# **Social Media Calendar of Messages**

# What's in this toolkit?

This document provides you with customized ready-made messages for you to use in whatever social media platform(s) your organization uses. The messages are presented in a calendar so that you don't have to worry about the timing of when you should share a specific message on a given topic.

#### How to use the toolkit?

Simple, just choose the messages in the calendar that work best for your organization and post them. You may post them exactly as they are or you can add any additional information that's specific to your organization, such as a hashtag, a link to your website and/or a graphic.

In each message we have included hashtags and shortened URLs that link back to key pages on IRS.gov. Using these items as they are provided will allow us to keep track of the message exposure. We will be sure to share this information with you once gathered. (See full list of hashtags and short URLs at the end of this document.)


# Additional ITIN Material you may want to use.



This includes any type of electronic communication, such as text messages and social media channels. 
