Important information about your Form 8716

We denied your request due to your deferral period

We received your Form 8716. We can't process your request because your deferral period is more than 3 months.

What you need to know

The tax year you're adopting cannot have a deferral period of more than 3 months.

The term "deferral period" means the number of months between the last day of the elected tax year and the last day of the required tax year.

You should file your annual returns at the end of your required tax year, usually a calendar tax year.

We'll mail your denied Form 8716 separately.
