Where's My Refund?—one of the IRS' most popular online features—gives you secure access to the status of your individual federal income tax refund *within seconds*. If you used e-file to file your income tax, you can generally get information about your refund 72 hours after the IRS acknowledges receipt of your return. If you mailed a paper return, it takes about three to four weeks.

It's easy. Just go to the [Where's My Refund?](#) online tool on [IRS.gov](#) and check on the status of your refund. You'll need to provide the following information from your tax return:

- Your Social Security Number (or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number)
- Your filing status (i.e., single, married filing jointly, etc.)
- The exact whole dollar amount of your refund

You can:

- Initiate a refund trace to re-issue your lost or missing paper check*; and
- Update your mailing address if the U.S. Postal Service was unable to deliver your check to the IRS*.

It's safe. You interact online with the IRS through secure technology that protects the confidentiality of your personal information.
