

IRS delays processing of some taxpayer returns until February 14, 2011

Although we prepared your return, we cannot file it until the IRS reprograms its processing systems. You are receiving this notice because your return contains at least one of the provisions of the Tax Relief, Unemployment Insurance Reauthorization and Job Creation Act of 2010 that was passed in December 2010.

The IRS estimates that the processing systems will be reprogrammed on February 14, 2011. After the systems are reprogrammed and your return has been processed, you can then:

If we encounter any problems when we are able to submit your return to IRS we will contact you. Otherwise, you can consider your return filed the week of February 14th. Allow 7-10 days after IRS is able to process your return for receipt of any refund due.
