The practice of using all numbers should not be continued, but, you don't need to get a new consent.

Some people (and the practice in some countries is to) write the day of the month followed by the month and then the year (DD/MM/YY) rather than MM/DD/YY. Since the 4 Form 941 quarters end on 3/31/06, 6/30/06, 9/30/06, and 12/31/06 - we shouldn't have a problem (e.g., because "31" in 12/31/06 could not be a month).

You should instruct your folks that the months (e.g., December 31, 2006) should always be spelled out in the future.
