

Rule Number	Rule Text
FPYMT-040	Tax payer's Day Time Phone Number in IRS Payment Record or IRS ES Payment Record cannot equal all zeros.
FPYMT-042	Payment Amount in the IRS Payment Record must not be more than 200% of the Form 1040, Line 75 'AmountOwedAmt' amount.
FPYMT-043	If the processing date is after June 23, 2010 but prior to September 23, 2010, the "Requested Payment Date" in the Estimated Tax Payment Record can only be September 15, 2010 or January 17, 2011.
FPYMT-044	If the processing date is after September 22, 2010 but before December 31, 2010, the "Requested Payment Date" in the Estimated Tax Payment Record can only be January 17, 2011.
FPYMT-045	The "Requested Payment Date" in the Estimated Tax Record must not be the same as that in another Estimated Tax Payment Record filed with the same return.
FPYMT-046	If the processing date is between January 1, 2010 and January 14, 2010, the "Requested Payment Dates" in the Estimated Tax Payment Record can only be April 15, June 15, and September 15.
FPYMT-047	If the processing date is after April 23, 2010 but prior to June 22, 2010, the "Requested Payment Dates" in the Estimated Tax Payment Record can only be June 15, 2010, September 15, 2010 and January 17, 2011.
FPYMT-054	If the timestamp (in the GTX key or Response to Send Submissions Request) is on or before the due date of the return, then the "RequestedPaymentDate" in the IRS Payment Record must be on the due date or before the due date but not more than 5 days prior to the received date.
FPYMT-055	If the timestamp (in the GTX key or Response to Send Submissions Request) is after the due date of the return, then the "RequestedPaymentDate" in the IRS Payment Record must not be later than the date the return was received and must not be prior to five days before the date the return was received by the IRS.
FPYMT-056	If thr processing date is January 15, 2010 through April 15, 2010, the "Requested Payment Dates" in the Estimated Tax Payment Record can only be April 15, June 15, September 15 and January 17.
FPYMT-057	In IRS Payment Record or IRS ES Payment Record, the payment amount must be greater than zero, but less than \$100 million.
