Robert Weinberger is a Senior Fellow at the Aspen Institute's Initiative on Financial Security in Washington, specializing in tax and financial services policy.

Earlier, he served in federal and state government (at the White House, U.S. Departments of Commerce and Transportation, and as General Counsel to the Illinois State Comptroller) before leading government relations and public policy as an executive at Continental Bank, Unilever, and finally H&R Block, from which he retired in 2009.

He chairs the board of the Center for Responsive Politics, is on the boards of Community Tax Aid and the American University Law School's Federal Tax Clinic, and is a past member of the Internal Revenue Service Advisory Council.

A graduate of Oberlin College and the University of Illinois College of Law, he also studied at the University of Illinois' Institute of Government and Public Affairs and at Harvard's Kennedy School of Government.
