Section 6223(c) and the regulations there under only require, "for purposes of this subchapter", the use of the name and address of a partner. The partner's TIN is not required except when the partner is providing updated partner information to the Service. Thus, there is no legal requirement to have the full TIN of partners on NBAPs and FPAAAs or other TEFRA related documents. Thus, the Service is free to balance privacy and practical necessity in determining whether to include TIN's. Note, however, that, outside of the TEFRA examination function, section 6103(e)(10) limits disclosure of one partner's personal identity information to any other person.
