

You could receive a tax refund even if you're not required to file



EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT

- ▶ When claiming three or more qualifying children, you can receive up to \$6,728
- ▶ Your household must have earned income of less than \$57,414
- ▶ You and your spouse must have valid Social Security numbers
- ▶ Qualifying child must be younger than you
- ▶ Qualifying child must be under age 19, or a full-time student under age 24, at end of tax year
- ▶ Qualifying child can be any age if permanently and totally disabled
- ▶ You may be able to claim the Earned Income Tax Credit without a qualifying child if your earned income is less than \$21,430 (\$27,380 if Married Filing Jointly)

CHILD TAX CREDIT

- ▶ You may receive up to \$3,600 for each child age 5 and under, \$3,000 for each child age 6 through 17 at the end of 2021
- ▶ No income is required to claim this credit for 2021
- ▶ Qualifying child must have an SSN
- ▶ Qualifying child must be claimed as a dependent on your return
- ▶ Qualifying children may include foster children or extended family if they meet other criteria
- ▶ Dependents who can't be claimed for the Child Tax Credit may qualify you for the Credit for Other Dependents, which is up to \$500 per dependent

Expanded EITC Age Limits for 2021

BE AT LEAST AGE 18 AT THE END OF THE TAX YEAR (USUALLY DEC. 31)

- ▶ The minimum age to claim the EIC is generally age 19; however, if you are a qualified former foster youth or a qualified homeless youth, you need to be at least age 18.
- ▶ There is no maximum age limit. The prior maximum age limit was 64
