

Delegation Order 1-64 (New)

Effective: February 7, 2017

(1) Authority to Approve or Deny a Contractor's Request for a Deferment of Collections or Installment Payments

(2) **Authority:** To approve or deny requests for deferment of collections on claims of the United States arising from agency procurement activities regulated by Title 48 of the Code of Federal Regulations

(3) Delegated to:

- Associate Chief Financial Officer for Financial Management for claims up to and including \$50,000
- Chief Financial Officer for claims up to and including \$100,000

Note: Claims in excess of \$100,000 must be submitted through the Deputy Commissioner for Operations Support prior to submission to the Department of Justice.

(4) **Redelegation:** This authority may not be redelegated.

(5) **Authority:** To approve or deny requests for installment payments on claims of the United States arising from agency procurement activities regulated by Title 48 of the Code of Federal Regulations

(6) Delegated to:

- Associate Chief Financial Officer for Financial Management for claims up to and including \$50,000
- Chief Financial Officer for claims up to and including \$100,000
- Deputy Commissioner for Operations Support for claims in excess of \$100,000

(7) **Redelegation:** This authority may not be redelegated.

(8) **Sources of Authority:** Title 48, Code of Federal Regulations, Subpart 32.607, and 31 U.S.C. 3711.

(9) To the extent that authority previously exercised consistent with this order may require ratification, it is hereby affirmed and ratified.
