



## **Caution: *DRAFT—NOT FOR FILING***

This is an early release draft of an IRS tax form, instructions, or publication, which the IRS is providing for your information as a courtesy. **Do not file draft forms.** Also, do **not** rely on draft forms, instructions, and publications for filing. We generally do not release drafts of forms until we believe we have incorporated all changes. However, unexpected issues sometimes arise, or legislation is passed, necessitating a change to a draft form. In addition, forms generally are subject to OMB approval before they can be officially released. Drafts of instructions and publications usually have at least some changes before being officially released.

Early release drafts are at [IRS.gov/DraftForms](https://www.irs.gov/DraftForms), and may remain there even after the final release is posted at [IRS.gov/DownloadForms](https://www.irs.gov/DownloadForms). All information about all forms, instructions, and pubs is at [IRS.gov/Forms](https://www.irs.gov/Forms).

Almost every form and publication also has its own page on IRS.gov. For example, the Form 1040 page is at [IRS.gov/Form1040](https://www.irs.gov/Form1040); the Publication 17 page is at [IRS.gov/Pub17](https://www.irs.gov/Pub17); the Form W-4 page is at [IRS.gov/W4](https://www.irs.gov/W4); and the Schedule A (Form 1040) page is at [IRS.gov/ScheduleA](https://www.irs.gov/ScheduleA). If typing in a link above instead of clicking on it, be sure to type the link into the address bar of your browser, not in a Search box. Note that these are friendly shortcut links that will automatically go to the actual link for the page.

## What Is Form 1040-V

It's a statement you send with your check or money order for any balance due on the "Amount you owe" line of your 2018 Form 1040 or Form 1040NR.

## Consider Making Your Tax Payment Electronically—It's Easy

You can make electronic payments online, by phone, or from a mobile device. Paying electronically is safe and secure. When you schedule your payment you will receive immediate confirmation from the IRS. Go to [www.irs.gov/Payments](http://www.irs.gov/Payments) to see all your electronic payment options.

## How To Fill In Form 1040-V

**Line 1.** Enter your social security number (SSN).

If you are filing a joint return, enter the SSN shown first on your return.

**Line 2.** If you are filing a joint return, enter the SSN shown second on your return.

**Line 3.** Enter the amount you are paying by check or money order. If paying at [IRS.gov](http://IRS.gov) don't complete this form.

**Line 4.** Enter your name(s) and address exactly as shown on your return. Please print clearly.

## How To Prepare Your Payment

- Make your check or money order payable to "**United States Treasury.**" Don't send cash. If you want to pay in cash, in person, see *Pay by cash.*
- Make sure your name and address appear on your check or money order.
- Enter your daytime phone number and your SSN on your check or money order. If you have an Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN), enter it wherever your SSN is requested. If you are filing a joint return, enter the SSN shown first on your return. Also enter "2018 Form 1040" or "2018 Form 1040NR," whichever is appropriate.

• To help us process your payment, enter the amount on the right side of your check like this: \$ XXX.XX. Don't use dashes or lines (for example, don't enter "\$ XXX—" or "\$ XXX<sup>xx/100</sup>").

**No checks of \$100 million or more accepted.** The IRS can't accept a single check (including a cashier's check) for amounts of \$100,000,000 (\$100 million) or more. If you are sending \$100 million or more by check, you will need to spread the payments over two or more checks, with each check made out for an amount less than \$100 million.

**Pay by cash.** This is an in-person payment option for individuals provided through retail partners with a maximum of \$1,000 per day per transaction. To make a cash payment, you must first be registered online at [www.officialpayments.com/fed](http://www.officialpayments.com/fed), our Official Payment provider.

## How To Send In Your 2018 Tax Return, Payment, and Form 1040-V

- Don't staple or otherwise attach your payment or Form 1040-V to your return. Instead, just put them loose in the envelope.
- Mail your 2018 tax return, payment, and Form 1040-V to the address shown on the back that applies to you.

## How To Pay Electronically

### Pay Online

Paying online is convenient, secure, and helps make sure we get your payments on time. You can pay using either of the following electronic payment methods. To pay your taxes online or for more information, go to [www.irs.gov/Payments](http://www.irs.gov/Payments).

### IRS Direct Pay

Pay your taxes directly from your checking or savings account at no cost to you. You receive instant confirmation that your payment has been made, and you can schedule your payment up to 30 days in advance.

### Debit or Credit Card

The IRS doesn't charge a fee for this service; the card processors do. The authorized card processors and their phone numbers are all on [www.irs.gov/Payments](http://www.irs.gov/Payments).
