## Carson Man Pleads Guilty to Tax Evasion

LOS ANGELES - A Carson man pleaded guilty today to tax evasion before United States District Judge R. Gary Klausner.

Dewayne Davis, 52, pleaded guilty to failing to report income on his 2009 federal income tax return.

According to the plea agreement, Davis was employed full time on a salaried basis. In addition to his full time job, Davis provided security consulting services to a corporation by the name of At Close Range. During the years 2007 through 2011, Davis received compensation for these consulting services and deposited these amounts into his bank accounts. The income received from At Close Range was taxable to Davis. His failure to report this income created a tax loss to the government of \$78,697.

As a result of the guilty plea, Davis faces a statutory maximum sentence of five years when sentenced by Judge Klausner on July 21, 2014. He may be further ordered by Judge Klausner to pay restitution to the IRS of \$78,697.

This case was investigated by IRS Criminal Investigation's Los Angeles Field Office and the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
