



#### Significant Highlights From This Update of *Publication 6961*

- Of the 41 nonpaper information and withholding documents processed for Calendar Year 2021, the top 5 accounted for 87.5 percent of the total nonpaper documents processed.
- The grand total number of information and withholding documents processed in Calendar Year 2021 was 4.9 billion. After CY 2021, the grand total is projected to grow at an average annual rate of 3.3 percent, reaching 6.5 billion documents by CY 2030.
- The grand total number of paper information and withholding documents processed in Calendar Year 2021 was 28.6 million; it is projected to increase to 29.8 million in CY 2022 and decrease to 5.4 million documents by CY 2030.
- The grand total number of information and withholding documents processed electronically was 4.8 billion in Calendar Year 2021. It is projected to grow at an average annual rate of 3.4 percent, reaching 6.5 billion documents by CY 2030.
- The grand total number of paper filings for the Austin campus in Calendar Year 2021 was 13.3 million documents. The corresponding number for the Kansas City campus was 8.6 million documents. The Ogden campus processed 6.7 million paper documents in CY 2021.
