IRIS Filing Season Update

- Since the opening of Filing Season 26 (FS26) on January 6th, IRIS has received over **1.2 billion records**.

- Highest Volume Forms:
 - 1099-DA Over 1 billion records
 - 1099-B Over 26 million records
 - 1099-NEC Over 24 million records
 - 1099-INT Over 21 million records
 - 1099-MISC Over 12 million records

- Highest Volume Days:
 - 05/02/2026 Over 183 million records
 - 05/01/2026 Over 168 million records
 - 04/30/2026 Over 303 million records

- Historical Volume:
 - TY22/PY23: 67,000
 - TY23/PY24: 9 million
 - TY24/PY25 19.3 million



Updates/Useful Tips



FIRE System Retirement

- IRIS will be the only information returns electronic filing system, including current year, prior year, or corrections, after January 1, 2027.
- Key dates to remember
 - Nov. 1, 2026: Last day to file test information returns through the FIRE Trading Partner Test System.
 - Nov. 9, 2026: Last day to make changes to the IR Applications for TCCs.
 - Nov. 19, 2026, at 3 p.m. ET: Last day to file information returns through the FIRE system.
- Publication 1220, Specifications for Electronic Filing of Forms 1097, 1098, 1099, 3921, 3922, 5498, and W-2G, will be made obsolete when the FIRE system retires.
 - This information will be contained in the Schema Package and Publications 5717, 5718 and 5719.

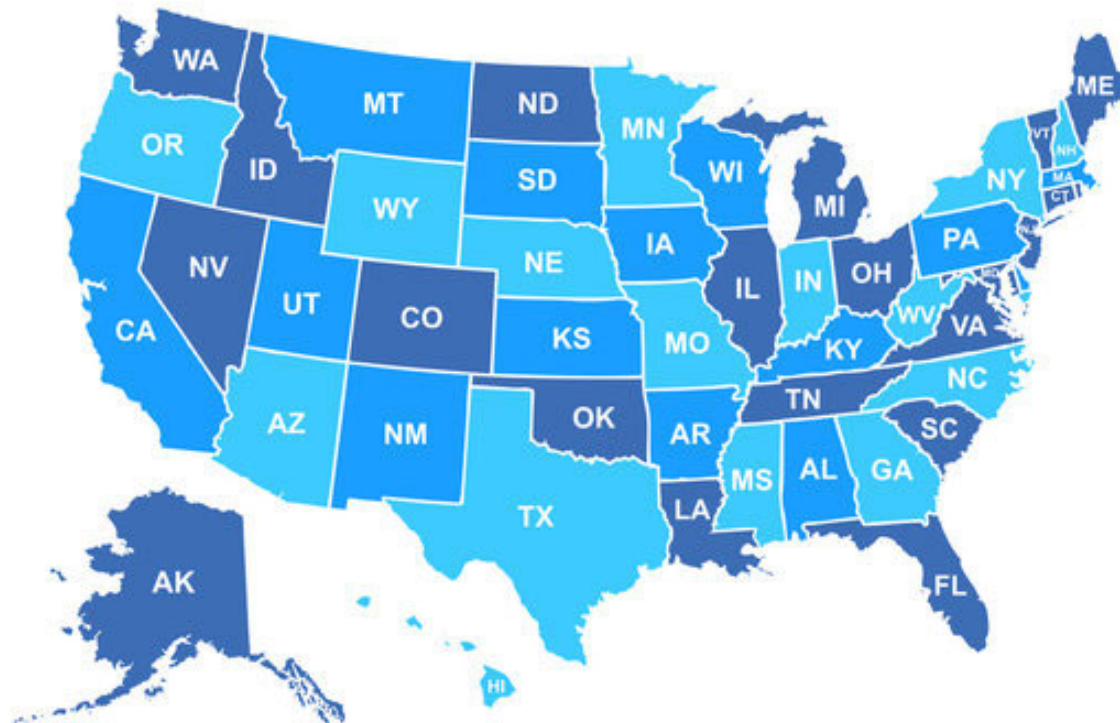

States

The IRIS schema folder is available to states in the FTA State Exchange system (SES)

- Located in the IRS folder where MeF schema is located
- All members who have access to MeF schema should also have access to IRIS schemas





IRIS ATS Reminders

- IRIS Assurance Testing System (ATS) is available for A2A testing year-round.
 - Tax Year 2025 is current year in IRIS ATS.
 - Tax Year(s) 2024, 2023 and 2022 are available for prior year returns.
 - TY26/PY27 IRIS ATS is tentatively scheduled to begin in October.
- Since the annual schema updates are typically minor, software developers are encouraged to establish a baseline by developing and testing against the current year's schema.
 - Once the upcoming year's schema is released, modifications can be made to accommodate the new tax year requirements
 - If you wish to have your Software tested and reviewed for a prior year, you must use the schema for that year.
- There is not a test environment for the Taxpayer Portal
 - The portal only accepts live production data
 - There is no test software or testing capabilities for transmitters



Address fields on Forms

Address fields on forms.

- For forms revised in 2026, the address fields on the paper forms have been divided into individual entry boxes.
- Electronic files will not include the suite/apt. number address individual entry boxes.
- Note: Generally, boxes on paper forms correspond with fields used for the electronic file; however, if the form and field instructions don't match, the guidance in the schema package and IRIS electronic filing specifications supersedes paper form instructions.

Correction for FIRE Originals

- For corrected returns filed through IRIS that relate to records originally accepted by FIRE, transmitters must complete the PrevSubmittedRecRecipientGrp element in the schema which will include new data elements in addition to established data elements within the PrevSubmittedRecRecipientGrp:
 - The element OtherIntakeSystemInd must be set to “true” to indicate that the original return was submitted through a system other than IRIS.
 - The element OtherIntakeSystemNm must be populated with the appropriate enumeration value identifying the prior intake system.
- Addition details will be provided in Publication 5718 and in TY26/PY27 Schema Packages.

Correction Business Rules

The following Business Rules will be deleted and new business rules created to enforce either the presence of a UniqueRecordId or the Other System Name Type:

- FTMFST014: If 'CorrectedInd' (or AmendedInd) has a value of "1", then 'UniqueRecordId' must have a value
- SHAREDIFORM006_002: If 'CorrectedInd' (or AmendedInd) has a value of "1", then 'UniqueRecordId' must have a value

The Business Rules in the 8/13/2026 Schema Package will not reflect this change. This will be updated in the next release.



Software IDs

- Software IDs are tax-year specific.
 - Software developers should obtain the appropriate Software ID for each tax year their software will support.

- Software IDs are required for prior-year filing.
 - Filers submitting forms for tax years prior to TY2022 will need a Software ID for those years.
 - Additional instructions will be provided at a later date on how to obtain IRIS Schema and Business Rules for Tax Years 2017-2021.

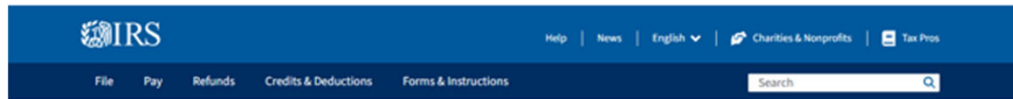

Where can I find the required fields for the CSV templates?

The CSV file formatting guidelines are provided on the Taxpayer Portal. On the dashboard click the Upload CSV with Form Data tile, then on the right side of the next page under FAQ, #8 has the template formatting guidelines. You may download the formatting guidelines for each form you need to file.

Tips for troubleshooting CSV errors are provided in Publication 5717 (Rev. 9-2024).

I uploaded a CSV file and nothing happens when I select "Start".

Confirm the file is saved as a CSV file. After uploading the file, a blue box should appear with the title "Current Uploaded File". The blue box will include the name of your file. If your file is not listed, please refresh your page and try uploading again. If your file name is in the blue box and there are no issues, the "Start" button will turn blue to indicate it is active.

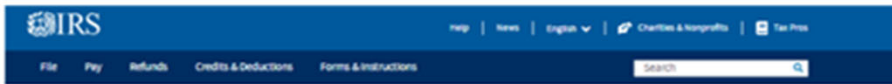

JWT Errors

Some IRIS Application-to-Application (A2A) transmitters may receive an authentication error:

“System.Exception: (ESRV306) invalid client - The given JWT for client authentication is invalid” when generating JSON Web Tokens (JWTs) for client authentication.

The error can occur when the JWT exp (expiration) claim is generated using a time zone-naive date/time value.

In these cases, the expiration time may be interpreted as already expired during validation, causing the authentication request to fail.

Update the JWT expiration (exp) generation logic to use a UTC-based, time zone-aware date/time type to ensure the expiration time is calculated correctly in UTC.

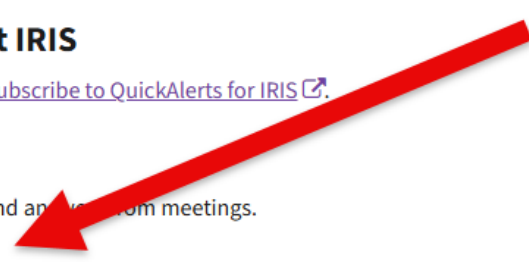

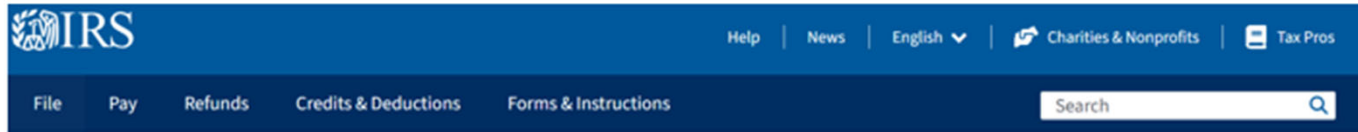

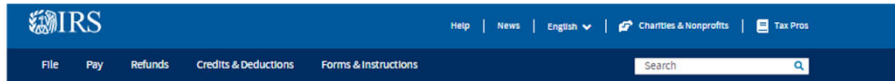
