TIPSS-3 PROGRAM

- Maintaining Current Critical Operations, as requirements are transition to TIPSS-4
- TIPSS-3 JOFOC
 - Extends the existing base contracts until April 2012
 - No New Task Orders are anticipated under TIPSS-3
 - Provides flexibility to handle legislative changes under current orders, if mandated
 - Allows for continuation of services pending new TIPSS-4 Competitions
- Working with customers to develop requirements for ongoing work

TIPSS-3 TO TIPSS-4 TRANSITION

- Analyzing current workload to identify all existing orders that need to be transitioned to TIPSS-4
- Preparing a schedule to allow proper competition on future orders
- Working with customers on solicitation packages
- Creating new Templates to assist customers, staff and vendors
- Identifying new items in the TIPSS-4 contracts to ensure a smooth transition
- Determining the appropriate contract vehicle for competitions
- Current TIPSS Structure
- Anticipated TIPSS-4 Task Orders

TIPSS-4 OPERATIONS

- The contracts will be transferred to the TIPSS Program Branch to administer and conduct task order competitions
- Typical RTCP/RTPP Process
 - 10 to 15 work days response
 - Standard Requirement Documents
 - Technical/Cost &Price evaluations
 - Down-select if applicable Negotiations
 - Award
- Government Wide push to reduce high-risk contract actions through the use of Fixed Price Performance Based awards
- Increased efficiency in task order competitions and awards
- Regular Vendor outreach sessions
