¹ For purposes of this form, personal representative means the executor, executrix, administrator or administratrix of the decedent's estate; if no executor, executrix, administrator or administratrix is appointed, qualified and acting within the United States, personal representative means any person in actual or constructive possession of any property of the decedent.

² May be the original or an authentic copy of a telegram or letter from the Department of Defense notifying the next of kin of the decedent's death while in active service, or a death certificate issued by the Department of Defense.
