

## ELECTRONIC TAX ADMINISTRATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Electronic Tax Administration Advisory Committee (ETAAC) Virtual Public Meeting Wednesday, March 20, 2024 MINUTES

John Lipold opened the meeting as the designated federal official. He introduced Timur Taluy, chair of the electronic tax administration advisory committee.

Taluy indicated that the Committee has made significant progress in the progress of the generation of the report. He indicated that the Committee has three active committees in addition to a group evaluating the free tax filing services offered by the IRS including Free File, VITA/TCE and direct file.

The sub-committees include an access to information sub-committee chaired my Mark Steber, an access to e-file sub-committee chaired by Ronn Gilson, and a legislative sub-committee chaired by Amy Miller. Taluy indicated that the access to information sub-committee is working on issues related to taxpayers having access to the information that the IRS has from third-party reporting; APIs to increase accuracy of tax returns and protect taxpayers from schemes and scams; and removing barriers to e-file while enhancing security by replacing the IP PIN with a more secure e-file PIN.

Mr. Gilson reported the access to e-file sub committee is exploring the reporting agent authorization signatures and the plans for FIRE and AIR systems in the IRS.

Ms Miller shared that the legislative sub-committee is exploring a recommendation to Congress regarding good tax administration and facilitating electronic filing by individuals and transmitters for low use forms.

Taluy indicated that these explorations are very early and preliminary, and this sharing is not an indication of what will be in the report or of any recommendations the Committee will make to the IRS or Congress. He then returned the floor to Mr. Lipold.

Lipold announced the subsequent and final public meeting of this ETAAC will be Jun 26 at 1111 Constitution where the Committee will present its report to the IRS.
