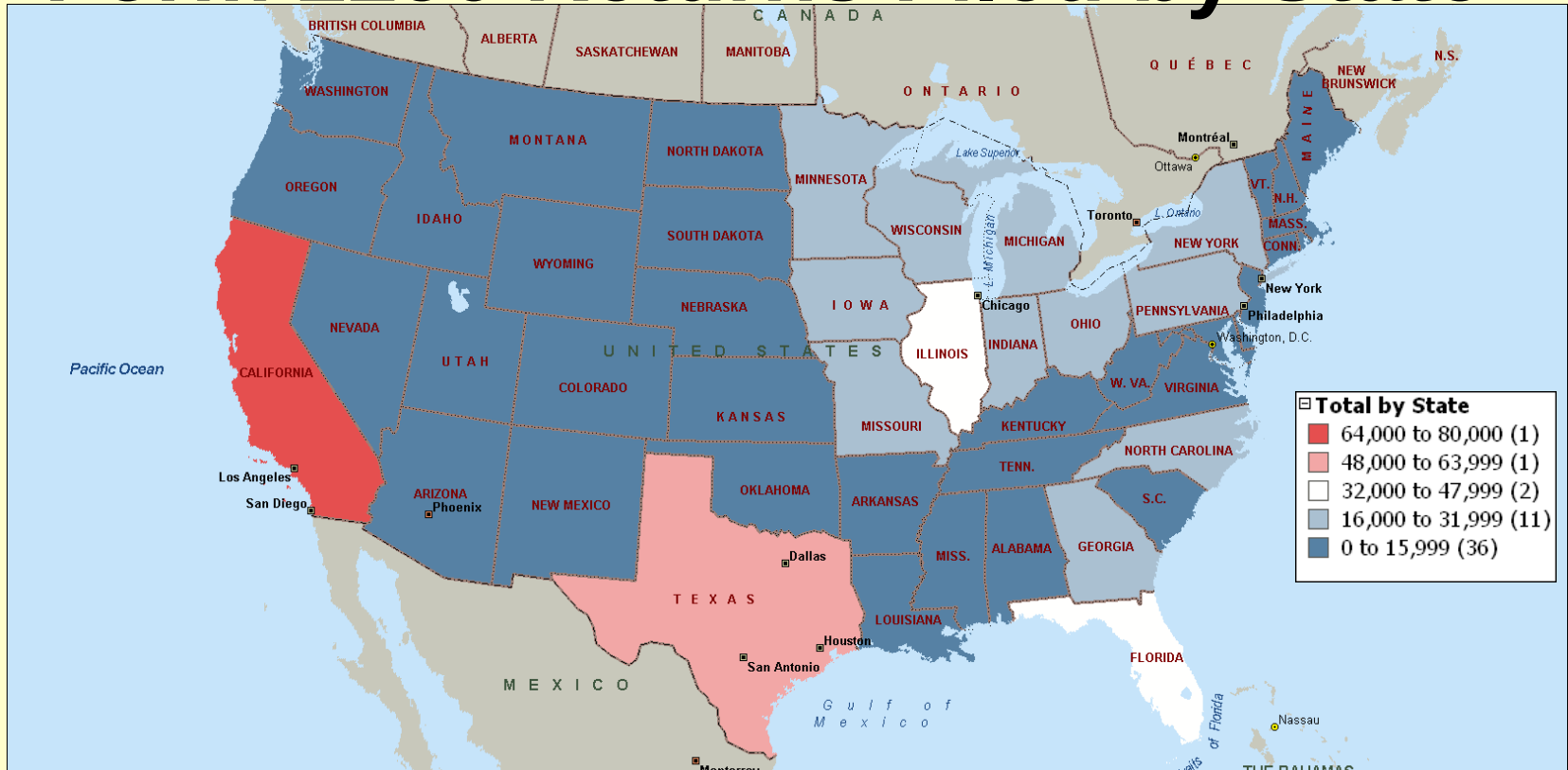

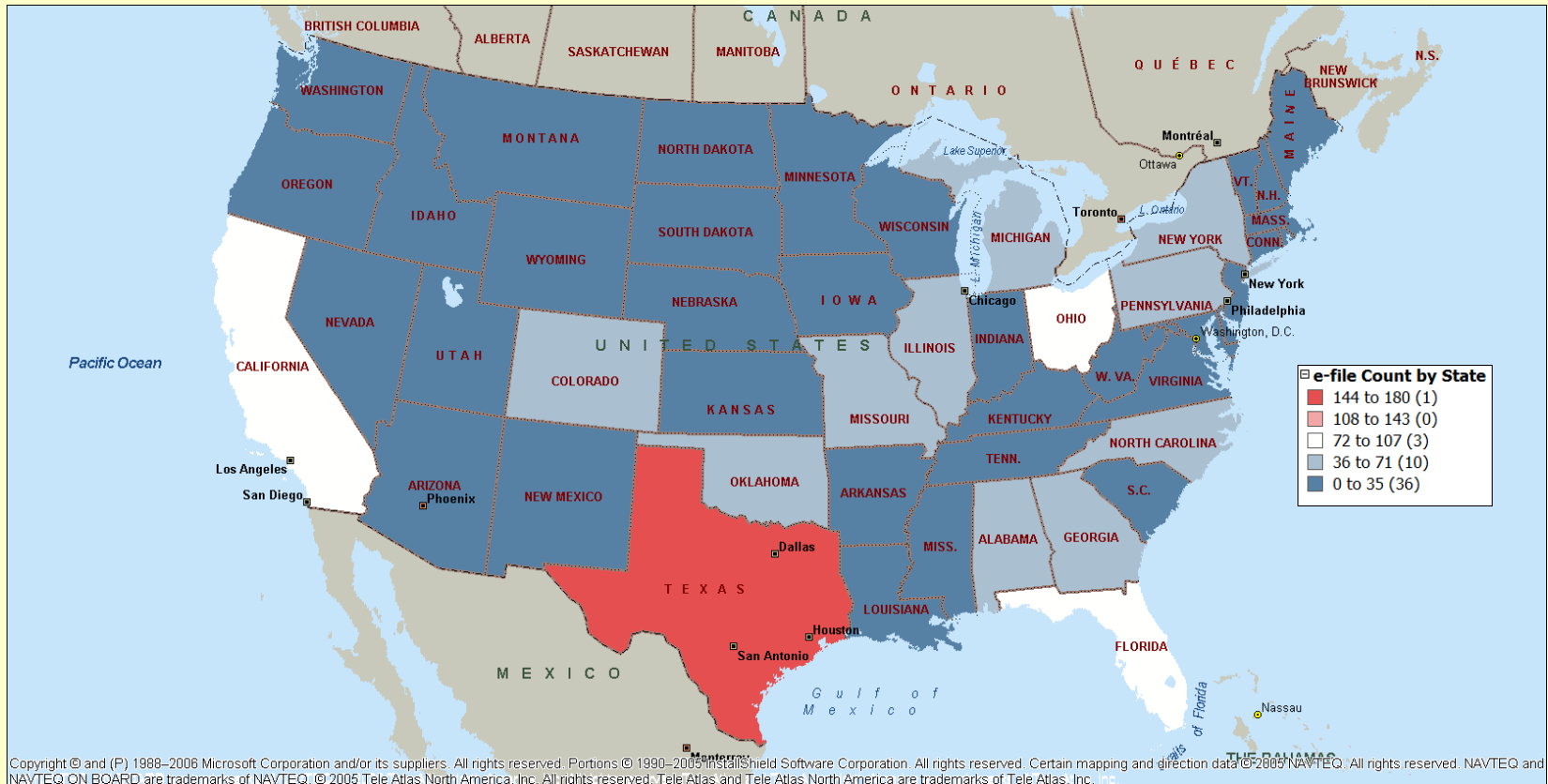

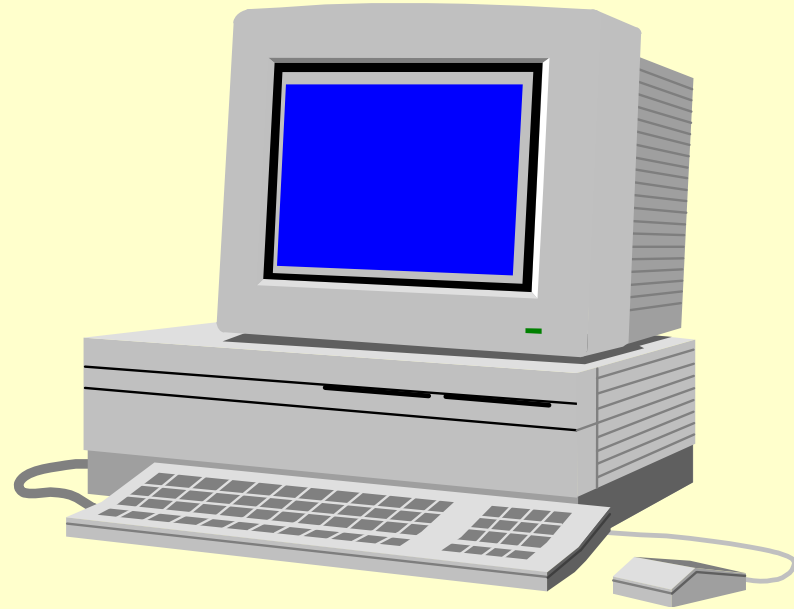

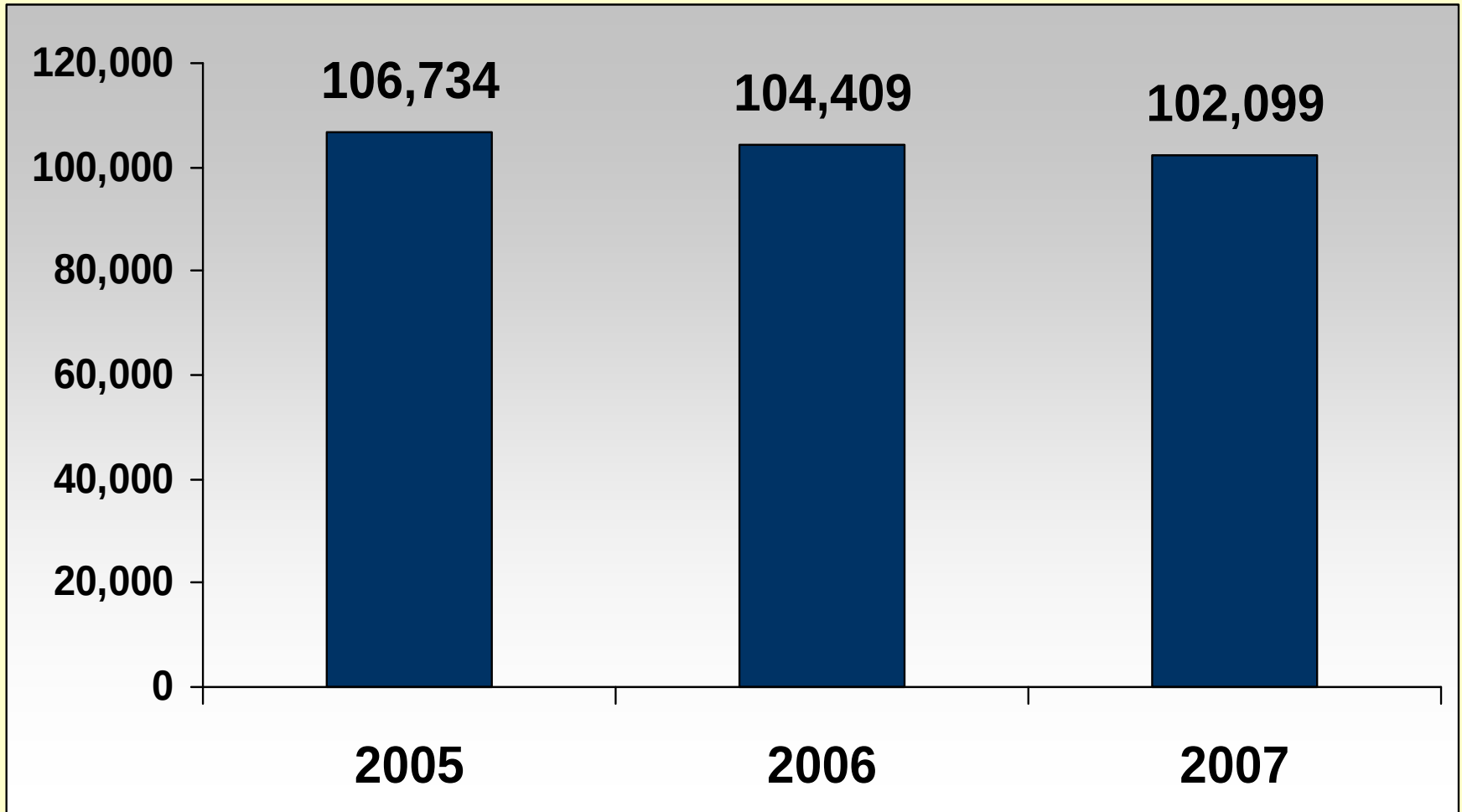
Quarterly Federal Excise Tax

Processing Year 2007



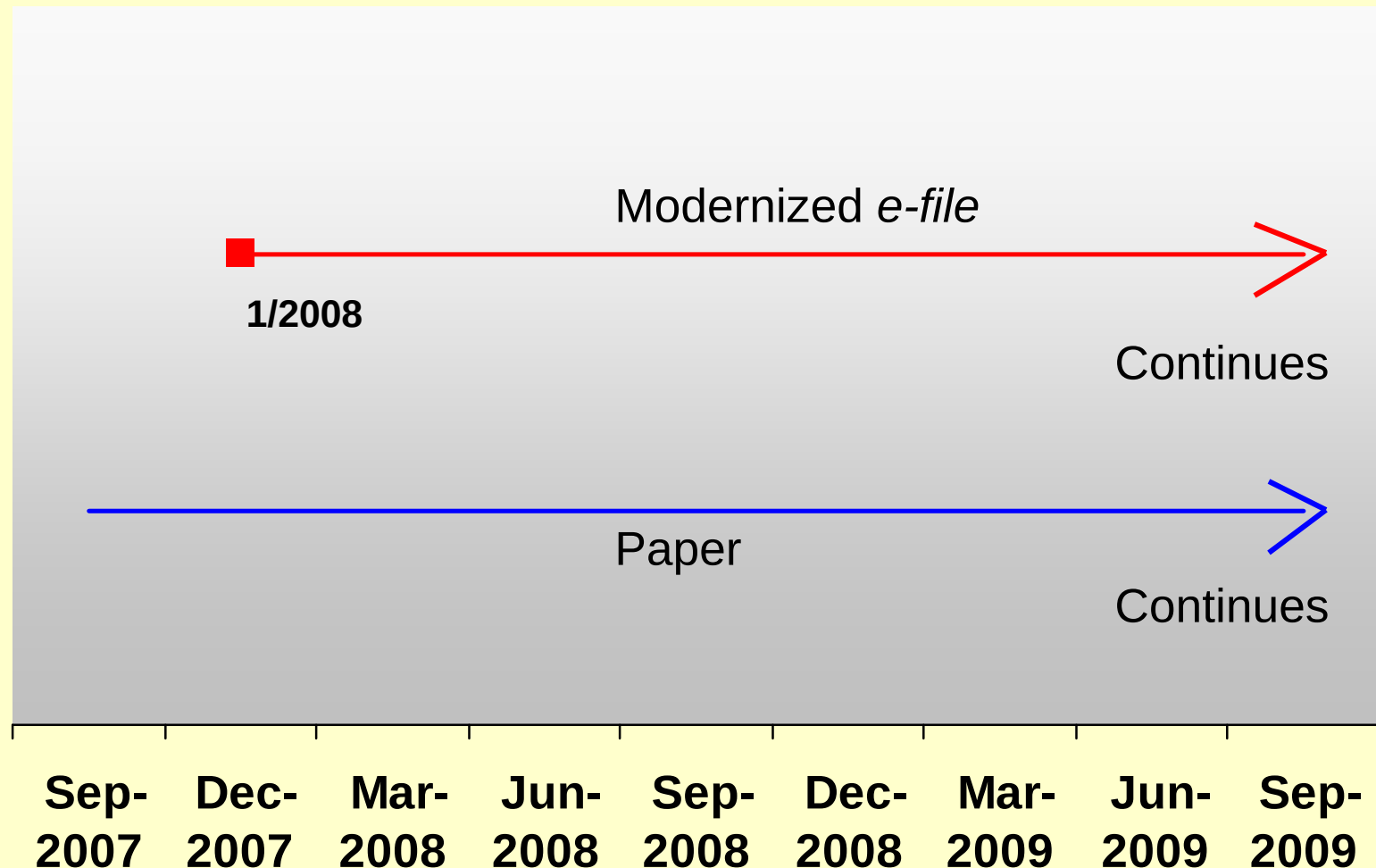

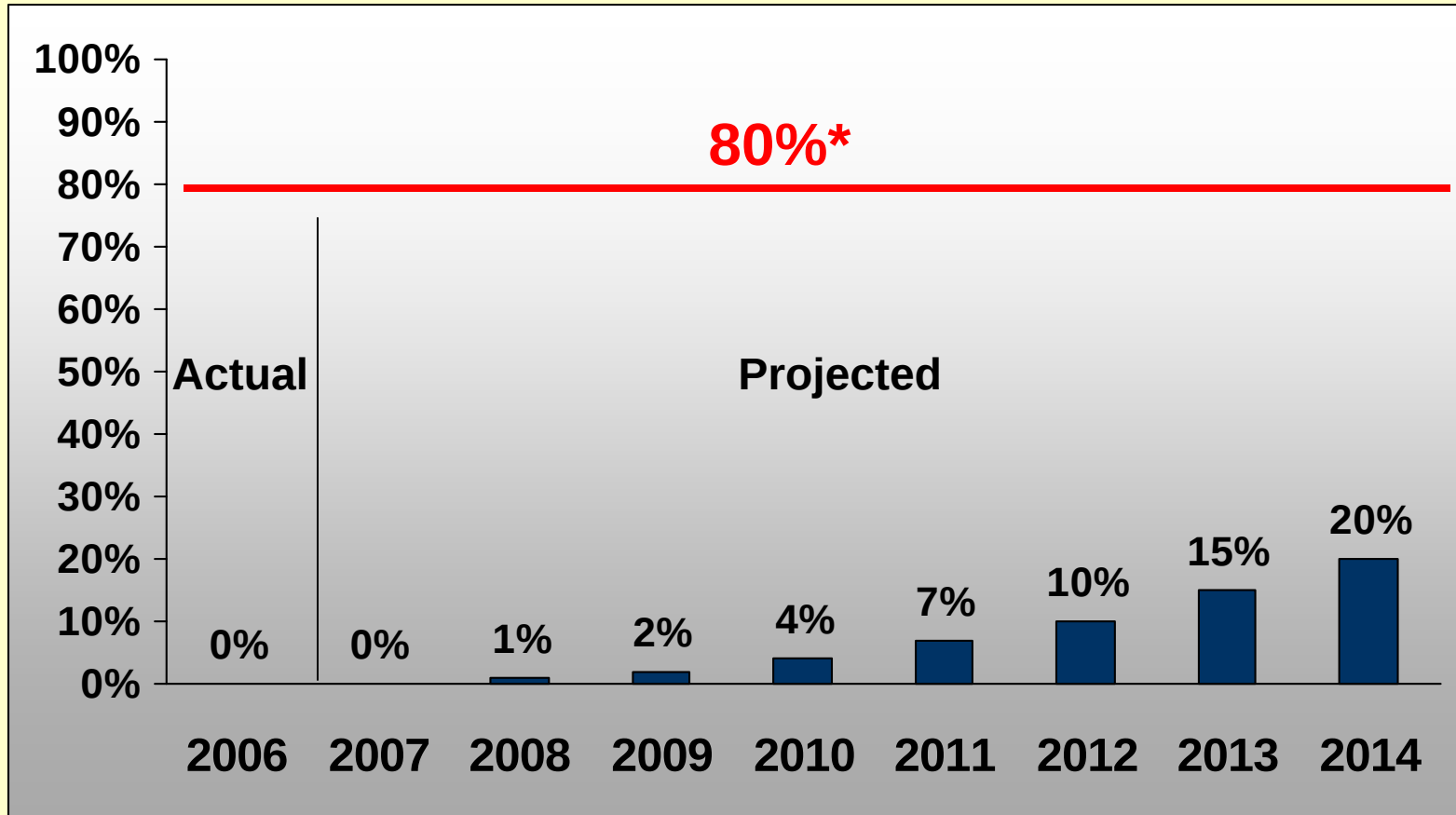

Form 720: Implementation Schedule

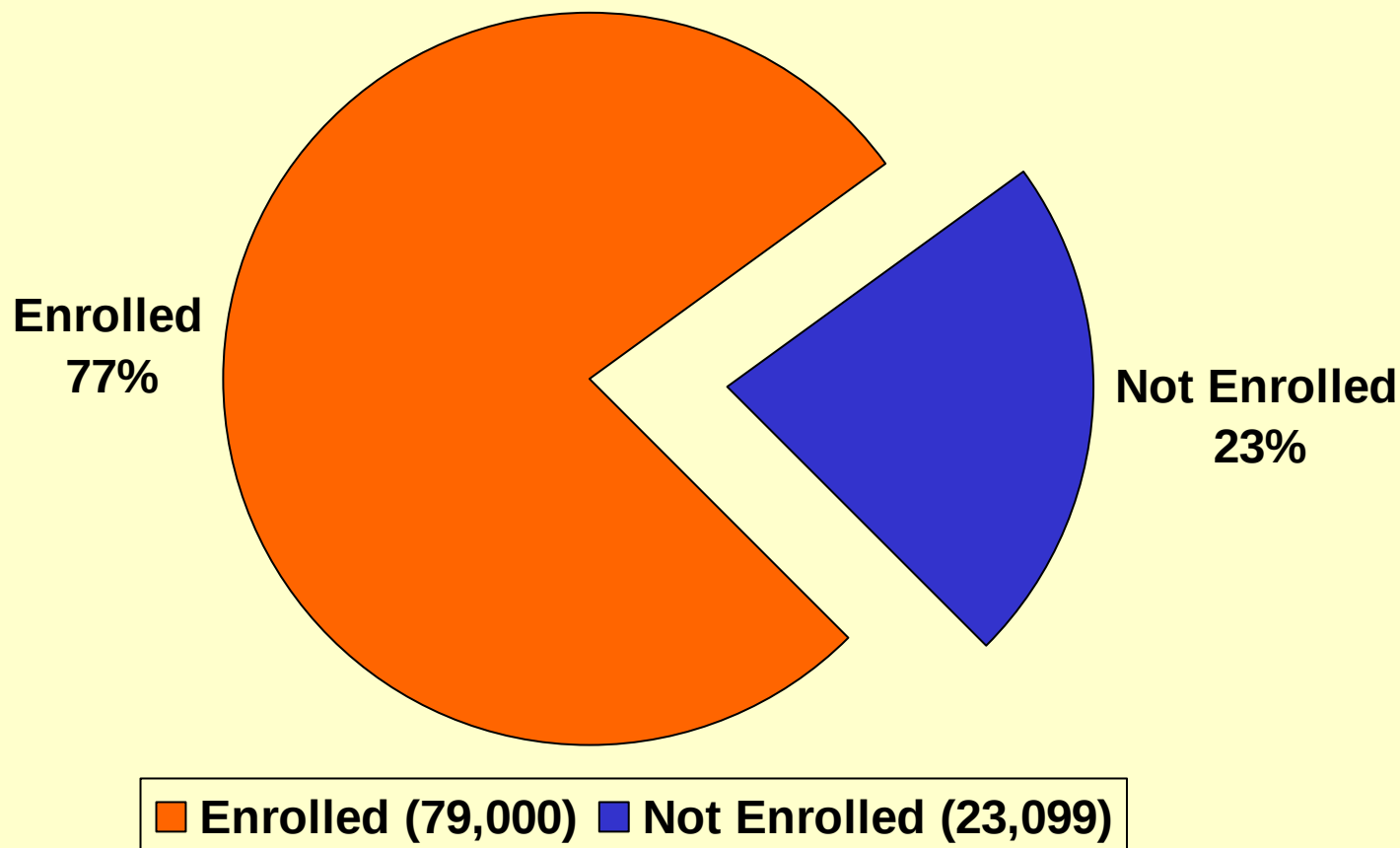


Form 720 Projected *e-file* Penetration Rate

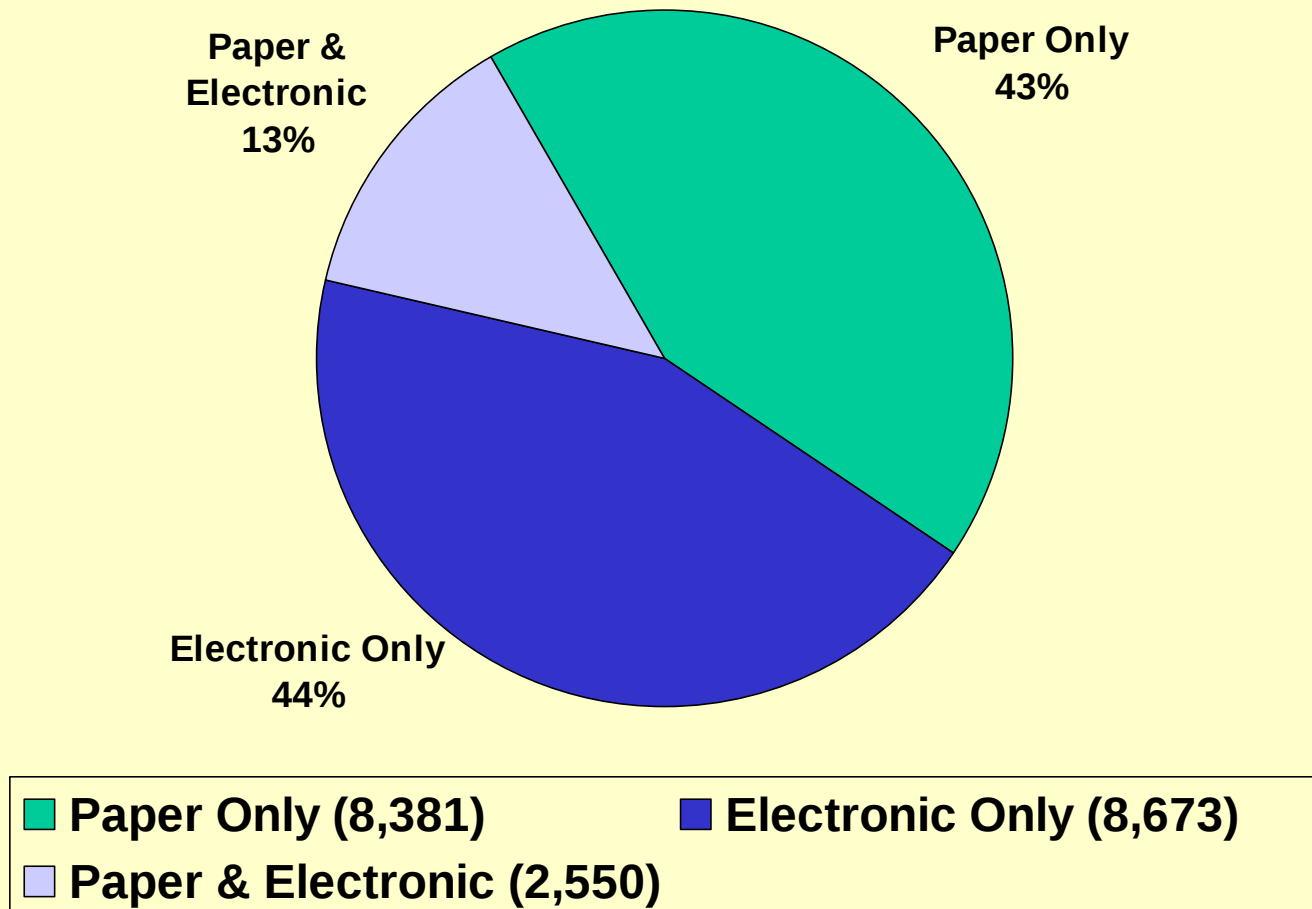


Form 720 Taxpayers Enrolled in EFTPS (Electronic Federal Tax Payment System)

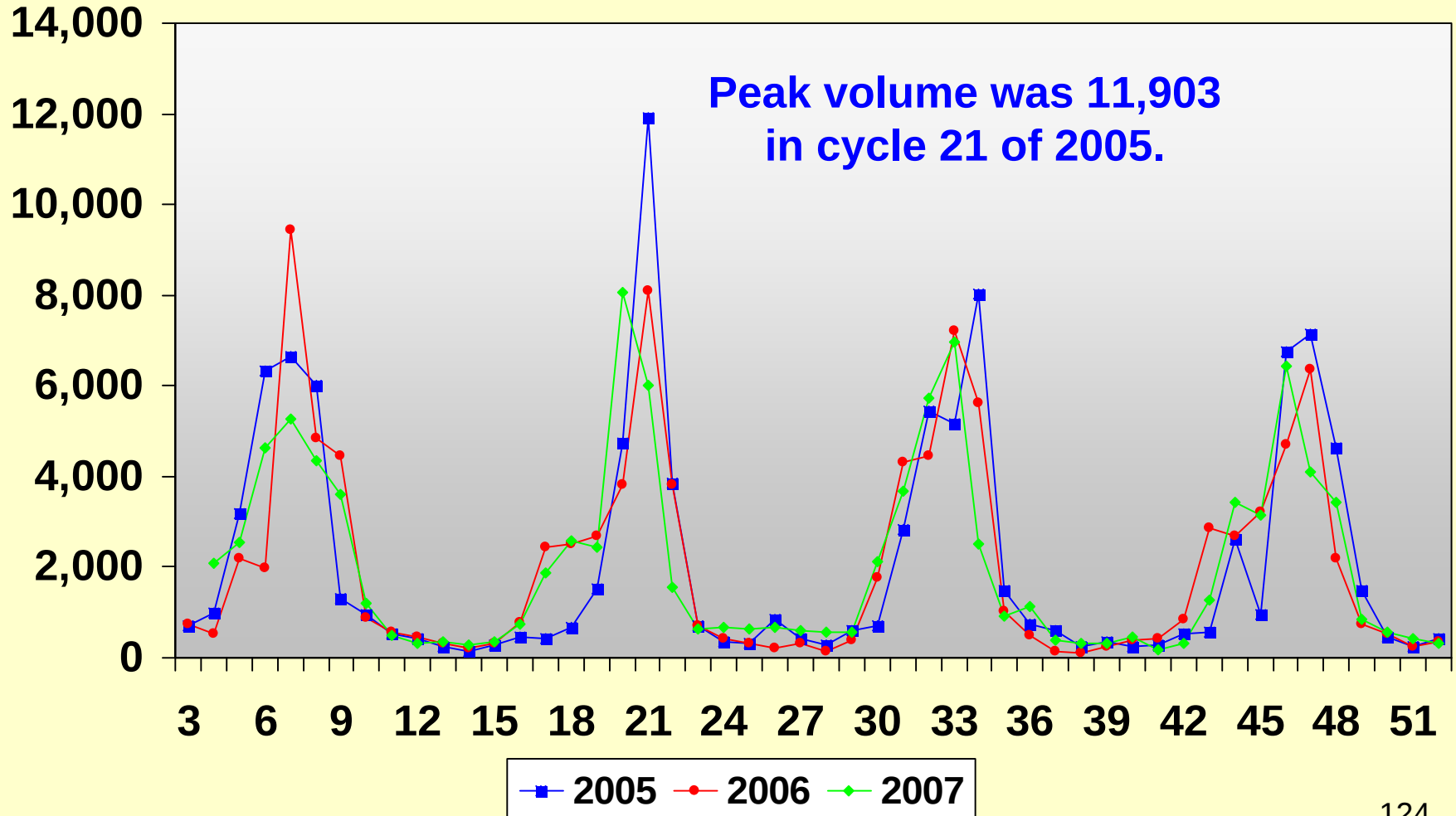

Total Number of Form 720 Taxpayers Making Payments*

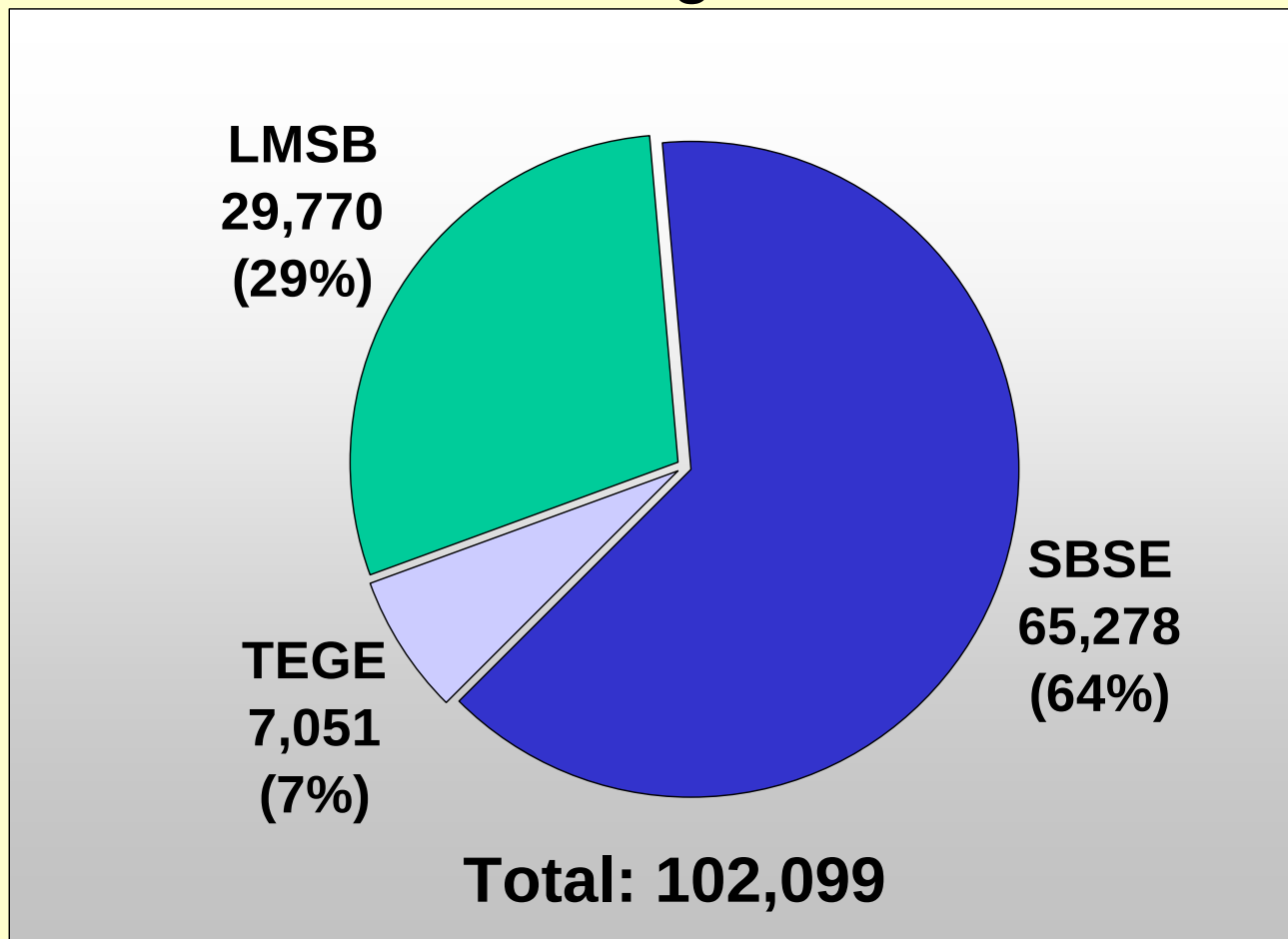


Form 720 Filing Patterns by Cycle Posted

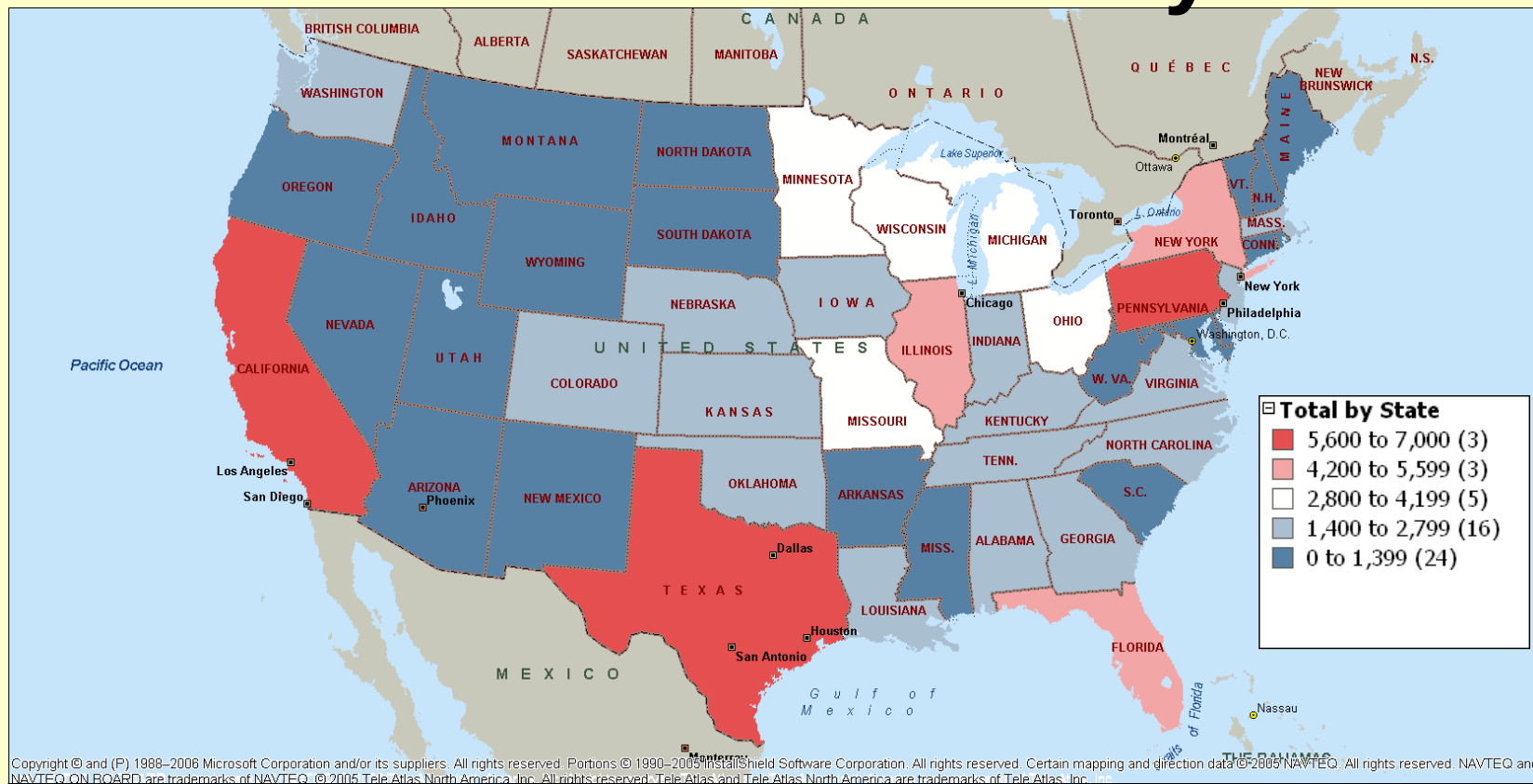
